
Royalites Monthly Meeting










Ladies Luncheon

n envelope is posted on the board in the club house for your convenience to share your favorite recipe in the Media. We have some great cooks in the Park as witnessed by our many food events. Favorites are salads, cookies and casserole dishes. **January** recipe of the month is:

PEACH HAND PIES

INGREDIENTS:

For the Crust

- Pepperidge Farm Puff Pasty (each sheet makes approx. 6 pies) For the Filling
- 1 can Peach pie filling (or apple)
- 1 teaspoon of cinnamon or as desired For Topping
- 1 large egg
- 1 teaspoon water
- sparkling sugar, optional



DIRECTIONS:

For the Crust

- Thaw puff pastry as directed
- Use a 4-inch biscuit cutter make 6 circles (you may have to use the excess dough to make the 6th circle)
- Preheat oven to 400° F, line a baking sheet with parchment paper, and prepare the filling.

For the Filling

- 1. In a medium bowl, cut peaches in very small pieces
- 2. Toss the peaches with the cinnamon.

Assemble the Pies

- 1. Add one heaping tablespoon of filling to the center of each dough circle, leaving as much liquid behind as possible.
- 2. Fold the dough in half and use your fingers or a fork to seal the edges.
- 3. Place hand pies on prepared baking sheet.
- 4. In a small bowl, whisk together the egg and water.
- 5. Use the tip of a sharp knife to cut 2 small slits into the tops of each pie.
- 6. Use a pastry brush to lightly brush the tops of the hand pies with the egg wash. If I desired, top with sparkling sugar.
- 7. Bake in preheated for 20-22 minutes or until golden brown.
- 8. Allow hand pies to cool.

 If desired mix powdered sugar and a bit of milk for a glaze!






