If you know of someone in the Park that has a need, please let us know. All requests are confidential. We would like to help if we can. Please call one of the numbers below and we will look into what we can do to help.



to forage healthy food on their own. Additionally, uneaten bread crumbs attract predators like rats, grow mold that makes ducks and other riparian animals sick, and contribute to harmful algae blooms. Worst of all, feeding ducks bread can even prevent them from flying. A high-carb, high-protein diet of mostly bread can cause a wing deformity known as "angel wing" or "airplane wing" that causes the end feathers to stick out sideways instead flat against the body, so that it can't fly.

#### **HEALTHY ALTERNATIVES:**

- 1. Frozen peas and pea shoots (don't cook the peas, but let them thaw)
- 2. Sweet corn (canned, frozen or fresh)
- 3. Lettuce or cabbage (kale is their favorite!)
- 4. Oats (rolled, steel-cut, or instant, they'll love this treat in moderation)
- 5. Seeds (bird seed or seeds from the health food market)
- 6. Rice (cooked or uncooked, in moderation)

Just keep in mind, all of these items are special treats to be given sparingly. Ducks' natural diet consists of algae, aquatic plants, worms, crustaceans, snails, small fish and fish eggs, insects, small amphibians, berries, fruits and nuts.

### **Golden Silk Spider**

ore commonly known as banana spiders, golden silk spider females are our largest non-tarantula-like spiders and live throughout Florida.

Growing up to four inches in total length with legs included, females dwarf the males in size; males only grow to about an inch. Easily recognized by their bright colors, the female spiders have yellow spots, orange to tan cylindrical bodies and orange banded legs. Males are dull in appearance and generally sit above the female on the web.

The webs created by the females are very intricate and can be quite large. They feed mainly on insects caught in the web and have been known to consume cicadas. The spiders, in turn, may be consumed by birds, such as Carolina wrens.

These large spiders, like all life, are part of the food web, from tiny bugs to black bears. All are dependent on others to sustain life, including humans.

#### **VETERAN'S CORNER**

ilitary Officers Association of America - Clearwater Chapter
Veterans and Gold Star Families will be granted free access to national parks, wildlife refuges and other Federal lands managed by the Department of the Interior starting on Veterans Day this year and every day onward.



"With the utmost respect and gratitude, we are granting Veterans and Gold Star Families free access to the iconic and treasured lands they fought to protect starting this Veterans Day and every single day thereafter," said Secretary of the Interior David L. Bernhardt.

Entrance fees for the National Park Service and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and standard amenity recreation fees for the Bureau of Land Management and the Bureau of Reclamation sites will be waived for Veterans and Gold Star Families. They will have free access to approximately 2,000 public locations spread out across more than 400 million acres of public lands, which host activities to fit any lifestyle, from serene to high octane, including hiking, fishing, paddling, biking, hunting, stargazing and climbing.

Many Department managed lands have direct connections to the American military, such as frontier forts, Cold War sites, battlefields, national cemeteries, and memorials. These special places pay tribute to our veterans and serve as reminders of their courage and sacrifice throughout the history of our nation, from Minuteman National Historic Park where colonists stood in defense of their rights, to Yellowstone National Park, which was protected from vandalism and poaching by the 1st U.S. Cavalry before the National Park Service was established, to Mount Rushmore where modern warriors attend reenlistment ceremonies.

Details on program

For purposes of this program, a Veteran is identified as an individual who has served in the United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard and Reserves, and is able to present one of the following forms of identification:

- Department of Defense Identification Card
- Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC)
- Veteran ID Card
