I Strawberry Angel Food Cake Dessert

Perfect for that summer picnic!

Ingredients:

- 1 (10-inch) angel food cake
- 2 (8 ounce) packages cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 1 quart fresh strawberries, sliced
- 1 (18 ounce) jar strawberry glaze

Directions:

- 1. Crumble the cake into a 9x13 inch dish.
- 2. Beat the cream cheese and sugar in a medium bowl until light and fluffy. Fold in whipped topping. Mash the cake down with your hands and spread the cream cheese mixture over the cake.
- 3. In a bowl, combine strawberries and glaze until strawberries are evenly coated. Spread over cream cheese layer. Chill until serving.

Raspberry-Peach Pie

Ingredients:

- 4 cups fresh peaches peeled, pitted and sliced
- 1 cup fresh raspberries
- 3/4 cup white sugar
- 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 2 (9-inch) pie crusts
- 2 tablespoons butter, softened and cut into pieces
- 1 tablespoon coarse granulated sugar

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C).
- 2. Place peaches and berries in a colander for about 15 minutes to drain any excess fluid, then transfer to a large bowl. Gently toss with sugar, flour, and cinnamon. Transfer to a pie crust. Dot with butter, and top with remaining crust. Cut vents in top crust, and sprinkle with coarse sugar.
- 3. Bake 45 minutes in the preheated oven, until crust is golden brown.

Fun Facts About Elvis Presley

- Elvis' famous black hair was dyes his natural color was brown.
- Elvis purchased his first guitar when he was just 11 years old. He wanted a rifle, but his mama convinced him to get a guitar instead.
- In 1974, a local radio show offered a young Elvis (age 12) a chance to sing live on air, but he was too shy to go on.
- At 18, Elvis paid \$4 to make his first record, a gift for his mama.
- In 1954, Elvis auditioned for a gospel quartet named the Songfellows. They said no.
- The same year, a local radio DJ played Elvis' version of That's All Right. He went on to play it 13 more times that day, but had trouble convincing his audience that Elvis was white.
- His nickname for his manhood was reportedly Little Elvis.
- His breakthrough hit was Heartbreak Hotel, released in 1956 a song inspired by a newspaper article about a local suicide.
- When performing on TV in 1956, host Milton Berle advised Elvis to perform without his guitar, reportedly saying, "Let 'em see you, son." Elvis' gyrating hips caused outrage across the U.S. and within days he was nicknamed Elvis the Pelvis.
- A Florida judge called Elvis "a savage" that same year because he said that his music was "Undermining the youth." He was subsequently forbidden from shaking his body at a gig, so he waggled his finger instead in protest.
- He played only five concerts outside the U.S., all on a 3-day tour of Canada in 1957. Many believe that the reason why he never toured abroad again was that his longtime manager, Colonel Tom Parker, was an illegal immigrant from Holland who would have been deported had he applied for a U.S. passport.
- Col. Parker is said to have always had an eye for talent and for a quick buck prior to managing Elvis, Parker reportedly painted sparrow yellow to sell them as canaries.
- Elvis was 6 feet tall and wore a size 11 shoe.
- Recording Hound Dog in the studio, Elvis reportedly demanded 31 takes.
- Elvis bought his mansion, Graceland, in Memphis, TN in 1957 for \$100,000. It was named by its previous owner after his daughter, Grace.
- Performing "Are You Lonesome Tonight?" in Las Vegas in 1969, Elvis did one of his frequent lyric changes to amuse himself. Instead of "Do you gaze at your doorstep and picture me there?," he sang "Do you look at your bald head and wish you had hair?"
- In 1956, he began his film career with a western, Love Me Tender. His second film, Loving You, featured his parents as audience members. Following his mother's death in 1957, he never watched the film again. He went on the make a total of 31 movies in his career.
- In December 1957, Elvis was drafted into the U.S. Army, earning a \$78 monthly salary. During his brief two-year stint on active duty, he was unable to access his music-generated income of \$400,000.
- In 1959, while serving overseas in Germany, Elvin (then 24 years old) met his future wife, 14 year-old Priscilla Beaulieu. They were married 8 years later.
- Elvis' 1960 hit "It's Now or Never" so inspired a prisoner who heard it in jail that he vowed



to pursue a career in music upon his release. The artist, Barry White, was then serving a 4-month sentence for stealing tires.

