

Reminders!

**PETS** 

Is Park Royale a pet friendly community? YES! There are pet owners and non-pet owners who live in the park.

With that being said, can pet owners please respect the fact that some resident's do not wish your pet to use their yard. Look for the purple paw in the window to see if it is okay or look for signs in the yards that ask you do not go there. The purple paw means a dog is welcome to use that yard. If you do not have one come sign sheet in clubhouse and you will be given a purple paw by Jay Johnson.

There are Park Rules and Regulations that are to be followed. The pet owners who do not follow the rules make life hard for the pet owners who do.

Please try to have your pet go in your yard before you walk (of course we know they may go again)

**Leashes** - When you are out in your yard or driveway, please have your pet on a leash at all times.

**Barking** - If your dog barks excessively, please look into a bark device. There are SAFE battery operated devices on the market that emits frequencies every time they bark to train them not to bark.

**Fleas** – It is the pet owner's responsibility to make sure their pet wears a flea collar or you give them frontline for fleas and ticks. The dog park is for all dogs. Protect your pets!

CATS –ALL cat owners should be keeping their cats inside at ALL times unless on a leash. Cats who roam may pick up fleas or get hit by cars. They use other people's yards as their litter boxes. We are in the process of trapping cats. If you find your cat is missing you may want to check with animal control.

**DOG PARK** – Please pick up after your dogs in the dog park. This seems to be an ongoing issue.

**LAWN SERVICE** – The lawn company comes every other Wednesday (Jan. thru April.) Starting in May they come every Wednesday.

**PARKING** – Thank you all for not parking in the street more than 2-4 hours. This has improved. However, if I do see cars parked on the street I will put a No Parking sign on your car as a friendly reminder. Please disregard it if you have only been there for the 2-4 hour timeframe.

#### WATER ŬSAGÉ = HIGH WATER BILLS

Can everyone please be mindful of their water usage. The park is on a pro-rata billing system which means everyone gets billed the same amount no matter how much water they use. The last bill was very very high! So we are asking that you go to a car wash to wash your cars, take your dogs to a groomer, instead of using the hose, watch how much you water your lawns, etc. Thank you! J





And use reflective tape on your clothes whenever possible!

#### Fresh or frozen? The choice is yours

om may tell you over and over again to eat fruits and vegetables that are fresh, but nutrition experts say that frozen produce isn't necessarily inferior. According to *The New York Times*, most nutrients are surprisingly hardy: Iron, for example, stands up to freezing quite well, and fiber does its job whether it's frozen or fresh.

Scientists at the University of California-Davis analyzed the vitamin content in several different varieties of fresh and frozen produce, including blueberries, broccoli, carrots, spinach, and strawberries. They found no significant differences between fresh and frozen items, and even discovered that frozen broccoli contains more riboflavin—a B vitamin—than the fresh selection. Similarly, frozen blueberries have more vitamin C than fresh.

Experts recommend looking for produce frozen using the IQF process—individually quick frozen"—for the highest quality.

#### Watch for these sources of illness while traveling

Traveling has enough hassles—check-in lines, lost luggage, bad airline food—without adding germs to the mix. Be safe by watching out for these common sources of germs and bacteria that can make you sick when you travel (from the CNN website):

- Washroom stall locks. In one test, airport stall locks were found to have an average of 70 colony-forming units (CFUs) per square inch. Use soap and water or a good hand sanitizer after touching them.
- Seatbelt buckles. Clean your hands after buckling up. Airplane belt buckles can have up to 230 CFUs per square inch.
- Lavatory flush buttons. These can get pretty nasty, containing 265 CFUs per square inch (although overhead vents and tray tables have more).
- Drinking fountains. Thirsty? Maybe buy a bottle of water instead. The buttons on airport drinking fountains have been found to hold 1,240 CFUs per square inch.
