

### **Meet Resident Jerry Brown**

Terry was born and raised in Memphis, TN when racial tensions were high and segregation was still going on.

Jerry joined the Army in 1961 when John F. Kennedy was sworn in as the 35th President of the U.S. and after the defection of 20% of the eastern Germany population, the Berlin Wall was built 87 miles long separating the East from the West.

When asked why he joined so young, he stated that he was only taking his friend who wanted to join. While his friend was taking the written test, they asked Jerry to take it as well and while his friend was taking his physical, they asked Jerry if he would take one too. Low and behold, his friend did not pass the physical because of his heart. Jerry was not ready to join and didn't want to, but they kept him there for hours until they finally beat him down and he finally agreed. He hadn't even graduated high school yet. They told him he could get his GED while he served in the Army. You see, they wanted Jerry because he scored a high IQ. So, he headed off to boot camp in Ft. Knox, Kentucky. It was the first time he had ever been on a train and he was curious as to what was in store for him. Well, they cut off his medium afro (which he didn't appreciate) and he did not like crawling on his back, in the mud under machine fire! After graduating boot camp, Jerry went off to specialist school. He was the only black man in the Company who received special training of electrical systems in combat vehicles. He was also placed in code school for morse code, but he didn't like that, he wanted to be a mechanic. Jerry was Specialist 4th Class Armored Intelligent Specialist. He was also in charge of inspecting all armor, guns and combat vehicles. He enjoyed driving the Lieutenant around; his vehicle was the cleanest of all the vehicles in the Company.

Jerry served from 1961 through 1964. He was stationed for 2 years in Bindlach Germany near the east-west German border. After that, he was shipped back to the US in Ft. Bragg, NC.

Jerry finished school with a GED and he also received the Rifleman medal as well as the Good Conduct medal.

Jerry and his wife Susan moved to the park in 2014.




