Pointe West General Information

- 1. All renters/visitors required to register and apply for background check at the office. Show proof of age. Owners check-in and also leave departure date. Update your information.
- 2. Permit required for overnight parking in **designated** areas. Overnight street parking is not permitted. Obtain permit at office (5-L) during office hours.
- 3. Speed Limit in park: 10 MPH. Be aware of other cars when parking on streets. They are very narrow. Emergency vehicles should be able to pass easily.
- 4. Information on possible sales or rentals available at office.
- 5. Children must be accompanied by resident adult to use Pool & Clubhouse. All residents are to wear cover-up or Tee shirt when in clubhouse. DO NOT WALK INTO CLUBHOUSE WITH WET FEET!
- **6.** SAFETY HINT: Use a FLASHLIGHT when working during the dark hours after 6:00P. Golf Carts turn lights **ON**.
- 7. Residents should have <u>Emergency Contact information in their office file</u>, in case of medical problem or weather emergency.



Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

Fresh or frozen? The choice is yours

om may tell you over and over again to eat fruits and vegetables that are fresh, but nutrition experts say that frozen produce isn't necessarily inferior. According to *The New York Times*, most nutrients are surprisingly hardy: Iron, for example, stands up to freezing quite well, and fiber does its job whether it's frozen or fresh.

Scientists at the University of California-Davis analyzed the vitamin content in several different varieties of fresh and frozen produce, including blueberries, broccoli, carrots, spinach, and strawberries. They found no significant differences between fresh and frozen items, and even discovered that frozen broccoli contains more riboflavin—a B vitamin—than the fresh selection. Similarly, frozen blueberries have more vitamin C than fresh.

Experts recommend looking for produce frozen using the IQF process—individually quick frozen"—for the highest quality.

Watch for these sources of illness while traveling

Traveling has enough hassles—check-in lines, lost luggage, bad airline food—without adding germs to the mix. Be safe by watching out for these common sources of germs and bacteria that can make you sick when you travel (from the CNN website):

- Washroom stall locks. In one test, airport stall locks were found to have an average of 70 colony-forming units (CFUs) per square inch. Use soap and water or a good hand sanitizer after touching them.
- Seatbelt buckles. Clean your hands after buckling up. Airplane belt buckles can have up to 230 CFUs per square inch.
- Lavatory flush buttons. These can get pretty nasty, containing 265 CFUs per square inch (although overhead vents and tray tables have more).
- Drinking fountains. Thirsty? Maybe buy a bottle of water instead. The buttons on airport drinking fountains have been found to hold 1,240 CFUs per square inch.





Ancient gold belt dug up in U.K.

rcheologists in the U.K. have dug up a 3,000-year-old gold belt in Cambridgeshire, and it's now on display at the British Museum in London.

The object, known as a torc, is the largest ever unearthed. Torcs were usually worn around the neck, but this one measures 49.6 inches, suggesting it was worn as a belt between 1300 and 1100 B.C., or that it was worn by a sacred animal slated for sacrifice. The torc, made of 20 karat gold, weighs 1.6 pounds.

British scientists examining the artifact have found little sign of use or wear on the links used to fasten the torc together, so its original function remains a mystery.

Astronomers discover the sky's smallest asteroid

he universe is full of objects large and small: Sharp-eyed astronomers have recently discovered a near-Earth asteroid just 6 feet in diameter.

The asteroid, named 2015 TC25, was discovered in October 2015 by scientists working with the Catalina Sky Survey. It's one of the brightest of its kind ever observed, reflecting about 60 percent of the sunlight that hits it, and it's one of the fastest spinning. Astronomers speculate 2015 TC25 was chipped off another asteroid, (44) Nysa, a large bright object in the main asteroid belt that's about 44 miles in diameter.

The small rock is about the size of many meteorites that fall to Earth, but astronomers believe there's little likelihood of 2015 TC25 dropping on our planet very soon.

