

Introducing our "Veteran of the Month" Richard Fairfield

Richard was born in Richmond, Virginia. He grew up with 3 brothers and a sister. He moved to the park in April of 2017.

He enlisted in the Army in February of 1958 when the 1st US Satellite (Explorer I) launched and Domenico Modugno won the Grammy Award for the hit song "Volere". He was inspired to enlist by his mother when Richard was 18 and out of a job. His mother thought it was the best thing for all the boys to enlist.

When Richard left home, he went to boot camp in Ft. Dicks, NJ, at the same time Elvis Presley left for boot camp in Ft. Chaffey. He was excited to leave home in anticipation of travelling. He exclaimed that there was nothing funny about boot camp! After boot camp, he was trained in artillery and shot the big guns.

As PFC, he was a truck driver in the Army. He transported and drove one of the first trucks that would carry and shoot an atomic bomb. He also was awarded the sharpshooter medal.

Overseas, he was stationed in Darmstadt, Germany, just outside of Frankfurt. In the states, he was stationed in Ft. Bragg, NC, which was his favorite post because he had lots of freedom and was close to his friends.

After his discharge, during the Cuban Missile Crisis to his surprise, he was called back to duty to replace an artillery unit that was headed for Germany.

Richard recalls his worst memory in Germany when he was infected by a chigger bite that ended up being the size of a golf ball for which he spent 3 weeks in the infirmary.

When asked what his best memory was in the service, he stated "A funny thing happened in Germany when we were driving the B Unit 4x4 gun lifting 250, we ran over a Volkswagen and just kept going!"

As with all veterans, next time you see Richard, please thank him for his service.



Mushroom Business by Betty Sevoie

A favorite requested by many!

Ingredients:

- 1 cup sliced mushrooms
- 2 Tble butter
- ½ cup chopped onions
- ½ cup chopped green pepper(optional)
- ½ cup chopped celery
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- ¼ tea. Salt
- Dash of pepper
- 8 slices whole grain bread (white OK)
- 2 lg. eggs beaten
- 1 cup milk
- 1 can mushroom soup (undiluted)1 cup shredded Monterey Jack, or Swiss, I'm going to try Jalapeno.

Directions:

- 1. In large heavy skillet, saute mushrooms in butter 5 minutes. Do not drain.
- 2. In a large bowl combine onion, green pepper, and celery with mayo, salt and pepper. Add mushrooms and Mix Well.
- 3. Grease 8 inch square baking dish.
- 4. Cut bread slices into quarters. Lay ½ pieces into baking dish, over lap if necessary
- 5. Spread mushroom mixture over bread.
- 6. Cover with the remaining bread squares. In a small bowl combine eggs and milk and beat until well mixed.
- 7. Pour over bread slices,
- 8. Cover and refrigerate 4 hours or overnight.
- 9. Spread undiluted soup over top, spreading evenly to the edges.
- 10. Bake 45 minutes in preheated 350 degree oven.
 - Remove from oven and sprinkle cheese over top.

Bake an additional 10 minutes, serves 6 to 8. ENJOY!!


