Directions: left out of the park – left on Ulmerton, pass Taco Bell, make a U-turn and Department of Health will be on your right hand side or b) you can get it free from Walmart/Publix if your doctor gives you a letter saying that due to your health you need one, if you do not have a letter from your doctor, you will have to pay a small fee.

presentations given by the Largo Fire Department. The Co-Op President, Pat Humphries, and HOA President, Mary Ross are currently planning additional presentations Education is key to Prevention.

Safety tips:

Lockbox key – If you use a deadbolt, first responders will get to you in case of an emergency, but may have to cause some damages to do so. In order to avoid this eventuality, you can buy a combination lockbox key (Home Depot/Lowes), put an extra house key inside and call the fire department at 727-587-6737 to give them your combination. Easy installation on your outside railing, etc.

Thope everyone had a wonderful summer. We are now in full swing to fall and winter. Our friends from the north will be arriving soon or have already begun to arrive. Welcome back Leveryone! With that said, it also brings leaves and other yard debris questions and problems. Please remember that all bags should not be too heavy for our garbage crew to pick-up. I understand that everyone wants to save on bags and think they are Hercules when they lift the bag and it doesn't seem heavy, but remember the garbage crew isn't just picking up a few bags at your home. They do the entire park in one day! I have also been hearing that bags are not being tied before being put out for pick up. As well as using shopping bags as garbage bags, this is not acceptable. Please make sure they are tied it helps when the garbage crew is tossing them into the truck and compactor. We are still asking that only 5 bags of yard waste be placed outside each pick up day to help with space in the compactor. I have been hearing that it is too cold in the clubhouse, I would like to explain how the system works so that you have a better understanding to why it may seem or feel colder. First, the system that is in the clubhouse is a ZONE A/C & Heating system. Meaning that each area has a zone and they are all connected to the main zone. If one area let's say the small hall is reading 73 degrees but the big hall is reading 76 degrees the only zone that would be working is the big hall at 76 degrees to keep it regulated on the set temperature of 76 degrees. The small hall would not come on until it reached the set temperature of 76 degrees. This is a very beneficial system that will save up to 30% in electric costs each year. We have placed lock boxes on the thermostats to insure







VETERAN'S CORNER

1. A nationwide smoking ban outside all Department of Veterans Affairs medical facilities applying to visitors, patients and employees is creating controversy. A third of veteran's smoke, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and many were introduced to



- the habit while serving. Tobacco long has been tied to military: Cigarette ads featured troops, and the culture of the service historically promoted smoking on the battlefield or as a welcome respite from the stress of combat.
- 2. Smoking was already prohibited inside VA medical buildings, but now patients, employees and visitors will not be able to puff away anywhere on the grounds. Previously, smoking was allowed in designated shelters dotting the grounds of VA medical facilities. Posters and banners promoting the ban have been put up in facilities and the VA is alerting veterans through social media and letters. "This is a really good thing for our veterans and our staff," said Kevin Forrest, associate director of the Manchester VA in New Hampshire, which serves 27,000 veterans. "It's a safer environment. It reduces fire risk. There is certainly evidence that smoking and second-hand exposure is a medical risk for our veterans."
- 3. The smoking ban was first announced this summer. It brings the facilities in line with bans already in place at 4,000 medical facilities and four national health care systems that have made their grounds smoke-free. But some veterans see the move as draconian. Many Veterans are upset.
- 4. Regardless of pushback, the ban is happening. Over the coming months, it is gradually implementing the ban for the 62,000 veterans it serves, including providing resources that could help veterans kick the habit. Violators will initially be warned of the policy and eventually VA police will enforce it. But even a gradual rollout is seen as too stringent for some smokers, even some veterans who don't smoke. They argue that there should be some place for smoking at VA facilities and fear that some veterans may choose cigarettes or cigars over visiting their VA doctors.
