s most of you know we have several ponds in our community. What most of you don't know is that our ponds are connected with the storm drains throughout our community. What that means is that when you throw your garbage bottles, cups, leaves, etc. down the storm drains it comes out into our ponds.

I live on pond #5 which has been drained to be able to repair some issues with the pipes. As the big pump trucks came through the community I watched them pump the storm drain next door to me and could see the empty bottles and garbage being pumped right into the pond. I am one of the residents on this pond who tries to keep the pond cleaned out each week so that our beautiful swan is not swimming with everyone's trash. I don't appreciate cleaning up everyone else's trash because they feel they can't carry it home to deposit in their own trash can.

When you are walking in our community and enjoying a drink but happen to finish it before you have finished your walk, please be kind to your fellow residents and take it home with you. We had to have a new pump installed in our fountain twice in the past 2 years because of plastic garbage bags being put in the storm drains or thrown into the pond. This is a very costly expense that doesn't have to happen. When the Co-Op has to continue to put money into items like this it will eventually effect everyone in the community.

I am privileged to be able to live here and respect that the property will be here long after I am gone. If everyone just takes a minute to remember how lucky we are we can stop this practice of disposal in its tracks.

### **Pond Update From the Co-Op**

he Paradise Island Co-op board of directors want to provide an explanation of what has been going on with the ponds. We first had a concern come to the attention of the management office involving a large area of land in front of a home on Martinique. When we looked at this home, we contacted the company that we have used in the past for these type of problems. When they began work they observed a "36 inch" storm pipe that was



cracked from a tree root and was starting to give way. The company Aiden Park replaced the pipe and it is now completed. Shortly after that, we received another concern of standing water in-between homes on pond 6. Aiden Park inspected the area and found it to be another storm drain pipe in need of repair. In order to repair this pipe, we had to partially drain pond. Upon draining the pond, we found that there were more issues with the storm pipes than pond 6. Us-

ing a diver, Aiden Park went into the pipes with cameras and discovered all the pipes that connect ponds 5, 6, 7 had issues and some homes where near these pipes so it became an emergency matter. All three ponds were drained enough to have Aiden Park go into the drains and inspect to make sure all issues were addressed. Upon completion, there were concerns about how the water would be replaced in the ponds. Based on recommendations



of American Eco. 's President Kevin Youngberg we believe the best thing for the ponds at this time is to let nature take its course. As of today 5-16-2019, all emergency issues are completed.

Residents, please be aware that the office will not be allowing requests for fencing at this time. We are working on getting this situation of fencing resolved as soon as possible. We will let you know when fences will be permitted once again. We had a visit to the office from the City of Largo Code Enforcement. They were very nice and explained that residents have been placing items that are not recyclable. The items that are not allowed would be the envelopes with bubble wrap inside. The bubble wrap cannot be recycled so please do not place them in the recycling. Also, boxes need to be broken down and NO Styrofoam is allowed. If we need to start monitoring this I will have no issue handing out violations. I have also seen residents parking cars and trucks on the sidewalks, this is something that needs to stop. When I am out doing inspections I will be looking for vehicles that are entirely on the sidewalks and will be sending a violation. The Rules and Regulations states that; vehicles cannot park on sidewalks. It is rule number XI. Number 2. I hope that all residents try to abide by the rules and regulations to make everyone happy in our little world of Paradise Island.



Robo-calls from the office for all emergencies like water breaks, etc.

The hurricane season is upon us. It is imperative that the office has your right phone number to reach you. The number of the person on your deed is not always the best number to reach you. Please make sure you go to the office and check which number they have and ask them to change it if need be. This should answer questions asked at our last meeting regarding this matter.

Friendly reminder: There is NO smoking in the pool area. You can use the pavilion on the left of the pool by the pond. Also please do not use the club house entrance to access the pool. The club house from the pool area should be use only if you have to utilize the restrooms. Let's be careful about water on the floors, it makes them very slippery and can create a dangerous situation. Be safe.

Safety tips for this month:

- 1. Always lock your car while driving. Do not put your pocketbook on the seat next to you, that's the window thieves will break to steal it. Leave it next to you by the door or on the back seat floor.
- 2. When you stop, leave enough space to see the back tires of the car in front of you.
- 3. If someone walks towards you (more likely not good news, not looking for directions anymore now everyone has either a GPS or cell phone) you have enough room to go around the car and leave.
- 4. GPS if someone gets hold of your GPS for HOME enter the police station address so they won't know where you live. Use a different name on your address list for your home.
