If you have a common name, you may receive multiple alerts because it will not distinguish one name from another. The hurricane season is about three fourths done. We had a good dress rehearsal at the beginning of September. Gratefully we were spared but let's keep our guards up and have everything ready until the end of November.

If you missed the presentation on August 19th about Hurricane & Fire Safety given by Summer Mahr, Public Educator, Largo Fire Rescue, you can go to: <u>www.pinellascounty.org/</u><u>alertpinellas</u> to get copies of the many flyers distributed.

It is important to remember that our community is Zone A in the event of an evacuation, we <u>MUST</u> evacuate.

FREE to all residents: Smoke alarm – the fire department will replace and install it for you.

No need to replace the batteries, the batteries are good for 10 years and your smoke alarm should be replaced every 10 years. If you have a hard wired one (electric) they won't furnish the alarm but will give you a battery operated one for free, so you will have 2 in case the power goes out.

Fire extinguishers – should be replaced every 5-7 years. To dispose of it, you can contact the company listed on it and inquire about how to do it.

It is unfortunate how some residents do not share the feeling of fellowship or the idea of being neighborly. In order to continue to live in harmony, everyone should be respectful and courteous towards each other. We cannot allow the behavior of a few to determine the ambience and quality of life here at Paradise Island. Quote: "Rumors are carried by haters, spread by fools and accepted by idiots." False rumors can be to the point of slander.
