



Doug's paternal grandfather was instrumental in repairing and redesigning improvements in New York City and his maternal grandparents owned the Lathrop Paper Company. The strong work ethic and commitment to quality which Doug observed were probably the foundation of his success. When Doug was in high school he became more and more interested in sports and was willing to serve his class as President. However, when Doug graduated he still didn't know what he wanted to do. At the age of 17 he enrolled in the Navy. After the completion of basic training in Sampson, N.Y. he became a signal man. From his training he was able to send signals by code with flags. He maintained a large box of flags while on a Destroyer in the Atlantic during World War II.

After the War Doug decided to go to college, but it was difficult to get into school at that time. Finally he enrolled in the Associated College of Upper New York State. His education was partially earned in Utica and then he went on to Syracuse, New York. When he graduated he was a civil engineer and began his career with the Public Works Department in New York State. In 1951 he married his wife, Mary.

In 1955 flooding in New York created a great need for dams and Doug was instrumental in the process of building them when he was with the O & G Company. During that time the U.S. Army had money to fund dams and other related construction projects. The O & G Company was very successful in gaining funds for dams. The Thomaston Dam which is one of the largest in Connecticut was funded by these resources. After 15 years Doug and his brother, who was also an engineer, formed a partnership under their Hemlock Construction Company name. Later Doug and Mary had 5 children of which the oldest one has just retired and the youngest son works for the same company as his father. Unfortunately Mary passed away, but the family continues to grow. Today there are 13 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren.

Along with being successful in his career, Doug found time to pursue his favorite hobbies, sailing and skiing. Doug started sailing at the age of ten on Highland Lake. He was a sailboat racer for many years. His personal favorite sailboat was a 34 foot boat which was docked in Connecticut. Since boating is a seasonal sport, Doug took up skiing and he has skied all over the world. He started skiing in the U.S., from the east to west coast but after traveling in Europe he found Kitzbuhel, Austria to be his favorite skiing location. Now in retirement and calling Florida home, Doug swims and bikes for exercise.


Activities in the Park



Huge exoplanets not as plentiful as thought

stronomers have discovered more than 100 giant exoplanets orbiting distant stars, but some are now saying that many of those huge worlds aren't planets at all.



According to the website of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), scientists analyzed the findings of the Kepler Space Telescope, which identifies exoplanets by scanning stars for long stretches of time in search of changes in their brightness. These changes suggest the presence of planets or other objects temporarily causing their light to dip.

Instead of monitoring brightness, a second group of scientists looked for signs of movement in the stars as planets circled them. The differences in the slight movements between planets and other objects has led the team to conclude that as many as 55 percent of "exoplanets" have been misidentified. More likely, they're stars themselves—possibly brown dwarfs, a type of failed star, sharing an orbit with a larger sun.

One day he grew so discouraged that he went to his boss and told him that he was going to quit. His boss's response? "You can't."

Hailey repeated that he was quitting. The manager repeated, "You can't."

Angry now, Hailey shouted, "Yes, I can!"

His manager replied, "Walter, you can't get out of the insurance business because you have never really gotten into the insurance business."

The words hit Hailey like a ton of bricks. For the first time in his life he realized that you can't get something out of an endeavor if you never put anything into it. Or as Ziglar puts it, "There are many people who 'join' a sales organization but never get into the business of selling."

hopping online has exploded in recent years. One example: A survey conducted by 72 Point Inc. and commissioned by Door to Door Organics, an online organic grocer, found that shoppers increased their online grocery purchases by an average of 29 percent in the past year, and those shoppers do about 19 percent of their weekly grocery shopping via the Internet.

Extra sleep may not lead to longer life

ost of us look forward to sleeping late on the weekend. After a hard week of work, we deserve a few extra hours, right? But a study from the Journal of Clinical Endocrinology & Metabolism suggests that sleeping in may contribute to a higher risk of diabetes and heart disease

Researchers tracked more than men and women age 30-54, using devices that recorded their movement to determine when they fell asleep and woke up for a one-week period. Close to 85 percent went to bed later and got up later on their days off from work, and those people tended to experience lower levels of HDL cholesterol (the good kind) along with higher triglycerides, greater resistance to insulin, and a higher body mass index, even after controlling for factors like physical activity, calorie consumption, and alcohol use.

The implications are clear: Maintaining a consistent sleep schedule, even on weekends, is better for everyone's long-term health.

Aspirin prevents skin cancer?

spirin is known to cure our aches and pains and improve heart health. It may also be useful in preventing certain kinds of skin cancer, according to an article on the Discover magazine website.

Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) like aspirin and ibuprofen are already known to help prevent cancers in the colon, lungs, prostate, and breasts. A meta-analysis of studies, some previously unavailable to researchers, turned up evidence that non-aspirin NSAIDs can reduce the risk of developing squamous cell carcinoma by 15 percent, and that when aspirin is added

to the mix, the risk drops to 18 percent. NSAIDs are known to inhibit COX-2, an enzyme produced by skin cells in response to ultraviolet light.

Talk to your dermatologist about aspirin, and otherwise limit your exposure to UV light to stay safe from skin cancer all year round.
