In the Rules and Regulations; Part IV. Manufactured home sites, Number 8. All trees located on resident's unit, or planted by the resident on their unit, are the responsibility of the resident. If the tree is on the city's side and the branch is hanging over onto their property and is close to wires they need to inform the office so that we can contact the proper authorities to handle the situation to resolve the issue. If all residents help each other by monitoring their surroundings and inform the office we can take care of the issue. If you see a problem with a tree branch please contact the office so we can look into it. Please also be aware of this time of year for hurricanes. Make sure that if you are leaving for any amount of time this summer to store all objects that could fly away and become a projectile to move them inside. If there is a hurricane coming you will be informed if you are to evacuate. If you are told to evacuate please don't wait to leave, it is better to be on the safe side and leave as soon as possible. I am seeing many homes looking beautiful and that is always nice to see. I still am working diligently on homes that are in need of work and the residents are notified as soon as possible. Thank you for attention to these matters and hope all is going well here for you in Paradise.

 $\succ$  that if you have a fire caused by a power surge, your homeowner insurance may not pay, check with your homeowners' insurance to make certain you are covered for a loss in the event of power surges.

 $\succ$  termites can destroy your house without your knowledge. By the time you discover the problem, the damage can be extensive. It is a good idea to have your house inspected for termites yearly.
