REVIVE YOUR SPICES

Who hasn't bought a bottle of turmeric, or some other dried spice for a particular recipe and then not needed it again for 6 months or longer? If the spice is faded in color but still has a slight fragrance, you might be able to get additional use of the spice. To test its freshness, measure the spice into your hand and crush it with your fingers. If it becomes fragrant again, you are good to go. If not, put the spice in a dry skillet over low heat and cook, stirring constantly until it becomes fragrant. Then immediately transfer to a bowl and add to your recipe.





s Americans live longer, families are feeling a heavier burden in the caregiving area. The Bureau of Labor Statistics estimates that some 40.5 million Americans are acting as unpaid caregivers for older family members. Most just help one person, but 22 percent are responsible for two people and 7 percent provide help to three or more. Most caregivers are between the ages of 45 and 64 (23 percent), but 17 percent of people older than 65 act as caregivers as well.

The demands may be high, but many Americans find the work worthwhile. Yes, 32 percent describe caregiving as stressful, but 88 percent say helping out an elderly loved one is a rewarding experience.
