Recipe of the Month: Italian Pasta and Bean Soup

- 1 Tablespoon olive oil
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 clove of garlic, finely chopped
- 6 cups of low sodium chicken broth
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups farfallini (small bow tie pasta)
- 1 14.5 ounce cans of cannellini beans
- 2 15 ounce cans of diced tomatoes in juice
- ¹/₂ cup fresh flat-leaf parsley, chopped
- ¹/₄ cup grated Parmesan

Heat the oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Add the onion and $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon of salt and pepper, and cook, stirring until beginning to soften, 4 to 5 minutes. Add the garlic and cook for 1 minute.

Add the broth and Pasta and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer until the pasta the pasta is just tender, 8 to 10 minutes.

Stir in the beans and tomatoes and cook until heated through, about 2 minutes. Remove from the heat and stir in the parsley.

Serve with grated Parmesan.

Hints to make better soup:

- 1. Did you know that when you add vegetables to a soup, they taste better if you sauté them in a little butter first.
- 2. Don't boil your soups for too long, they'll lose their color.
- 3. If you need your soup to be a little thicker put instant mashed potatoes and gravies in to thicken. Stir it in thoroughly and keep on adding as much as desired. Most cooked vegetables can also be pureed and then stirred in to thicken soups.
