- 1. All renters/visitors required to register and apply for background check at the office. Show proof of age. Owners check-in and also leave departure date. Update your information.
- 2. Permit required for overnight parking in **designated** areas. Overnight street parking is not permitted. Obtain permit at office (5-L) during office hours.
- 3. Speed Limit in park: 10 MPH. Be aware of other cars when parking on streets. They are very narrow. Emergency vehicles should be able to pass easily.
- 4. Check Clubhouse Activity Room # 1 for information on possible sales or rentals available.
- 5. Children must be accompanied by resident adult to use Pool & Clubhouse. <u>All residents are to wear cover-up or Tee shirt when in clubhouse.</u> DO NOT WALK INTO CLUBHOUSE WITH WET FEET!
- 6. SAFETY HINT: Use a FLASHLIGHT when walking during the dark hours after 6:00P. Golf Carts turn lights ON.
- 7. Residents should have <u>Emergency Contact information in their office file</u>, in case of medical problem or weather emergency.
- 8. Any requests for our maintenance staff is to be submitted, IN WRITING, so work order can be generated. No verbal requests, please.

Pointe West Community Organizations

1. Residents Owned Community - ROC

- a. Residents who bought a share in community which owns the land. They display a black permanent tag on their coach.
- b. These residents pay real estate taxes to Pinellas County.
- c. They pay a monthly maintenance fee to the ROC.
- d. Organization elects residents to the Board to govern the running of Pointe West. These (9) directors elect yearly: a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer.

2. Recreation Association - REC

- a. All residents are eligible to join, paying \$2.50 per person for life.
- b. It's managed by a Board of Directors (12) for rotating three year terms. They then elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer each year.
- c. They plan a Social calendar for winter and summer seasons.

3. Home Owners' Association - HOA

- a. Pointe West Homeowners Association Inc. A not-for profit corporation. The H.O.A. is by law, the official and legally recognized representative.
- b. Members Non-shareholders who rent their lots here regarding, rent increases, park rules and regulations, park amenities, state governing statutes.

4. Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc.

Message from Park Manager

Violations:

If you receive a Violation notice and you do not comply or reach out to the Office, we will correct the non-compliance and charge the owner up to \$200.00 for labor/supplies to correct non-compliances. You are given thirty (30) days to correct violations. If you are away from the Park for any extended time, please be sure you hire someone to take care of your Unit and surrounding areas. Please be sure to put away any loose objects that can be caught in a hurricane, storm or high winds. It is your responsibility to care for your Unit and surroundings; weeding, bushes trimmed, painting, power washing, carport, etc... We send out numerous violation letters at once and it can take Park Management time to address the Units that do not comply with the violation. If anyone would like to volunteer to help out a neighbor who is physically unable to address their violations, please let us know. I'm sure your neighbor would be appreciative.

<u>Park Communication</u>: VOLO Village has been passed. It will tentatively start January 1st. If you wish to sign up for VOLO Village please reach out to the Office, via phone or email. We would need your name, phone number and/or email address. The Office will set you up but it will be your responsibility to let us know of any changes to your phone number or email address.

VOLO Village is a messaging service that will allow Park Management to send out Announcements or Alerts to all Residents that wish to sign up. VOLO can send you an email, text message or phone call when Park Management has an important announcement or an emergency alert.

<u>Clubhouse</u>: Due to the increase in COVID cases in Florida, the Clubhouse will remain closed until further notice.

<u>Cameras/Speeding</u>: Reminder: you are on Camera! We have numerous cameras set up in the Park with night vision. If you are caught speeding in the Park you will receive a warning. If it continues you can be banned from driving in the Park. If you see someone speeding, please don't hesitate to call the office with the date, time and color of the vehicle. We will view the cameras and get the license plate number. If it is a non-resident that uses our Park to cut through to Seminole or Ulmerton we can call the Largo Police and turn over camera footage.

<u>Payments for Rent/Maintenance:</u> Any Resident who drops their checks off at the office must mail them directly to BB&T (with coupon only) or Qualified Property Management (without coupon).

Starting January 1, 2020, we will no longer accept checks at the Office. If you do not have a coupon book you must send your checks directly to QPM Office, 5901 US-19 #7-Q, New Port Richey, FL 34652. We will only accept checks from brand new owners as it takes time to set up a new account. If you have any questions please call or email the Office.

