

#### **Get Your Flu Shot!**

It's hard to believe we are entering Flu season again! Flu season runs from October to May, with most cases happening from late December to early March. The flu vaccine is usually offered from September until mid-November. Getting vaccinated before the flu season is in full force gives the body a chance to build up immunity to the virus. It takes about two weeks after vaccination for antibodies to develop in the body and provide protection against influenza virus infection.

Both the Federal Drug Agency (FDA) and the World Health Organization (WHO) are recommending the same influenza targets for the 2018-2019 flu season, which will protect against four types of flu viruses. Everyone is hoping for a better result than last year's vaccine effectiveness of 36%.

#### **Prevention**

The best way to prevent seasonal flu is to get vaccinated every year.

Try to avoid close contact with sick people.

While sick, limit contact with others as much as possible to keep from infecting them.

Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.

<u>Wash your hands</u> often with soap and water. If soap and water are not available, use an <u>alcohol-based hand rub.</u>

Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth. Germs spread this way.

Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with germs like the flu.

**Symptoms of the Flu** 

Flu-like symptoms include fever, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, chills and fatigue. Some people also may have vomiting and diarrhea. One may be infected with the flu and have respiratory symptoms without a fever.

If you get the flu, antiviral drugs can be used to treat your illness. Studies show that flu antiviral drugs work best for treatment when they are started within **two** days of getting sick,

\*\*\*\*It is a good idea to seek approval from your physician before obtaining the vaccine, just in case it is contraindicated for you.

#### Take 3 actions to Fight the Flu

- 1. Vaccinate
- 2. Stop Germs
- 3. Antiviral drugs (if prescribed)

#### What can you do?

#### **Check your house for water leaks:**

- 1. Shut off valves
- 2. Check pipes under house
- 3. Check water lines to washing machine
- 4. Check hot water tank lines
- 5. Check the water hose where it is hooked to valve
- 6. Check toilets (inside) and all lines to toilet. To test it, pour some food coloring in your tank, don't flush, check toilet bowl in morning. If there is food coloring in the bowl then you have a leak, replace the flapper.
- 7. Check pipes under all sinks
- 8. Check in and around your home for any sounds of water leaking

Please let Joanne know if you find a leak or see one at your neighbor's house. Please help your neighbor if they are unable to check for leaks! These simple tasks can make a big difference on our water bills. Please report to the office if you need help.



#### **Something smells Good!**

n envelope is posted on the board in the club house for your convenience to share your favorite recipe in the Media. We have some great cooks in the Park as witnessed by our many food events. Favorites are salads, cookies and casserole dishes. **September** recipe of the month is:

#### **Crab Cakes**

#### Ingredients:

- 1-pound Chesapeake Bay crabmeat
- 1 egg, beaten
- 2 teaspoons yellow mustard
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1/2 cup diced onion
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 3/4 teaspoon crab seasoning
- 1 cup fresh grated bread crumbs

#### **Directions**

Put crabmeat in mixing bowl. Add beaten egg. Mix lightly. Add remaining ingredients in order listed. Form the crab cake mixture into the desired size. Fry in skillet with vegetable oil on medium to high heat (about 1/2-inch of oil in bottom of skillet). Fry on one side until golden brown and turn over on other side to get the same. For a healthier choice place crab cakes on a baking sheet coated with cooking spray. Bake at 350° for 25 minutes or until golden brown.


