UPDATE ON THE SPECTRUM PLAN

The Spectrum Plan is moving along as expected. We received a draft contract from Spectrum that we submitted to our attorney. He subsequently marked up the draft with his thoughts and submitted that marked up draft to Spectrum. As of 3/15, that is where the project stands. We expect to get a final draft of the contract the week of 3/19, which will be submitted to our attorney. It is likely that the Co-Op board will vote on the contracts the week of 3/26. If that timing holds the contract will become effective 4/2. There will then be approximately a 60 days period where Spectrum will do the necessary internal work to effect the transition. Again, if that timing holds, the Plan would be implemented for all residents in early June. I'll try to keep you up-to-date in subsequent Planet articles. The Management Office

- 1. If your phone number has changed we need the new number for our records and to update the emergency notification system.
- 2. If your emergency contact has changed their number or you wish to change the emergency contact on record in the office.
- 3. If you have added a dog to your family. We need to have all records of shots and information on dog as well as paperwork that we have for you to fill out.
- 4. THE NAME OF THE PERSON TAKING CARE OF YOUR HOME WHEN YOU ARE GONE.

<u>This is very important information</u>. We need to know who to contact during the summer. The community must look as nice as when you are here.



reighbors can you believe the season is quickly coming to a close? Soon the snowbirds and our Canadian neighbors will be leaving and the hot summer will be rolling in. I wanted to take this opportunity to say THANK YOU to Marcia White and her staff for never disappointing the residents. Your hard work and incredibly loyal staff of resident volunteers did a great job this season. The new shows were fabulous, all the parties were memorable, and as I hear it, next year's lineup will be even better.

The Co Op and HOA working closely together for many months managed to negotiate the very best bulk contract, named P.U.P., that is going to save us all a huge amount of money every month. Remember lot rents were not increased. You will see a separate charge of \$30.00 for your bulk package on your monthly statement. You will only see a bill from Spectrum if you have any of the "extras". We are moving forward to get this deal signed, sealed and delivered as soon as possible. The written information including the channel lineup is posted on our web site @ www.paradiseislandlargo.com. Please wait to call Spectrum until you receive in the mail, the written information from the Co Op telling you it is time to do so. Do not trust information that you did not hear from a committee member. The park is still listed as retail and that is the only information available to the call center employees.

Once the park is turned over to bulk, you can call the number provided to you and have your individual concerns answered.

This is what you can do now before leaving for the summer. Call Spectrum and shut off all your extra premier stations and turn in your extra boxes and Wi-Fi modem if you chose to. This will help reduce your bill until the conversion takes place. If you are a Direct T.V. customer, Spectrum will pay your early termination fee by signing up for Spectrum now. Call (844) 807-1758. ask about getting your fee paid and follow their instructions.

Before you leave here please take the time to remove ALL outdoor furniture, grills and especially all lawn ornaments and statues. During a hurricane these objects turn into missiles. If you leave anything out, it will be removed and donated. Contact the office to make certain all of your contact information on file is correct. Make sure you also provide the contact info of the local person who has a key to your home in case of an emergency. You are also required to have someone keep up the lot and outside the home. In the event of a storm, you must make arrangements to get your lot cleaned up and home examined for damages. Our members will be kept informed by email all summer. Please contact Pastor Bill if you haven't done so yet and provide us with your current email information.

In closing, for those new to the community, if you are not a shareholder you are an HOA member. Contact Pastor Bill Ogburn to register with us. We welcome you to the community and look forward to meeting you!





Letter to the Editor Paradise Island: is the bloom off the rose? March 2018 Paradise Planet A RESPONSE

n interesting yet slightly egregarious letter to be sure. The letter writer extols the virtues of Paradise island in the first paragraph, with which we totally agree. We are relatively new residents (less than a year) and moved here because of all the activities and camaraderie mentioned,

But then, he goes on to ostracize members of this community who are upset with the constant speeding, referring to them as "whiners" and "critics", who look for something about which to complain.

Well, count us among those whiners and critics.

We live on Martinique, which along with Caribbean, is a major ingress/egress route. It is on these streets that one can observe most of the traffic infractions, including speed, failure to yield and "What stop sign". Perhaps we could rename them Caribbean Expressway and Martinique Freeway. Consider:

• Increasing speed to 25 or 30 mph raises the noise level, disturbing those of us who like our windows open or enjoy being outside. It also raises dust and dirt which then enters our homes.

• STOP means just that. Perhaps the Co-Op could hold vocabulary classes for those who don't understand English.

• Just because there has not been a reported incident in 14 years is no excuse. I have experienced several close calls with drivers failing to yield and speeding. Also, I have been tailgated while driving the speed limit, and once someone even tried to pass me!

• Many of our members walk or bike in the early and evening hours when it is dark. With people parking on the sidewalks (another issue), they are forced into the street, inviting a potential tragedy due to inconsiderate driving. Why should we have to wait for a tragedy to occur before slowing down?

• 15 mph may be a "school zone" speed, but there is a hefty fine if caught exceeding it. I wonder if the writer obeys school zone speeds and if the reason is the penalty.

• Referencing The Villages, an 80000 home golf cart community in context with our 800 homes, is not a good comparison.

• While visitors and vendors should be held accountable, they cannot and will not unless many voices are raised and they are reported. We have tried, but one voice is not enough.

• EMS drivers, we have observed, are the most courteous. Certainly, they should be excepted.

The writer points out that he occasionally exceeds the speed limit. I would take that as an OK to break the rules. I wonder how he would feel if we smoked inside the pool area, or enjoyed our cocktails while in the pool? But, only occasionally, of course.

This issue is not about anything but respect. Respect for your neighbors and friends. Respect for the established rules of the community in which you choose to live. Rules that are designed for the benefit and comfort of everyone.

RESPECT, sir, respect. Otherwise, there is no rose.
