

All Hazard Guides are available in the clubhouse – This will help you prepare for Hurricanes.

I will say we sure dodged a bullet with Hurricane Irma. Only 3 homes sustained major damage. We were very blessed to not get the hurricane they were predicting!

Please be sure to know your evacuation shelters before a storm comes. Have a plan and supplies ready for the hurricane season so you don't have to fight the crowds.

<u>**POOL CLOSING**</u> – Since the pool was not closed in July because the previous contractor forgot to order the pavers, the pool will now be closed from Oct. 23 - Nov. 6th.







<u>GUESTS</u> – It was nice that we could accommodate family and friends when their power was out die to Hurricane Irma. However please remember to have them follow the Park Rules. No street parking. Have them park up by the clubhouse or on Regent. Normally guests are not allowed to bring pets, however we made an exception during this crisis. If they had pets they should follow the same Park Pet rules. Keep dogs on a leash and pick up after them. Thank you all for opening your homes to those without power!

# Please remember if you have a guest (not during hurricane) you have to register them in the guest book at the clubhouse. Thank You.

#### 10 things you should never flush down your toilet

- 1. Bathroom wipes even if they say flushable. These wipes are creating clogs and backups in sewer systems.
- 2. Cotton Balls and Swabs- they gather together in bends in pipes and cause major clogs.
- 3. Prescription Medication they destroy bacteria, contaminate groundwater supplies and have terrible effects on wildlife downstream.
- 4. Paper Towels- they are not designed to break down like toilet paper.
- 5. Cigarette Butts- they are full of incredibly toxic chemicals that end up in the water supply.
- 6. Band-Aids they are made of non-biodegradable plastic. Terrible for the environment
- 7. Dental Floss- it wraps around other items and causes clogs.
- 8. Fats, Oil and grease do not put in garbage disposal either. It cools and congeals and clogs pipes. Scrape it in the trash when it cools
- 9. Cat Litter it is made from clay and sand. 2 things that should never be put down a toilet. Plus the cat waste contains toxins and parasites.
- 10. Disposable Diapers or Adult Diapers. (Our lift station quit working last month. They found an adult diaper that clogged it up.)

(off 28th St. N.). The hours are Monday through Friday 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Saturday from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, and closed on Sundays and Holidays. There is no charge to the following limits: 6 TV's (must be whole), 20 - 1 gallon paint containers, 5 - 5 gallon paint containers, 5 computers, 12 Fluorescent bulbs/tubes, 4 Printers and 5 - 5 gallon containers of fuel.

Then do you throw out food?

So how do you check for freshness? Sniffing the food is not the answer, but it is a method that many people rely on. The approved way of checking for freshness lies in a voluntary system of labeling. The only items required by federal law to be labeled for expiration are infant formula and some baby foods.

Definition of terms

The actual term "expiration date" refers to the last date a food should be eaten or used. Last means last – proceed with caution. "Sell by" date tells the store how long to display the product for sale. This is a guide for the retailer so they know when to pull the item. "Sell by" is the last day the item is at its highest level of quality, but it will still be edible for some time after. "Best if used by (or before)" date refers strictly to quality, not safety. The date is recommended for best flavor or quality. It is not a purchase or safety date.

If you are returning now after being gone for the summer, this is the time to check the dates of canned goods and spices.



### Three activities to ward off Alzheimer's

lzheimer's disease may not have a cure, but experts believe some practices can help delay memory loss. Here's what you can do:

• Cognitive training. Crossword puzzles and other games can help, but try some different techniques. Do simple arithmetic in your head instead of relying on a calculator. Develop a new method for remembering what's on your shopping list. Train your brain to remember things in new ways and you'll keep it sharper.

- Control your blood pressure. Reducing high blood pressure with medication and weight loss not only cuts your risk of heart disease, but it can also ease stress on the delicate blood vessels in your brain— stress that can exacerbate memory loss and dementia.
- Exercise. Moderate aerobic exercise has many health benefits, including heading off symptoms associated with Alzheimer's. Try exercising for 30 minutes five days a week, or 50 minutes three times a week. You'll feel better and extend your cognitive health.

### Scientists search for life on the toughest planets

Te think of life as viable only on planets orbiting stars like our sun, but scientists now speculate that it could evolve on worlds circling very different types of stars.

Stars called M dwarfs are the most common stars in our galaxy. Their harsh flares and gravitational grip on their innermost planets could interfere with the formation of liquid water, which is necessary for life. However, astronomers have spotted approximately 200 planets circling M dwarfs, and dozens are in the so-called habitable zone where liquid water could exist and temperatures aren't too extreme for the development of life.

Scientists are studying these strange new worlds in hopes of detecting conditions that might lead to life—although it will probably be very different from any life found on Earth.

### Lost and found: Seeking owner of ancient sword

S cientists are trying to determine the identity of the owner of a 14th-century sword found in a bog in Poland. The four-foot-long sword, which according to the Fox News website is remarkably well preserved, was discovered by a worker using an excavator to drain a peat bog. The worker donated his find to a local museum.

Museum officials speculate that the sword was lost by a medieval knight, or that perhaps the knight perished in the bog. Researchers are examining an engraving on the sword's hilt that may identify the knight or his family. Meanwhile, archeologists are searching the bog for other artifacts.