New light on our oldest ancestor, Lucy

The remains of "Lucy," the name given to the oldest human ancestor yet discovered, were found 42 years ago, and ever since scientists have debated whether she spent most of her time walking on the ground or climbing through the trees. The journal PLOS One reports that new evidence suggests the three-million-year-old woman had muscular arms, indicating that she may have been have been a tree dweller, at least some of the time.



A CT analysis of Lucy's fossilized skeleton shows that her arms were heavily built and similar to those of chimpanzees. Scientists speculate that Lucy may have slept up in the trees to avoid predators at night, spending as much of one-third of her life above the ground. The fact that Lucy may have died from falling out of a tree adds weight to the theory.

- Overestimating the impact. A 20-minute workout won't erase all the calories in a 12-inch pizza. Walking or running a mile, for example, only burns about 100 calories.
- Overeating before exercise. You need energy to exercise, but don't overdo it. A small snack rich in carbs is best—along with being hydrated.
- Overeating after exercise. Don't pig out after you work out. Fix a meal rich in protein and healthy carbs, like an egg on whole wheat toast or oatmeal with blueberries.

Take prompt action on eye injuries

our eyes can be the most vulnerable parts of your body at work. Accidents like chemical splashes or bumps can happen all too easily, and the first aid that you apply to your eyes can mean the difference between minor eye damage and blindness. Here are recommended first-aid techniques for some common situations:

- Foreign objects. Don't rub your eyes. Instead, lift your upper eyelid outward and gently pull it over your lower lashes. This will cause your eyes to tear, which can wash out the foreign object. However, if an object is embedded in your eye, don't try to remove it—immediately seek medical attention.
- Chemicals. Immediately flush your eyes with cool water for at least 15 minutes. If possible, keep your head under a stream of water from the faucet, or slowly pour water from a cup to your eyes. If you wear contacts, remove them immediately and then flush your eyes. See a doctor right away.
- **Cut or penetration.** Gently cover your eye with a bandage or gauze and go to a nearby hospital. Don't try to flush it with water, remove the object, or apply medication.



Technology changing our TV habits

The days of the whole family sitting around the TV watching the same show are over. We're still watching programming, but the options have boomed. According to The New York Times, the average American adult watches five hours and four minutes of TV per day, most of it live programming—about four and a half hours, with another 30 minutes coming from DVRs. That sounds like a lot, but it's actually down by 19 minutes from two years ago.

Most live programming is watched by people over 50. People 24 and under view about two fewer hours of live TV and DVR programming per week than they did in 2015. Millennials (25- to 34-year-olds) watch an hour less per week than that, down from 27.5 hours to 26.5. Viewers between 35 and 49 now mostly watch about 22 minutes less live programming per week.

Approximately 50 percent of U.S. households have subscriptions to online streaming services like Nextflix or Hulu. With tablets increasingly common—58 percent of U.S. homes have at least one—time spent consuming media on them has risen 63 percent from 2015.

Books: Not going away

ince the rise of e-books and e-readers like the Kindle, pessimistic pundits have predicted that the physical book would soon become obsolete. That isn't happening yet, though. A study from the Pew Research Center found that 73 percent of Americans have read at least one book in the last 12 months (a number unchanged since 2012), and most of them are reading print books: The survey found that 65 percent of Americans picked up a physical book when they read in the past year, far more than those who read at least one e-book (28 percent) or listened to an audiobook (14 percent).

We're living in a yoga nation now

region veryone seems to be into yoga these days, and the numbers show that it's growing in popularity. A 2016 survey by the Yoga Journal and Yoga Alliance found that some 36 million Americans practice yoga, up from 20.4 million in 2012. Yoga practitioners spent \$16 billion on classes, clothing, and equipment in 2016, an increase of \$10 billion from 2012.

Women make up 72 percent of yoga enthusiasts, although men are catching up. The survey found that 34 percent of Americans—approximately 80 million people—say they're likely to try yoga for the first time in 2017. The main reasons for doing yoga? Flexibility (61 percent), stress relief (56 percent), general fitness (49 percent), improved overall health (49 percent), and physical fitness (44 percent).
