Recipe of the month

Bite-sized Caramel Cheesecakes

Ingredients:

- ¹/₂ cup graham cracker crumbs
- 1 Tablespoon Brown sugar
- ³/₄ teaspoon salt
- 2 Tablespoon butter
- 1 ¹/₂ packages (8 oz) cream cheese (softened)
- ¹/₂ cup granulated sugar
- 1 egg
- 12 Kraft caramels
- 1 Tablespoon milk

Heat oven to 325 degrees. Mix graham crackers, brown sugar, ¹/₄ teaspoon of salt and butter. Press into bottoms of 24 paper lined mini muffin cups. Beat cream cheese and granulated sugar in large bowl with mixer until blended. Add egg, beat just until blended. Spoon into muffin cups, adding about 1 Tablespoon to each.

Bake 15 minutes or until centers are almost set. Cool completely. Refrigerate one hour.

Place caramels in a small heatproof bowl. Add milk and ¹/₄ teaspoon of the remaining salt. Place over a pan of boiling water, making sure water does not touch bottom of bowl. Cook until caramels are completely melted and mixture is well blended, stirring frequently. Drizzle about a teaspoon of caramel sauce over each cheesecake. Sprinkle with remaining salt. Refrigerate 1 hour.



Part Two: Extremely Scary Incident in Lake Erie June, 1998

Poor Marie appeared at the bottom of the stairs in the companionway hanging on for dear life. She had the most anxious, worried face I'd ever seen on her.

Back to the train. I had to cup my hands over my mouth and yell as loud as I could for Marie to hear me to put the companionway doors in to prevent Lake Erie spilling over the side rail, going down below and sinking the boat. Marie was but 4-5 feet from me, but could barely hear me tell her what to do over the shrieking wind.

From time to time the boat was over so far and then popped up, only to be slammed down again on our left side at an extreme angle. This happened about 3 or 4 times. One time when we were over, the lightning flashed and I looked out the side of our boat. The two foot waves that had been there an instant before were now blown flat and it was pouring rain.

I was trying to roll up the sail at the front from the cockpit using the furling gear. All the time the sail was flogging violently and the snapping which sounded like a rifle shot. I had rolled up all the line to the cockpit, but the sail was still flogging and didn't feel right. So I got my flashlight and shone it at the bow of the boat. I saw the sail mostly furled up but ripped in 3 places. I could do from here.

It seemed like it took forever for Marie to get the four boards into the companionway. It was really tough for her. It was dark, and while hanging on with one hand, she had to put the boards in the proper order into the slot on both sides of the open. It would be difficult to identify the boards and know which order they should be in under any conditions.

I think this episode lasted perhaps 2-5 minutes. Not very long in the scheme of things, but long enough to frighten the hell out of us. In fact, the next morning I took photos of the tattered sail still flapping about under the blue sky. Marie saw the photo later and asked when that picture was taken. I told her the following day when we were on our way to Port Colborne. She claimed not to remember anything about the next day and the blue sky.

After that fiasco, the wind settled back down and it was almost calm. So then we had an uneventful motor trip to Turkey Point on the Canadian side. We anchored the boat and took the tattered sail down to the deck. I was amazed that it came down easily because there was a big knot of sail up there. I had visions of having to go up the mast, reach over and cut it away. Then when we got the sail down, we collapsed into a much deserved sleep. We arrived in Port Colborne the next morning. Then we continued sailing peacefully until we reached our Pickering destination. <u>Conclusion</u> – It was a real stroke of luck to have put the small sail up for the overnight sail in Lake Erie. Had I had the much larger front sail and some or all of the mainsail up, it could have been a very different outcome. The mast was very close to being in the water. If we had more sail up, the water could have cascaded over the cockpit foaming and found its way below. That horror would have happened so quickly that Marie would never have gotten the boards in place. And I could have been washed overboard because I was in such a hurry to do what I had to do that I didn't attach myself to the boat.

I've heard of storm fronts, microbursts and tornados, but I think what we experienced was a very near miss of a direct hit by a tornado. I think because of the "freight train" sound, it was a tornado. I've never heard anything like that in my life. It was a dark night in the middle of Lake Erie and I could not see behind me to see if the wind was coming across the waves. This was a night that I will never forget!
