

Estate Sales vs. Yard Sales and Paradise Island Park

any people have inquired about yard sales and estate sales held in Paradise Island. Here's the low down: An estate sale sells the greater part of the contents of a home. Most estate sales are conducted by professional personal property liquidators—an estate sale company. They sort, organize (or stage) the contents within the home, price, advertise, and conduct a sale last-

ing two, three, or four days. Many also offer clean out services as well for an additional fee. Estate liquidators are experienced with selling household items as well as antiques, art, etc., however, when in doubt they research and may call in an appraiser to assist them with the proper description and pricing. As defined, an estate sale is <u>in</u> the home, not outdoors.

A yard sale involves selling miscellaneous household and garden items, usually takes place in the garage/car port, on the driveway, or on the yard and are held for one or two days. The sale is usually run by the owners and they set up the items, price, and sell them. The items being sold are generally low in value.

One key difference to mention is where they are advertised. Estate Sales are advertised on estate sale listing websites, estate liquidator websites, social media, and print media. Yard sales are usually advertised by hand writing on poster board tacked up on poles, (where permitted), in a local newspaper, and on occasion on websites specifically for yard or garage sales.

Well, aren't you glad we sorted that out? How does all of this relate to the occasional yard sale we see here? The <u>Paradise Island Rules and Regulations</u> you all received, in Chapter XIII, para. 9, states: "Yard sales [also called garage, car port, moving, or tag sales] are not allowed unless approved by Co-Op BOD/Management." OK, that is not meant to be an impediment to any resident who wants to run one of these sales, or a classical <u>in-home</u> estate sale, as defined above. Please drop into the office, fill out the permission form, acknowledge some very common-sense ground rules, and await (quick) approval. What are these ground rules? The sale must not conflict with another previously approved competing park function; it has to respect your neighbors, it must be conducted in such a manner that the adjacent street and sidewalk are not partially or completely blocked by vehicles or sale attendees, and yard sale items must be confined to the seller's home, driveway, or yard.
