#### **Ingredients:**

- 4 cooked sweet potatoes, mashed
- ½ butter, melted
- 2 eggs, beaten
- ½ cup milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- ½ cup sugar

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Combine potatoes, butter, eggs, milk, vanilla and sugar and place in a 9" by 13" dish.
  - 2. Combine topping and sprinkle on potatoes
- 3. Bake 325 degrees for 25 minutes. Serves 8.

### Cauliflower Casserole

A favorite from Lillie

### I Ingredients:

- 1 Cauliflower (cut in small pieces)
- 1 can of cream of chicken soup
- 4 oz of Shredded cheese
- 1 stick of butter
- 1 stack of Ritz crackers
- 1. Cook cauliflower until tender
- 2. Mix butter and cracker crumbs in a 9 x 13 casserole
- 3. Layer vegetables, soup, cheese and cracker crumbs. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes until golden brown.

### **Carrot casserole**

1 b. carrots (cut into pieces)

Cook until tender, drain well.

Make a white sauce.

Cut 8 slices of American cheese and put into white sauce.

Pour carrots in the sauce, then put mixture into casserole dish.

Crumble corn flakes and layer on the top.

Bake at 350 degrees for 20 to 30 minutes.

### Save a life: Recognize the symptoms of stroke


### Walking vs. running: Which is for you?



### Recycling

Based on a conversation with resident Werner Sepp

his past summer Werner Sepp and his lovely wife, Judy, returned to Munich, Germany where Werner was born. While visiting his brother, Werner became curious L about the recycling process there. It was obvious that the process was much more complex than what we have in most cities in the U.S. or in Canada.

Recycling is Germany's contribution to the global battle for the environment.

A major part of the success of this program is the proper sorting of garbage. If one just looks at the recycling of glass, there are five color codes. The colors of glass are green, blue, yellow,

brown and gray and there is a bin for each color alone. Sorting glass

is relatively easy, but there is a need for extensive education when it comes to biological waste and plastic.

One of the issues that Werner shared was the fact that batteries of all kinds cannot be thrown in any bins. They have to be deposited in a small container found in the local shopping centers.

Germany produces 30 million tons of garbage annually but the successful recycling has reduced the amount of garbage by at least one million tons per year.

When talking to Werner it was easy to see his passion for educating children on the importance of recycling. He also felt that companies should focus on the reduction of packaging. And lastly, he spoke about the importance of using cloth bags when grocery shopping. Each plastic bag from the grocery store takes 100 years to break down and plastic diapers take a lot longer.

My conversation with Werner was both informative and stimulating and I know that he

would be glad to share his knowledge of recycling with others.





### Biggest dinosaur ever dug up in South America

ove over, T. Rex, brontosaurus, and other giant dinosaurs—you've just been replaced. Scientists have discovered the largest dinosaur to ever walk the earth. It's been named Dreadnoughtus by paleontologists at Drexel University, who unearthed its skeleton at a dig in Argentina.

The creature was as tall as a two-story building, over 80 feet long, and weighed more than 130,000 pounds, making it the biggest land animal known to date. It lived during the Cretaceous period, 66 million to 84 million years ago. Its name, from Old English, appropriately means "fear nothing."
