### A Little Consideration, Please

Recently, I waited to say "Hi" to one of our PI staff persons on Garbage pick-up day as he was coming around. He stopped several houses away and picked up a garbage bag to toss it in his trailer when the bag opened up and scattered garbage over him and the ground. He stopped to brush himself off and pick up the mess. It seems that the bag was untied. As we commiserated he said that this often happens at that house; he usually stops to see if the bags are tied but on that day he didn't check. I told him that I thought that was terrible and he replied that there are 30 or 40 out of the over 800 homes in the park that regularly violate the simple, common-sense rules concerning putting out garbage and trash. I said that they should just leave the mess for the homeowner to pick up and he said that that doesn't work as the homeowners file a complaint at the office and they are sent back out to pick up the mess. At best, they leave a note for the offending home owners that set out the rules.

We were all given, and are bound by, the park Rules and Regulations document that has a section on garbage and trash in Chapter XII. The following is a reproduction of the simpler format note that the maintenance guys leave where needed. C'mon neighbors, this really is a "Golden Rule" situation, let's have A LITTLE CONSIDERATION, PLEASE.

DO's & DON'Ts OF GARBAGE AND TRASH

Garbage must be out by 8 A.M.

 $\overline{DO}$ 

1 Do tie your trash bags.

2 Do have them by the curb—not up the driveway.

3 Do place garbage in a real garbage can with a tight lid if you must leave it out the night before.

4 Do break down all cardboard boxes.

DON'T

- 1 Do not over fill garbage bags as this makes them too heavy and they will tear. This also includes leaves and dirt.
  - 2 Do not use boxes as garbage bags.
  - 3 Do not use storage bags as garbage bags.
  - 4 Do not put newspapers in garbage bags. Take them to the clubhouse recycle bin.
  - 5 Do not put garbage or trash outside the compactor compound at any time.
  - 6 Do not use grocery store bags for garbage.

SPECIAL NOTES!

NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES, PROPANE TANKS, TIRES, PAINT, OR CHEMICALS. These must be taken to the Pinellas County Hazardous Collection Site. For information on mobile collection of these items call (727)-464-7500 or visit www.pinellascounty.org/utilities.

Brush must be no longer than 4 feet in length, tied in bundles that are not too heavy to be picked up and tossed into the truck.

No carpet/padding, furniture, or any construction debris will be picked up. Either the contractor or resident must dispose of these items.





### **Craft Fair 10 Commandments**

raft fairs can be your best friend or your worst enemy. Before you spend all the time and money applying for fairs, buying booths, and making product, read through these guidelines from our contributor Vicki O'Dell. She's pulled together the top things you need to know before heading out to sell at your next craft fair.

- 1. Read through all information sent to you regarding the show making note of set-up times and procedures. Make sure you understand all requirements and obligations regarding the show. File all related paperwork so that you can refer to it again just before the craft show. Getting in touch with the show coordinators right before the show is hard to do as they are working very hard to set up the show and extremely inconvenient for them. If you do have legitimate questions make sure to make a list of them so that you only call once.
- 2. Always stay open until the very end of the show. Packing your booth early sends the message to customers that the show is over and shopping is done. It also irritates your fellow craft show vendors. Just because you think you may not make a last minute sale doesn't mean they won't. I can't count the number of sales I've had at the 11th hour because someone saw something in my booth earlier in the day and had to have my doodad before they left the show. As tired as you are and as anxious as you may be to be on your way... wait.
- 3. Keep a positive attitude at all times. Settle any disagreements, whether with the show organizers, a customer or your spouse, away from the booth. Be positive with your fellow vendors (even if you aren't a big fan of them or what they are selling) and customers. A positive attitude sets the tone in your booth and surrounding areas making shopping much more pleasant. You may not be the only one selling purple doodads but you can be the NICEST person selling purple doodads.
- 4. Create a booth that is inviting and pleasing to the eye. Keep boxes and packaging out of view and keep your space clean and tidy including during set up. Make sure all table coverings are laundered before the show if needed. Make sure your tent is clean and in good repair. Visit retail stores while designing your booth set-up or a visit with a friend who is an interior designer for inspiration.
- 5. Do some of your own marketing for the show in advance. If every vendor reached out to their friends, family, social media circles etc. it would benefit every vendor at the show. If you received flyers be sure to hand them out.
- 6. Stay focused on what you are doing selling and tending to customers. Visit with family and friends in the food court, leave your children with a babysitter, eat your meals away from the booth and give your shoppers 100% of your attention. Shoppers don't want to interrupt your conversation or your breakfast to purchase an item.
- 7. Be professional. Dress nicely and keep advertising, political or off color humor to a minimum on your clothing, buttons, etc. Unless it's that kind of show. Dressing nicely lends and air of quality to the items you sell.

