SCAMS AND FRAUDS

From Largo Police Crime Bulletin

#1 – Secret Shopper Scam

Mystery shopping has been among the top scams for a long time, and it keeps working because there are actually legitimate mystery shopping companies out there. The way to tell a scam from the real thing, though, comes down to whether or not you have to pay any money to sign up, receive lists of stores, or set up your own mystery shopping jobs. But there's a new take on it, and it combines the work-from-home scam with a money laundering scam. In the version reported this week, the victim was paid with a personal check and told that the shopping job involved depositing the check into her bank account, keeping \$500 for completing the job, then wiring the remaining \$1600 to another person via Money gram. If the victim had followed through, the original personal check would have bounced and the \$1600 money wire would have been taken out of the victim's bank account. There is no legitimate reason why you should ever receive a check and then turn around and send a portion of those funds to someone else. It is a known front for criminal activity and financial fraud.

#2 – Bad Check Scam

This scam plays upon your fears of criminal action after informing you that you've broken the law. The victim received a letter that appeared to be official, informing him that he had bounced two checks. It went on to say that there were now bad check charges filed against him, and if he did not pay the amount of the checks plus his court fees, he would be arrested. Here's the catch: the letter stated that the only way to pay the fine was with a certified check. The victim couldn't transfer money from his savings account to cover the checks, for example, or go down to the police station and pay in cash. Whenever you're given only one payment option—and it's an untraceable method, like prepaid debit cards or money wires—that should cause you to think twice. A quick phone call to your bank will let you know if you're the target of a scam or not.

#3 – Ransom ware Scam

Ransom ware is a form of cyber attack that can affect anything from a Fortune 500 company's network to the Smartphone in your pocket. There are a variety of different ways that your technology could have become infected, but the end result is still that a scammer is holding your device or computer for "ransom." It happens when you've accidentally installed some malicious software. A box or screen appears that tells you your computer is infected, and nothing you do seems to fix it. If you call the phone number or go to the website to fix it, you're told to pay a fee to "clean" your system. Sometimes these messages seem to come from a legitimate source, like Microsoft informing you that your network is compromised and they can repair it; other versions have been far more sinister, as in a hacker actually stating he was responsible for this and will only remove it if you pay up. The most important thing to do is never give in to the demand. If you cannot unlock your system yourself, take it to a computer repair office and see what can be done. Turning over your credit card number to a scammer in order to remove the issue only gives them your financial information, and may not even remove the problem.

It's worth noting that IRS Imposter Scams are still topping the list of reports to the BBB, and that isn't likely to change until well after tax season. In the meantime, take a look at some of their other recent top scams or fraud attempts.



have found that there are a number of our residents who do not even know that we have this fund or they have no true idea of what and how it works. I pray that I can explain in enough Letail here to educate every resident of Paradise Island about the care we have for our own. I must first assure everyone that this is the "Paradise Island Outreach Fund!" Not the Paradise Island Church in the Park Outreach, or the church Outreach fund. It is its own entity. The Paradise Island Outreach Fund stands alone. The fund IS administered by the Church in the Park. There are several reasons for this, the chief being that it is covered under the church's Non-Profit status. Financially they are totally separate. Each has its own banking account, accounting and disclosure requirements. The "Funds" and the "Church's" moneys cannot and do not inter-mingle. Neither one can be used for the other with the one exception that the "Church" pays one half of its tithe to the "Fund". I cannot over emphasize that the "funds" money has nothing to do with the church! When you give to the Paradise Island Outreach Fund, 100% of that gift is used for the residents of your community, "Paradise Island." The "Fund" has no fees, compensation, or bills other than you, as a resident, needs. This is the only benevolence fund that I know of that 100% is returned to those to whom it is intended. Yes we use Godly principles in order to be good stewards of your money. But to my knowledge there has never been any discrimination due to race, color, creed, religion, or anything I can think of. We do investigate each need on an individual basis and our giving is to meet what we believe to be a



true need. We DO NOT deal with cash! All gifts have a paper trail, i.e. a check to Duke Energy, etc. However, we can issue food gift cards and are considering gas gift cards as well. These are tracked by name and lot #. All information about the dealings between the administrators and those in need are covered under the ministerial confidentially principle. I will not even disclose too you who gave me your name or lot # without the express permission of the giver. I hold this confidentially responsibility very dear and consider it a great privilege to be allowed to hold this position. Therefore, any conversation, donation, receiving of a gift, or any matter you deal

appreciated by someone in this park. Donations can be given in any form to me or any member of the Church in the Park. Please designate all gifts to the Outreach Fund. 

Swift action averts a serious water problem

Tithin the last month, the fresh water supply within Paradise Island was shut down due to accidental damage to a couple of main conduits that supply it to our community. Fortunately, neither was serious enough to cause long term disruption, nor was the water contaminated as a result. In the both cases, the quick and efficient response by the maintenance staff and others eliminated major damage and reduced the down time considerably. The workmen are to be commended for their effort on behalf of our community. The inconvenience to the residents was minimized because of their swift response.

The citizens of Flint, Michigan weren't so fortunate. Because the local, state, and federal governing bodies ignored, denied, and covered up their water problem a state of emergency resulted. Essentially, the toxic levels of contamination in their precious water necessary for the survival of its citizens was ignored since April of 2014. In place of "sweeping it under the rug," the so-called leaders allowed the water to "flow under the bridge" resulting in the resignation of at least four.

The crisis is far from over. In the fall of 2015, General Motors cancelled it contract to purchase water from Flint because the high levels of chloride "could corrode engine parts." Imagine what it must be doing to the citizens of Flint. If the Governor had approved the mere \$50,000 annual cost to add phosphorous to the water the problem potentially could have been resolved. Instead, Governor Rick Snyder is planning to have the state of Michigan provide Flint with a \$28 million grant to resolve the issue. What were they thinking?

Now, Paradise Island is no Flint, Michigan, but it doesn't mean it can't have contaminated water if measures aren't taken to recognize the possibility. So far, so good. Perhaps the time is right to begin a dialogue between the officers of the HOA and the CO-OP, including representatives of the city of Largo's water department, to set in motion a plan for, a) getting a better understanding of potential water problems, b) steps that can be taken to anticipate a water crisis, and c) some method of informing the residents if and when a water problem (or other community matter of seriousness) arises. There must be a way to network effectively within the community. Brainstorming will bring about good results.

Again, a sincere 'thank you' for the rapid response of our maintenance crew and others for preventing a serious problem and an extended period of time without potable water. While most of us were sleeping, these workmen responded and got the job done without much fanfare. We should all be grateful and make it a point to express appreciation.




