



## Weird Things You Didn't Know About Valentine's Day

#### The Price of Love

The average American will spend about \$120.00 on Valentine's Day.

Men spend almost twice as much on Valentine's Day as women do .The average man will spend about \$156, while the average woman will only spend \$85.

More than one-third of men would prefer not receiving a gift. Less than 20% of women feel the same way.

Around this season, a dozen long-stemmed roses can cost an average of \$75, or about 30% more than the normal price of \$58.

More than nine million pet owners are expected to buy gifts for their pets this Valentine's Day.

15% of U.S. women send themselves flowers on Valentine's Day.

#### I Choo Choo Choose You

Teachers receive the most valentines, followed by kids, mothers, wives and sweethearts. Over 50% of all Valentine's Day cards are purchased in the six days prior to the holiday.

The oldest surviving valentine dates from 1415. It is a poem written by Charles, Duke of Orleans to his wife. At the time, the duke was being held in the Tower of London following his capture at the Battle of Agincourt.

One billion valentines are sent each year worldwide, making it the second largest cardsending holiday of the year behind Christmas. Women purchase approximately 85% of all valentines.

In a classic Simpsons episode, Lisa gives Ralph a valentine with a picture of a locomotive saying, "I Choo Choo Choose You."

Hallmark produced its first valentine in 1913.

Today, Hallmark employs an 80-person research staff to analyze the sales pattern of previous valentines. That analysis, combined with more than 100,000 annual customer interviews, focus groups and in-store observations, will help create roughly 2,000 cards in Hallmark's core Valentine's Day line.

While Hallmark offers thousands of different cards for Valentine's Day, one card was the top choice of customers in New York, Los Angeles, and virtually every other city in the country in 2006.

### **Sharing Love Around the World**

In Japan, women are expected to give chocolate and other gifts to men on Valentine's Day. This tradition was started as a marketing campaign by Japanese chocolate companies. Men are not off the hook, unfortunately. They are expected to return the favor on March 14th, commonly known as White Day.

"I love you" in German is "Ich liebe dich."

## History, Legends, and Rumors

The roots of St. Valentine's Day can be traced back to the Roman fertility festival of Lupercalia. On Luperalia, a young man would draw the name of a young woman in a lottery and would then keep the woman as a sexual companion for the year.

## **Cherry Pinwheel Cookies Recipe**

TOTAL TIME: Prep: 30 min. + chilling; Bake: 10 min./batch

YIELD: 60 servings

### **Ingredients**

- 3/4 cup butter, softened
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 white egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons cherry extract or cherry brandy
- Red paste food coloring
- 1/4 cup ground almonds
- Coarse sugar

## **Directions**

- 1. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in egg and vanilla. In another bowl, whisk flour, baking powder and salt; gradually beat into creamed mixture. Refrigerate, covered, 1 hour.
- 2. Divide dough in half. Add extract to one half and tint red. Knead almonds into remaining half. Wrap each in plastic wrap; refrigerate at least 3 hours or until firm enough to roll.
- 3. On a baking sheet, roll each portion between two sheets of waxed paper into a 15 x 8-in. rectangle. Refrigerate 30 minutes.
- 4. Remove waxed paper. Place almond rectangle on top of cherry rectangle. Roll up tightly jelly-roll style, starting with a long side. Roll in coarse sugar; wrap in plastic wrap. Refrigerate 2 hours or until firm.
- 5. Preheat oven to 375°. Unwrap and cut dough crosswise into 1/4-in. slices. Place 2 in. apart on greased baking sheets. Bake 10-12 minutes or until set. Remove from pans to wire racks to cool completely. Store in airtight containers. Yield: 5 dozen.

## The Old Coot Reveals a Secret

ne of the burning questions across the country is, "What do old coots talk about when no one else is around?" It's a well-guarded secret, but in the spirit of Edward Snowden's release of the secret files at the N.S.A. I've decided it's time to let the world in on the "old coot conversations."

Old coots don't talk about religion or politics. They learned those subjects are taboo from years of experience and conversations that ended in arguments, fistfights and loss of friendships. Besides people believe what they believe and trying to talk them out of it is futile. Eventually, you learn this and keep your mouth shut.

How old we are - is one of our favorite topics. We can't talk about it enough. We just can't believe it! A couple of years ago we were complaining about turning thirty and now we're sitting around in clothes older than that, not believing we've been retired for 10, 20, or 30 years. We also do it to fish for compliments. A guy will say, "I'm 68!" We'll say, "Wow, you don't look a day over fifty" and hope he'll do the same when we tell him we're seventy-one. We know it's a lie, but it still feels good to hear it.

