Since 2017 is not finished I input \$ 65.00 as a guestimate for water. Using this guestimate **There is a potential \$ 97.80 annual savings.**

Keep in mind that there are more residents this year than last. Currently we have 303 occupied sites and by the end of the year we anticipate 309. This would put us at 100% occupancy.

In order to get meters each resident will pay anywhere from \$550-\$600 to install your meter. This is also a guestimate because my finals on installation are not in.

You can pay in a lump sum or possibly making monthly payents. We have not determined how many months we will split it over.

There is no charge to the following limits: 6 TV's (must be whole), 20 - 1 gallon paint containers, 5 - 5 gallon paint containers, 5 computers, 12 Fluorescent bulbs/tubes, 4 Printers and 5 - 5 gallon containers of fuel.

IS MY DOG TALKING TO ME?

"For a thousand generations, the West belonged only to American Indians - perhaps more than three million of them. In the Kiowa oral tradition, one of the ways to indicate time long past, is to say, 'Well this happened when dogs could talk.'" N. Scott Momaday

sn't it amazing that for millennia, man has considered the possibility that dogs could communicate? Cesar Milan wrote, "The idea of talking animals is very old in human culture. Even in early Greek myths and stories are full of talking animals. I have never heard them [dogs] speak in human voices. That's okay, though, because my dogs talk to me all the time, and I talk back."

How domestic and wild canines communicate has become the subject of hundreds of current scientific studies, and most dog owners have experienced this phenomenon personally. Even the youngest child understands what a wagging tail means, but there appears to be an entire dictionary of canine behavioral activities that communicate messages of both the trivial and grand ideas.

Persistence is a global characteristic of all canines, and as one dog trainer told me, "If your dog isn't persistent, you have a cat." If he can't explain himself one way, he will try another and then, another, and still another, until you get it or you force him to stop.

The happiest dog could be the one that is heard the most clearly, and if that's true, the onus is on dog owners to not only speak with clarity to our pets, but to listen with intention to their communications

The Purple Paws Pet Club advocates for the pets in Park Royale, and we encourage all pet owners to listen to their dogs. In upcoming articles, we will explore some ideas about canine communication, and how we might learn to recognize their messages. Science of dogs is telling us that our best friends are saying much more than a wagging tail conveys, but the key is to listen with our eyes, our ears, and even our hunches.






