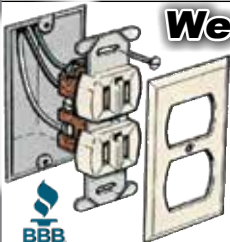

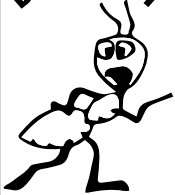

## **As a reminder to the Paradise Island residents:**

*By Brian Wade*

---

- Pool/Spa (Hot Tub) hours are 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Pool/spa closings for maintenance will be posted.
- Children under the age of eighteen (18) may use the pool ONLY between the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and MUST BE accompanied by an adult at all times.
- There is NO LIFEGUARD on duty at the pool. Do not swim alone. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- No soap or shampoo is allowed when taking a shower before or after leaving the pool. All persons must rinse under the shower before entering the pool.
- Applying sunscreen products in the pool is prohibited. Chairs must be covered when using sunscreen products.
- No toys, inner tubes, or rafts are permitted in the pool except pool noodles. ADA additional flotation devices must be attached to the body of the disabled person.
- No children are permitted in the pool that are not toilet trained. No young children are permitted in the pool in diapers or swimmer pants. Non-swimming children must use an approved flotation device and be accompanied by a responsible person in the water at all times.
- Any person with incontinence problems will not be permitted in pool. No adult incontinence products are permitted in the pool.
- People with shoulder-length hair or longer must have hair confined in a barrette or rubber band or wear a bathing cap.
- The Corporation will not be held responsible to Residents or their guests for any injuries or lost articles.
- When using any of the on-ground chairs or lounges, they must be returned to their original place before leaving. Users must put umbrellas down when leaving the pool area. There is no reserving of chairs, tables or lounges at the pool; they are on a first come, first served basis.
- Beverages (both alcoholic and non-alcoholic) may be consumed in the pool area, but not within four (4) feet of the water or in the water. No glass containers are allowed. All trash must be placed in receptacles provided.
- No equipment shall be removed from deck area.
- No pets are permitted in the pool or patio area.
- No one under the age of 16 can use the hot tub at any time.
- No smoking is permitted in the pool area. Smoking is permitted in the picnic pavilion provided there is no event being held in the pavilion. This rule applies to any device that emits smoke or vapors.
- No bicycles are permitted in the pool area. Bicycles must be parked at the bicycle stand.
- Host Resident must accompany Guest/s to the pool.

## Social Committee Updates

**I**t looks like we are finally on the downside of the virus. We are now reporting only one half of the cases daily that we had last month. If this turn continues we may be able to open up more activities in September sometime. As of this moment we are still on hold. Stay tuned for updates on Channel 732 and we will post on Positively Paradise as well as PIFAN for you.

Social distancing prohibits us from doing most of our activities. We have opened the pool room for up to 4 players at a time. ### **Nature at Home: Creeper vs. Ivy**

By Pam Stover

Taking a walk in the woods, around the neighborhood, or even in your yard, you might see two very similar vines: Virginia creeper and poison ivy. They look alike, often grow together and are often confused. Knowing how to positively identify these two vines can come in very handy.

Virginia creeper (*Parthenocissus quinquefolia*) is generally green in spring and summer, turning bright red in fall and winter in the colder part of its range. The mature plant has 5 leaves, but young plants sometimes have only three. The plant produces dark berries in the fall, which

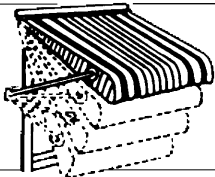

## VETERAN'S CORNER

The Senate overwhelmingly approved an addition to its defense policy bill to expand the Department of Veterans Affairs' list of diseases considered related to exposure to Agent Orange, adding bladder cancer, hypothyroidism and Parkinsonism. The measure's passage sets up a debate between the House and Senate over the issue when the two chambers reconcile the differences in their respective versions of the defense bill. In last-minute discussions this week, a similar provision was omitted from the House bill. The Senate passed the amendment 94-6. Members are set to vote on the entire bill later this week. Sen. Jon Tester of Montana, the ranking Democrat on the Senate Armed Services Committee who sponsored the bill, said Tuesday that justice for these veterans "was long overdue." "Our sacred duty is to care for those who are wounded. We have refused to cover illnesses such as bladder cancer, hypothyroidism and Parkinsonism. [The VA] doesn't seem to think that exposure to these toxic chemicals in Vietnam is a cost of war. Let me tell you, they are wrong," he said in a speech on the Senate floor before the vote. If signed into law, the provision would expand VA health care eligibility and disability benefits to roughly 22,000 affected veterans. Former service members with these illnesses have been waiting since 2016 for a decision from the VA on whether the department would expand its list of 14 conditions to include the three new ones. That year, the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering and Medicine found that there is suggestive or sufficient evidence that the three diseases are associated with exposure to herbicides used

during the Vietnam War.

In 2018, the Academies concluded that "sufficient evidence" also exists linking hypertension and related illnesses in veterans to Agent Orange and other defoliants. The proposal that passed the Senate did not include hypertension, however. The condition is common among the elderly and, if it had been included, may have added more than two million veterans to VA disability rolls in the next 10 years, at an estimated cost of \$11.2 billion to \$15.2 billion, according to the VA. The decision not to include hypertension in the legislation this time was a compromise, and lawmakers and advocacy groups have pledged to keep pushing for it to be included. In 2017, then-VA Secretary David Shulkin expressed support for including bladder cancer, hypothyroidism and Parkinsonism on the list of presumptive diseases, but he never formally announced his decision. According to internal VA documents, Shulkin had been on the verge of including the three conditions when the Office of Management and Budget and other White House officials objected, citing what they called "limited scientific evidence" and cost. Meanwhile, thousands of veterans have waited. "The fact of the matter is that this administration -- the Trump administration -- has refused to expand the list of presumptive health conditions associated with Agent Orange," Tester said. He sponsored the legislation in the Senate. On the House side, the amendment was promoted by Rep. Joshua Harder, D-California. It passed the House Armed Services Committee but was struck from the bill by the House Rules Committee, which decided that it did not include a requisite way to cover its cost, called a "pay -for." A source close to the process said that the Congressional Budget Office provided an informal assessment of the cost of Harder's amendment that was in the "tens of billions," while the assessment given to Tester's office was "\$10 billion." The source questioned the \$10 billion price tag. "The cost is not going to increase. We are losing these people every day. There may be some spousal benefits, but the sad thing is, they also are of an age where they are going too," said the source, who spoke on background as he was not authorized to discuss the issue.

VA Secretary Robert Wilkie told lawmakers late last year he wants the results of two studies -- the Vietnam Era Health Retrospective Observational Study, or VE-HEROES, and the Vietnam Era Mortality Study -- to be reviewed for publication before announcing a decision on whether to broaden the presumptive list. The VA began recognizing diseases associated with herbicide exposure in Vietnam in 1991, naming 14 diseases as presumed to be linked to exposure, including Hodgkin's disease, multiple myeloma, non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, early-onset peripheral neuropathy, porphyria cutanea tarda, prostate cancer, respiratory cancers, soft-tissue sarcoma, chloracne, type-2 diabetes mellitus, light chain amyloidosis, ischemic heart disease, chronic B-cell leukemias, Parkinson's disease.
