
Shelley Young -Treasurer







So when my doctor was using the word cancer to identify something in me, I had to review my thoughts and then try to figure out what to do next. I knew that I was in the best location for cancer treatment but there were bigger issues that were worrying me. I didn't drive, didn't have a car, and there was no public transportation in our immediate area. Plus, to make matters worse, my caregiver was scheduled for surgery during that week when I was getting the treatments, so that was not the solution. How was I going to get to the treatment center at the Morton Plant hospital for 16 consecutive days for the radiation appointments? And within a day or two an answer was given to me: volunteers! My appointments were scheduled each day from 10:20 am until the end of the session which averaged out to be about 20 minutes and most of that time was for garment changes. Would Park Royale residents really want to make that trip to Morton Plant hospital? Many of the volunteers had never been to this hospital before so they had made use of their GPS's and made trial trips so they knew where to go. From the willingness of Park Royale residents who were eager to sign up for this task, the planning by Joe K. and the support of the volunteers, I was going to Morton Plant!

Each morning, right on time, a car rolled up in front of the house. If you want to envision a tall handsome chauffeur standing by the car, go right ahead, but that was not what I saw. It was the Park Royale residents who were eager to bring encouragement to the day and they did such a fine job. I can't tell you how much that meant to me. Within no time, the radiation sessions were over and we went back to life as it had been. No, that's not true. I will be forever grateful for all of the time given to me by so many people and I will never forget the kindness and laughter that we shared. I remembered that laughter is a great panacea and we should find it in our everyday life. It was a pleasure to listen to volunteers who had spent many winters in Florida but called Park Royale home.

A pot luck dinner took place shortly after the treatments were completed and we experienced our own bell ringing ceremony that let me send my message of "I am cancer free." Since most of the volunteers attended the dinner, I could easily thank each one, but if I missed thanking you in person, please let me know so I can complete this task. Again, thank you from the bottom of my heart.

We go through life looking for the best answers and hopefully finding the right solutions to love, family, school and friends, etc. We hope we make good choices. At least, we think we do. Some of our choices are easy and some are not. While selecting friends is important to us in the adolescent years, it is more important in our senior years. From what I have read the positive attitudes of friends can be extremely valuable in maintaining good health in later years. Some research has even declared that late in life friendships could be equivalent to a successful bond even with your doctors and other medical professionals to give you a better quality of life.


