
























## **Monthly Memos**

## **Boost your thinking with Limits**

ometimes a few constraints can boost your creativity. As recounted on the Fast Company website, publisher Bennett Cerf bet one of his authors, Theo Geisel—better known as Dr. Seuss—that he couldn't write a children's book with just 50 different words. Seuss stepped up to the challenge and won the bet with his book, Green Eggs and Ham.

"Putting limits to encourage creativity might sound counterintuitive," writes JotForm CEO Aytekin Tank on the website. "But the thing is, constraints encourage more divergent thinking—and you can leverage built-in limits or apply them to the project at hand. For example, sometimes we'll tell our designers that they can only have 10 elements on a product screen. These limits stretch their problem-solving abilities and typically produce surprising results."



## Four paths to inspiration

Creativity calls for patience and a willingness to make mistakes along the way to success. The Thrive Global website offers some advice on how to begin this sometimes difficult path:

- Anticipate the future. Look at trends instead of the status quo. What's changing, and how can you take advantage of it? This helps you challenge conventional thinking and start finding new areas to explore.
- Let yourself play. Don't take your projects too seriously. Take time to relax and do something different. When working, give yourself the freedom to try something new and outlandish. Even if it leads nowhere, it should loosen up your mind so you can spot new possibilities.
- Let your mind wander. Focus is important, but so is a wide perspective. Think about the project you're working on, and allow your mind to explore all the angles without worrying about what's "right." A wandering mind will sometimes come across a useful idea.
- Embrace ambiguity. Look at elements that don't seem related, and try to forge connections in your mind. Looking for similarities instead of differences can help you link ideas usefully and develop more options than what's immediately apparent.



## **Creativity**

## **Inventive women from history**

ome of the most common things we use every day were invented by creative women. Here are a few, gathered by the Mental Floss website:



- Paper bags. Margaret Knight created the modern, flat-bottomed paper bag in 1868. Before then, paper bags looked like envelopes. A man tried to steal the idea and file a patent, but Knight filed a lawsuit and won the rights to her creation.
- Windshield wipers. Mary Anderson invented the first manual windshield wipers in 1903. They didn't take off because most drivers thought it was safer to simply drive through rain and snow than keep pulling a lever to clear it. Another woman, Charlotte Bridgwood, invented an automatic version in 1917, but it wasn't accepted either. Still, by 1920 windshield wipers were everywhere, starting with Cadillac, which began installing them on all its cars.
- Liquid paper. A secretary named Bette Nesmith Graham corrected her typing mistakes with white tempera paint. After years perfecting the formula in her kitchen, she patented Liquid Paper in 1958. Gillette bought her company in 1979 for \$47.5 million.
- Kevlar. This lightweight material will stop a bullet. It's five times stronger than steel. A chemist named Stephanie Kwolek discovered it by accident in 1966 as she was trying to develop a lightweight fiber for car tires.

## Da Vinci's bridge design would have worked

eonardo da Vinci is known for such paintings as "Mona Lisa" and "The Last Supper," but he was also a masterful engineer. According to the LiveScience website, in the 16th century he designed what would have been the longest bridge in the world at the time, connecting Constantinople to a nearby area called Galata over the Bosporus Sea. He was responding to a request for proposals from Sultan Bayezid, the ruler of the Ottoman Empire.



DaVinci's bridge was never built, but modern researchers from MIT have built a 3D replica of the bridge, using materials and construction equipment that would have been available in the 16th century. They found that da Vinci's design, using only a single arch, would have been structurally sound, thanks to compression that would have held the bridge's stones together. Leonardo was a true Renaissance man.



## **Happy Puppy**

ur pets make us happy, or we wouldn't have so many of them. Thirty-three percent of U.S. households have a dog, 11% have a cat, and 14% have both. The 2018 General Social Survey looked at the connection between pets and overall happiness.

The survey found that 36% of dog owners describe themselves as happy, and 18% of cat owners said the same. (Twenty-eight percent who have both a dog and a cat agreed)

Does that mean you'll be a happier person with a dog as opposed to a cat? Not necessarily. The survey found that dog owners are more likely than cat owners to be married and own their own homes, two factors that influence happiness and life satisfaction. Dog owners are more likely to engage in outdoor physical activity, another factor in overall happiness.

Whatever kind of pets you have, enjoy them and they'll bring you lots of happiness.

## It's hard to make friends

ere's some sad news: The average American hasn't made a new friend in five years, according to a survey of 2,000 adults by OnePoll, reported on the Sputnik News website. Forty-five percent of respondents said they struggle to make new friends.

Thirty percent said they have trouble finding new friends because they don't like going to bars. About 33% said they're worried everyone already has a well-established circle of friendships, and 29% said their hobbies aren't good for making friends. Twenty-one percent said moving to a new city had made it difficult to forge new connections.

Age may be a factor. A majority of participants felt that making friends was much easier in their early 20s. Most said they had the largest circle of friends at 23. The survey noted that the average U.S. adult has 16 active friendships.





## Learn about stroke - and how to recognize one

hat is a stroke? Also called a "brain attack," it's when blood to an area of the brain is blocked, or when there's sudden bleeding in the brain. Someone suffers a stroke every 40 seconds in the United States, according to the NBC News website. The website describes two different kinds of strokes that can occur:

- Ischemic stroke. This is caused by a blood clot or plaque blocking a blood vessel in the brain.
- Hemorrhagic stroke. This is the result of a blood vessel bursting and bleeding into the brain.



**F:** Face. The face of a person having a stroke usually droops. Ask the person to smile. If the smile is uneven, a stroke could be happening.

**A:** Arms. Ask the person to lift one or both arms above the head. A weak or numb arm is another symptom of stroke.

**S:** Speech. Is the person slurring his or her words, unable to speak, or difficult to understand?

**T:** Time to call 911. If the person exhibits any of these symptoms, call for medical help immediately.