<u>Complaints/Concerns/Suggestions:</u> Reminder: If you have a complaint it must be in writing. You can fill out a form (located outside the office on railing) or email the Office. The email address is pointewestoffice@gmail.com.

born there and laid in a manger. Angels proclaimed him a savior for all people, and shepherds came to adore him.

Hanukkah – The festival is observed by lighting the candles of a candelabrum with nine branches, called a menorah (or hanukkiah). One branch is typically placed above or below the others and its candle is used to light the other eight candles. Each night, one additional candle is lit until all eight candles are lit together on the final night of the festival. Other Hanukkah festivities include playing the game of dreidel and eating oil-based foods, such as latkes and sufganiyot, and dairy foods. Although a relatively minor holiday in strictly religious terms, Hanukkah has attained major cultural significance in North America and elsewhere among secular Jews as a Jewish alternative to Christmas, and is often celebrated correspondingly fervently.

Boxing Day - Boxing Day is traditionally celebrated on 26 December, the day after Christmas Day, though many people hold - and there is documentary assertion - that it would not fall on a Sunday and consequently Monday 27 December would be Boxing Day.

In Canada, Boxing Day is a federal holiday. Government offices, banks and post offices/delivery are closed. In some Canadian provinces, Boxing Day is a statutory holiday that is always celebrated on 26 December. In Canadian provinces where Boxing Day is a statutory holiday and it falls on a Saturday or Sunday, compensation days are given in the following week.

The European tradition of giving money and other gifts to those in need, or in service positions, has been dated to the Middle Ages, but the exact origin is unknown. It is sometimes believed to be in reference to the Alms Box placed in the narthex of Christian churches to collect donations to the poor. The tradition may come from a custom in the late Roman/early Christian era wherein alms boxes placed in churches were used to collect special offerings tied to the Feast of Saint Stephen, which in the Western Christian Churches falls on the same day as Boxing Day, the second day of Christmastide. On this day, it is customary in some localities for the alms boxes to be opened and distributed to the poor.

Kwanzaa - Kwanzaa is celebrated from December 26 to January 1. Each of the seven days of Kwanzaa is dedicated to one of the following principles, as follows:

- Umoja (Unity): To strive for and to maintain unity in the family, community, nation, and race.
- Kujichagulia (Self-Determination): To define and name ourselves, as well as to create and speak for ourselves.
- ❖ Ujima (Collective Work and Responsibility): To build and maintain our community together and make our brothers' and sisters' problems our problems and to solve them together.
- ❖ Ujamaa (Cooperative economics): To build and maintain our own stores, shops, and other businesses and to profit from them together.
- Nia (Purpose): To make our collective vocation the building and developing of our community in order to restore our people to their traditional greatness.
- ❖ Kuumba (Creativity): To do always as much as we can, in the way we can, in order to leave our community more beautiful and beneficial than we inherited it.
- ❖ Imani (Faith): To believe with all our hearts in our people, our parents, our teachers, our leaders, and the righteousness and victory of our struggle.

Recipe Roundup

Peppermint Bark

Peppermint bark is a candy we cannot wait to get our hands on every holiday season. Luckily for you, you can make a batch in 10 minutes flat with just 4 ingredients. It's a holiday treat made of two types of chocolate—either semisweet or dark and white—and chopped candy canes.

Ingredients

- 12 oz. semisweet chocolate, chopped
- 12 oz. white chocolate, chopped
- 1/2 tsp. peppermint extract
- 8 candy canes, crushed

Directions

Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Fill the bottom of a large pot with 3" water and bring to simmer over medium heat. Reduce heat to low, then place a large heatproof bowl on top. Add semi-sweet chocolate and stir occasionally until chocolate has melted. Stir in extract. Pour into prepared baking sheet and spread into an even layer with an offset spatula. Refrigerate until set, about 20 minutes.

Over the same pot of barely simmering water, place another large heatproof bowl. Add white chocolate and stir until melted. Pour over set semi-sweet chocolate then top immediately with candy canes. Refrigerate until set, about 20 minutes.









Calm your ocean

B orn on the lowest rung of India's caste system, Dashrath Manjhi worked in the coal mines of Gehlaur village.


One day his wife was injured. The nearest doctor was in a
