Report from the Shareholders' Meeting September 17, 2014

During the course of the recent meeting, President Knowles opened the floor to any questions the members cared to ask. The following Q and A may be of interest to all residents.

Q: Regarding a tree in a member's yard that she deemed dangerous, what must she do to have the tree removed?

A: Office Manager Nancy Perry explained what needed to be done and invited the member to come to the office for a full explanation of the process.

Q: Could we ask the city of Largo to paint a centerline on Willow coming into the park?

A: We have tried on numerous occasions to get the city to paint a line on Willow without success.

Q: Are there any plans to erect a white vinyl fence around the rest of the park?

A: There are no current plans. A couple of years ago we sought bids to see what a vinyl fence would cost around the entire perimeter. At that time the cost was well over \$100,000 and we did not have the funds then or now to undertake such a project. What we hope to do, as it becomes necessary, is to replace the old fencing with a better grade of wood fence or with a vinyl fence as appropriate. Members who have a concern regarding the fence on their property should come to the office and fill out a form stating those concerns and we will have our maintenance department look into the situation.

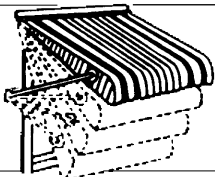

Stopping Safely in Case of Emergency (Part Two)

In the September issue of the Planet, I tackled the issue of speed, braking, and stopping of an automobile. My purpose was to bring an awareness to the control of a vehicle under adverse conditions. The response from several residents was very positive. A few took issue with the data from which I developed the examples. Notwithstanding, most readers came away with a better understanding of what it takes to stop a vehicle in an emergency.

An incident, which took place on the morning of September 25, at 6:45am, has given me a reason to follow-up with this article. It happened as 'Steve' an elderly gentleman, was driving south on Hamlin Boulevard, after turning off of Walsingham, on his way to daily 7:00 Mass at St. Jerome church. He was driving within the speed limit as he approached the entrance to the church parking lot. As a daily communicant, 'Steve' was very cognizant of the proper entrance.

On this morning, however, the lighted sign at the entrance to the lot was not working, causing a condition of total darkness. He took what he thought was his natural left-hand turn. Suddenly, without warning, he realized he had missed the turn. Immediately, he reacted by hitting his brakes. His car, a new model Cadillac, skidded directly into a retention pond and submerged. Try to imagine the panic and shock 'Steve' went through. He didn't know what hit him.

Within seconds, by Divine Intervention, two men who witnessed the incident dove into the pond in pitch darkness and managed to extricate 'Steve' from his car. A third man called 911 immediately. The reaction of the local fire department and EMT's was swift. 'Steve' was whisked

Ironically, this miraculous incident was not given one mention from the local TV or radio news, nor was there ever a mention of it in the press. Of course, we all know good news does not warrant mention, nor did those whom acted spontaneously by sacrificing themselves for another human being receive any recognition.

As I write this, 'Steve' remains in the hospital but is recovering. He suffered from shock, some bodily injuries, and debris from the pond that entered into his body. He is expected to survive. Whether he will ever drive a vehicle again is another matter.

I thought readers of the Planet would appreciate this follow-up article, and reread and heed the message of the September issue. 'Steve' was a very fortunate man. His Guardian Angel was by his side turning a crisis into a blessing.

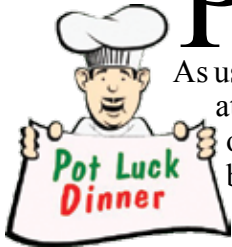


November Community Potluck

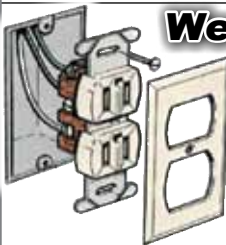

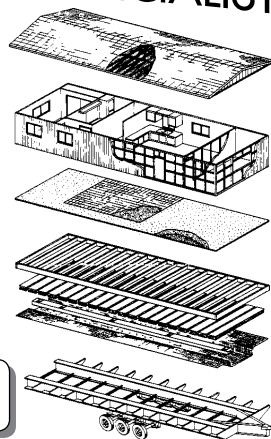

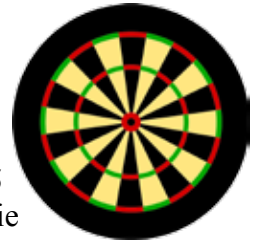
