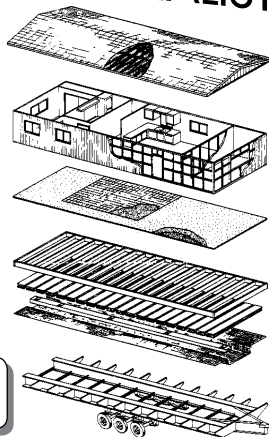

From the Media Editor:

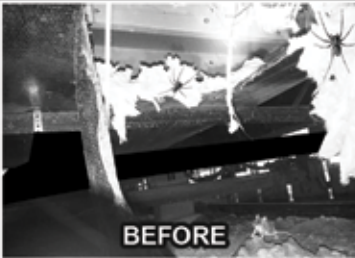

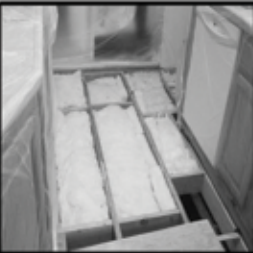

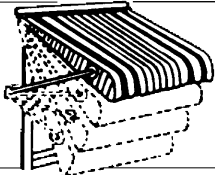

Something smells Good!

If you have a recipe that you would like to share with the residents of Park Royale, please let us know and we will gladly add it to the Media. We have some great cooks in the Park as witnessed by our last food event. Favorites are salads, cookies and casserole dishes.

Let's talk Pot Luck

As you can see Park Royale has several pot lucks during the year. If you are not familiar with this term or expectation of food, then we will make some suggestions. There is now a magazine that only focuses on Pot luck dinners. Their last issue was devoted to sweet potatoes. There are some favorite side dishes that everyone likes; such as traditional lettuce and tomato salad, cole slaw, potato salad and pasta salads. But our food tastes are changing and we now see such items such as glazed meat balls, wings, herbed sprouts, spinach bakes, rice dishes, spicy corn balls to name a few on our serving table.

Pot Luck dinners

The word pot luck appears in the 16th century English work of Thomas Nashe and it was used to mean food provided to an unexpected guest. But the modern interpretation is a communal meal where the guests bring their own food. This concept originated in the 1930 during the depression. The term pot luck has had a lot of difficulties being recognized as a valid meal. Pot luck dinners have been eliminated in some states and are illegal in Arizona. It usually is a regular meal with no special preparation. It is a homemade dish that can be enjoyed by 10 to 12 people.

Here is one of the pot luck favorites:

Lillie Wampole's Cauliflower Casserole

1 head of cauliflower chopped and slightly cooked

1 can of cream of chicken soup $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of shredded cheese

1 stick of butter

1 stack of Ritz crackers.

Mix the first 2 ingredients in a large shallow baking dish, and spread cheese on top. Melt butter and mix with crushed crackers and spread on top of cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for $\frac{1}{2}$ hour. You can also use all broccoli or $\frac{1}{2}$ broccoli or $\frac{1}{2}$ cauliflower.

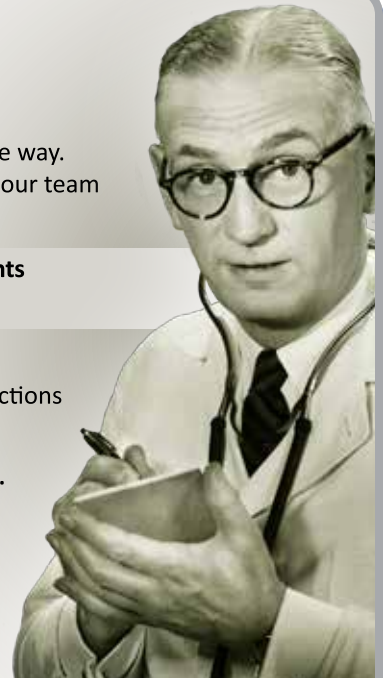

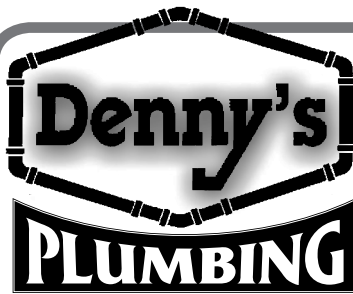