- Elvis and Priscilla's only daughter, Lisa Marie Presley, was born in 1968. Lisa Marie latter married Michael Jackson and actor (and Elvis obsessive Nicholas Cage. Mr. Cage is reportedly the only person outside of Presley's immediate family to have ever see Elvis' Graceland bedroom.
- Following his divorce from Priscilla in 1972, Elvis was said to have allowed good-looking girls who waited outside Graceland to enter after hours. One night it was 152 women!
- Elvis' popularity faded in the 1960's with the rise of the Beatles, the Rolling Stones, and others. He successfully relaunched his career with a 1968 television special that came about because Elvis had walked down a busy Los Angeles street and had no one recognize or approach him.
- He was distantly related to former U.S. Presidents Abraham Lincoln and Jimmy Carter.
- Elvis recorded more than 600 songs, but did not write any of them.

10 More Fun Facts About The King of Rock and Roll

- #10 Elvis recorded 15 songs with the word "BLUE" in the title.
- #9 Elvis' favorite sandwich was peanut butter, bacon, banana, and honey!
- #8 Elvis released an entire album of between-song stage banter called "Having Fun With Elvis on Stage" just to fulfill a contractual obligation in '74 ... So it's an album of Elvis talking. In between songs!
- #7 After Presley's first TV appearance on 1956, Jackie Gleason said, "The kid has no right behaving like a sex maniac on a national show."
- #6 When Elvis and The Beatles met for the first time, a giant rock-n-roll party did NOT ensue. In fact, all parties involved remember the encounter as pleasantly low-key, if not a bit awkward.
- #5 Elvis was really good friends with Johnny Cash, and the two used to impersonate each other.
- #4 When Elvis Presley met President Nixon in December of 1970, he read aloud a six-page letter to the President, in which he revealed his desire to be made a "Federal Agent-at-Large" in the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs. Presley accused The Beatles of being 'un-American' for their open drug-taking and anti-Vietnam politics.
- #3 Elvis wore a cross, the Hebrew letter chai, and a star of David around his neck. "I don't want to miss out on heaven due to a technicality," he said.
- #2 Elvis wasn't only The King of Rock and Roll ... he was also a black belt in karate! If you were lucky enough to see him in concert, you might wind up getting a free demonstration.
- #1 Elvis once cracked up in the middle of a performance!! The King got a bad case of the giggles!!





Watch for the dangers of carbon monoxide

arbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless and nearly odorless gas created by the incomplete burning of solid, liquid, and gaseous fuels. It's poisonous to people and pets, so be careful. Symptoms of the poisoning are:

- Headache
- Fatigue
- Shortness of breath
- Nausea
- Dizziness



To prevent CO poisoning, take these precautions at work and at home:

- Buy and install a CO alarm. Make sure it meets safety requirements, and follow the directions for proper placement and installation.
- Install appliances properly. Most of them should be installed by a professional.
- Check your appliances. Have your heating system inspected and serviced every year.
- Only burn charcoal outdoors. Never burn it in a tent, home, garage, vehicle, etc.
- Make sure you turn off fuel-burning engine equipment when you are inside a garage or basement. Just having the doors open does not ensure your safety.
- Always follow the manual directions when servicing fuel-burning equipment.
- Do not use gas appliances, such as ranges, ovens or clothes dryers, to heat your home.
- If you use a fuel-burning appliance that is approved for indoors, make sure it is vented to the outside following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Install and use exhaust fans over gas stoves.
- Open flues when you use your fireplace.
- Choose the proper size wood-burning stove for your home.
- Have a professional inspect, clean and tune up your central heating system (furnaces, flues, and chimneys) annually.
