

66th Street North Construction

hortly after being elected as a Director of the Park Royale Home Owners Association (H.O.A.) in January 2013, I was asked by a friend "What **J** can be done to the entrance of our park?" As you all know we all take our lives in our hands every time we enter or leave the Park onto busy 66th Street.

Your H.O.A. Board of Directors put together a bulletin asking you if :: ** you would support our initiative – to get Shell to close their northern CONSTRUCTION driveway. I am pleased to announce that we had 84 responses with

81 for and 3 against. The breakdown between year-round/seasonal was 42 and 42 with 80 responders that were SHELL customers.

With this information in hand, I went to the Pinellas Park Police Station where I got a printout of recent accidents. There were 24 in the past two years in the general area of our entrance confirming that there definitely is a problem. I next went to the Public Works Department of Pinellas Park where I was well received by the Administrator who actually took time to come to the Park to view our concerns first hand. He was very supportive; however, since 66th Street is a State Highway, there was little he could do. He did promise to forward our concerns to his contact at the Florida Department of Transportation. This all took place in the first 4 months of 2013. When I returned to Florida in November 2013, I went to see my contact at Pinellas Park who advised me that he had, in fact, been in contact with the Florida Department of Transportation re: our concerns and discovered that they were planning to resurface 66th Street in the near future. I was given the name of the project manager who I contacted immediately and I was able to set up a meeting at their office in Tampa.

Brian King, a homeowner in our Park, and I met not only with the project manager, but also her supervisor. Brian prepared a very detailed report using printouts from Google earth – so excellent was his report that our hosts suggested that they should hire him. We were well received and Mr. Jim Smith, the senior person at this meeting, agreed to hear a second meeting which was held here at the Park so he could see first - hand what we face daily.

This all took place in the first four months of 2014. Then on May 1, 2104 shortly after arriving home, I received the following email from Mr. Scott.

"We had several discussions with Circle K about their northern drive. The results are that Circle K will allow the DOT to close the drive and we will widen their southern drive so that the additional traffic exiting that drive will not interfere with motorists turning into the drive." For your information that drive is currently 33' and will be widened to 40'.

Upon returning to Florida in October, I contacted Mr. Scott, thanking him for the job that they did for us. I was told that the contract for resurfacing 66th Street will be let in December and work could begin early in 2015.









