

ORIGINS OF VALENTINE'S DAY: A PAGAN FESTIVAL IN FEBRUARY

he history of Valentine's Day—and the story of its patron saint—is shrouded in mystery. We do know that February has long been celebrated as a month of romance, and that St. L Valentine's Day, as we know it today, contains vestiges of both Christian and ancient Roman tradition. While some believe that Valentine's Day is celebrated in the middle of February to commemorate the anniversary of Valentine's death or burial—which probably occurred around A.D. 270-others claim that the Christian church may have decided to place St. Valentine's feast day in the middle of February in an effort to "Christianize" the pagan celebration of Lupercalia. Celebrated at the ides of February, or February 15, Lupercalia was a fertility festival dedicated to Faunus, the Roman god of agriculture, as well as to the Roman founders Romulus and Remus. To begin the festival, members of the Luperci, an order of Roman priests, would gather at a sacred cave where the infants Romulus and Remus, the founders of Rome, were believed to have been cared for by a she-wolf or lupa. The priests would sacrifice a goat, for fertility, and a dog, for purification. They would then strip the goat's hide into strips, dip them into the sacrificial blood and take to the streets, gently slapping both women and crop fields with the goat hide. Far from being fearful, Roman women welcomed the touch of the hides because it was believed to make them more fertile in the coming year. Later in the day, according to legend, all the young women in the city would place their names in a big urn. The city's bachelors would each choose a name and become paired for the year with his chosen woman. These matches often ended in marriage.

I believe it's safe to say that we won't have any animal hides or slapping at our dinner dance, so feel safe to come out and have a good time...of course I can't say that if you come single you may not end up married by the end of the year either!

Meet Your Neighbor: Mr. Harold James Jackson, known as "Jim"

met Jim at the Park Royale craft show this past fall. He had a unique display of hand-made writing pens of which I purchased several for Christmas gifts. These pens are one of a kind and are very attractive.

When I met Jim again, he was kind enough to share his life story along with his many talents. Jim grew up in Apollo, Pa. and attended a one room school house that served all 8 grades. The school was named the "Jackson" school after the late Colonel Jackson who served as a Civil War General. Another claim to fame for the Colonel was that he was the grandfather of the late actor Jimmy Stewart. The school house later became a 4 room school with two grades together. The older boys there tended to the furnace to keep the other children warm. This school is still standing but now remains vacant. The Jackson name was pretty common in the Apollo area. It was the name of streets, stores and many families.

Jim was raised on a large farm and then after age 16 began his career as a carpenter. Shortly after establishing a career with Allegany Ludlum in Breakerridge, Pa,. he married his Jackson School sweetheart, Maxine, in 1941. They were the proud parents of 4 boys.

She was his best friend and co-motorcycle rider for 72 years until she passed away. Jim and Maxine traveled all of the lower 48 states and 8 Canadian provinces. Every year they participated in the Wing-Ding International gathering of motorcycles and were members of Chapter FL1-M. This is the club that rides through our park at Christmas time.

When Jim retired in 1980 he began to pursue many hobbies. He and his wife became snowbirds in Pine Island for 15 years. Using his strong carpenter skills he made clocks and furniture. He also set out to build a 23 foot cabin cruiser with help from his 4 sons. When the boat was ready for launching, Jim heard that the gas prices were soon going to exceed \$1.00 a gallon, so he never put the boat into the water.

Jim moved to Park Royale in 2013. Within a short time he rebuilt the kitchen with his son and started to make pens and went wild. His favorite pen is the Bolt Action Pen which is a lot of tedious work. He has used a variety of woods and even coffee beans for custom pen orders.

Jim was also a ham radio operator for many years and has been a Shriner since 1950. After serving in the military during WWII, he took advantage of the GI Bill and went back to school to get his Pilot's license. He bought a plane and enjoyed taking his family and friends for rides. When Jim and I were finishing up our conversation, he shared his own personal philosophy which he has lived throughout his life which is 95 years by the way. It is as follows:

Never hesitate on anything, don't be afraid to try anything.

Benefit from other people's mistakes, but learn from your own! Be sure to say hi to Jim when you see him in the park.
