Teighbors, as I sit here writing this article, we are 2 days into the recovery efforts from the worst storm our state has seen in 57 years to the exact day. A storm of this magnitude can wipe out everything and everyone in its path. I want to thank all the residents who listened to The Pinellas County Emergency Management Team and left the park to shelters and hotels when the mandatory evacuation order went out. I have been unable to explain to anyone how in the world our beautiful park and all of our homes were spared from destruction. I can only give thanks to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ for sending his Angels to cover our park and spare us from harm. We are still without power, it is very hot and sticky, no ice to have a cool drink, and no lights after dark.

After the storm, so many of our members from out of state and in Canada became frantic trying to reach anyone to hear the status of their home. Remember, the Co-Op is responsible for Paradise Island and the management office. They are the first call you should make. Thank you to park resident Deb Warren-Hite for creating a face book page called Paradise Island Friends. The page has been a tremendous help to keep residents informed. I urge everyone to friend the

page to stay in touch.

I want to thank park residents Ed and Kim Massimiano. As the storm approached, they kept us informed hour by hour, of what was happening in Largo. After the storm, they went through the park street by street and posted videos and pictures of the damages. Then they went into action helping with the clean-up effort. The one thing I kept hearing from Ed is we need to remind our owners who leave for the summer to take all their garden statues and flags and anything else that can be a missile during a storm and put them away before they leave. He went through the park picking up flags, metal lawn ornaments, etc. If you are missing any of these items, chances are they were found damaged and many streets away. If anyone has any questions about the damages from the storm, please call the Co-Op office.

We hope things get back to normal as quickly as possible so we can resume our normal activities. We invite our residents to join us on Thursdays in the clubhouse for Bingo, and please invite a friend. Our meeting of the HOA is the first Wednesday of the month at 7PM, coffee and

donuts served at 6PM. We look forward to seeing everyone at the next meeting.