- 8. Talk to people in a general, friendly manner no "hard sells" please. Comment on their clothing, jewelry, or the weather. Don't sit in the back corner of your space and expect customers to hunt for you. Be present. Pay attention to the people around you.
- 9. Be respectful of your neighboring vendors. Keep smells to a minimum, even if you are selling candles you don't have to light them all. One will do. If you must play music keep it quiet so that only the people in your booth with hear it. Stay within your defined space, be aware of what neighbors are selling and be willing to "spell" them if they need a bathroom break. This helps everyone's sales and crates goodwill among fellow creatives.
- 10. Network. Use set up time, the time before the show opens or just after the show closes to network with fellow crafters. You might learn of another show you didn't know about before, find a better hotel rate, or find out where the best bathrooms are. Hand out business cards or flyers to anyone interested. After the show, send out emails, visit blogs and leave comments and promote artists or crafters that you connected with in your social media circles.

Not all craft shows are rainbows and unicorns. Eventually you will have a show that, for one reason or 10 reasons, just doesn't go well. It will pay to keep these 10 Commandments in mind no matter what happens. You just never know... If you are doing several local shows people will remember you and recognize you from show to show. Play your cards well, create products your customers love and treat them well and it won't be long before they will be searching for your business name on the vendor list. You just never know... If you travel to shows you are likely part of a group of vendors who see one another from event to event. Being kind, going out of your way to be helpful and having a positive attitude makes life easier for everyone.

You just never know... where a new client, customer or friend might come from.

UNTSVILLE, Ala - The Better Business Bureau is reporting that Instagram has now become the newest target of scammers. They are using this social media platform to phish account login information from Instagram users.

Reports indicate that users are receiving notifications that a friend has added them to the so called "Ugly List" with a link to click on the post. Once they click on the link and enter their Instagram login as prompted, this gives scammers access to their account along with any other associated personal information.

The takeaway here is, if you receive a notification that you have been added to the "Ugly List," don't believe it. Think about how your real friend normally communicates with you via Insta-gram, and if a posting seems unusual, be very cautious. Your friend's profile could have al-ready been stolen.

If the post or picture is sensational, be wary. This could simply be a hook to lure you into click-ing on a malicious link or revealing your login information.

Never click on any links associated with unsolicited posts, notifications, emails, or texts; and turn on the safe search feature on your internet browser or virus/malware application.

And last, be sure that your firewall is active on your computer.





### The cephalopods are coming

on't look now, but cephalopods are on the rise. A team of scientists have determined that cephalopods—sea-dwellers including mollusks, squid, cuttlefish, and octopuses—are increasing their numbers below the waves.

As reported on the Sci-News website, scientists at the University of Adelaide created a database of catch rates for 35 species of cephalopods from 1953 to 2013. They found that cephalopod populations have increased across three distinct groups since the 1950s.

The sea creatures are able to adapt to environmental changes quickly due to their short lifespans, rapid growth, and life-history plasticity. Their growing numbers could have both positive and negative effects: increased pressure on the undersea species they hunt for prey, but also benefits for marine predators who in turn hunt them, as well as humans who harvest them from the sea for food.



### Chinese brewed beer in ancient times

rafts beers are thriving these days, but beer has been around for a long time, scientists say. Researchers in the United States and China have revealed that the Chinese brewed their own beer some 5,000 years ago, much earlier than previously believed.

As reported on the Voice of America website, archaeologists have uncovered brewing equipment in underground rooms in China's central plain region. Traces of ingredients found on the equipment suggests that the ancient brewmasters used a recipe of broomcorn millet, barley, a grain called Job's tears or Chinese pearl barley, and a form of tuber to brew their beverage. The presence of barley 1,000 years before it was believed to have been grown in China suggests that it might have been brought in from other regions, making beer an ingredient in early trade.

Researchers describe the possible taste of the beer as "a bit sour and a bit sweet."