Who died - is always coming up. My crowd is in that phase of life. "John Doe died last week," one of us will report. Then the discussion ensues to find a reason why he left the building so early and why we won't do the same. "Did he still smoke?" - "He never did lose that beer gut like his doctor told him to." - "I told him, and told him, he needed to get out and walk more, move around." We loved John Doe, but still, we have to figure out that it's his fault and we are exempt from his fate.

What's his name - doesn't usually start out to be a topic in and of itself. It's an offshoot from one of the three other topics. "Joe what's his name has that sore neck thing you have. You know, the guy who used to live over by the guy from IBM next to the drug store." The conversation just skipped from one name to three. In trying to get it resolved, several more nameless people pop into the conversation. When it reaches a fever pitch we call it a day. Our brains overheat. We take our stiff necks, sore knees and sprained wrists and go home. The rest of the day is spent racking our brains to come up with one of the missing person's names so we can call or text the other guys and let them know we're not as senile as they are. If we could only remember where we put the phone.

## **Groundhog Day**

roundhog Day is a traditional holiday celebrated on February 2. According to folklore, if it is cloudy when a groundhog emerges from its burrow on this day, then the spring season will arrive early, some time before the vernal equinox. If it is sunny, the groundhog will supposedly see its shadow and ratreet back into its day, and winter weather will possible day, and ratreet back into its day, and winter weather will possible day.

Groundhog Day was adopted in the U.S. in 1887. Clymer H. Freas was the editor of the local paper Punxsutawney Spirit at the time, and he began promoting the town's groundhog as the official "Groundhog Day meteorologist."

The largest Groundhog Day celebration is held in Punxsutawney, Pennsylvania, with Punxsutawney Phil. Groundhog Day, already a widely recognized and popular tradition received widespread attention as a result of the 1993 film Groundhog Day.

The celebration began as a Pennsylvania German custom in southeastern and central Pennsylvania in the 18th and 19th centuries.

### Meteorological Accuracy

According to Groundhog Day organizers, the rodents' forecasts are accurate 75% to 90% of the time. According to the StormFax Weather Almanac and records kept since 1887, Punxsutawney Phil's weather predictions have been correct 39% of the time. The National Climatic Data Center has described the forecasts as "on average, inaccurate" and stated that "the groundhog has shown no talent for predicting the arrival of spring, especially in recent years.

## In popular culture

At the end of Disney's 1930 Silly Symphonies short film Winter, Mr. Groundhog the Weather Prophet comes out of his hole to determine whether or not there will be more winter. At first, he does not see his shadow, but the clouds clear and his shadow appears, causing him to run back inside. At this point, the winds pick up again ad winter continues.

Tex Avery's 1940 Warner Brothers cartoon Wacky Wildlife features a brief gag with a groundhog that peeks outside, then retreats into a burrow filled with high-tech (for the time) weather equipment.

In the 1979 Rankin-Bass Christmas TV special Jack Frost, a crucial plot point in the story involves Jack casting his own shadow on Groundhog Day for six more weeks of winter. At the end of the story it is revealed that the narrator (voiced by Buddy Hackett) is the groundhog.

The 1993 comedy movie Groundhog Day is set in Punxsutawney, Pennsylvania on this day. The main character is forced to relive the day over and over again until he can learn to give up his selfishness and become a better person.

In Disney's 2006 film Bambi II, Bambi accompanies his friends Thumper and Flower to go and see the Groundhog, whose shadow will foretell if winter will end soon.

Even within the U.S. Groundhog Day is not necessarily observed uniformly throughout the entire country; it is sometimes acknowledged differently in western and southeastern states where groundhogs are generally not considered indigenous. In the state of Alaska, for example,

Marmot Day is celebrated on February 2 instead.

Likewise the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area in Clark County, Nevada is home to a similar tradition that has been observed since 2000 with a desert tortoise named Mojave Max.

Louisiana celebrations also vary somewhat from the traditional Groundhog Day theme. Since about the 1980s Groundhog Day in New Orleans has featured T-Boy the Nutria, a coypu based at the Audubon Zoo.

Since 1997 Pierre C. Shadeaux, also a coypu, has been the focus of "Cajun Groundhog Day" festivities in New Iberia. Because of Louisiana's subtropical climate, Pierre actually forecasts either a longer spring or an earlier summer, as opposed to the usual groundhog options of a longer winter or an earlier spring.

Another Louisiana tradition influenced by Groundhog Day occurs in Shreveport on February 1 - one day before Groundhog Day - centering on Claude the Cajun Crawfish. Claude annually predicts the weather for Northwest Louisiana-area parades held during Mardi Gras season, a season that has a long history in Louisiana but also happens to overlap with Groundhog Day festivities.

#### **Incidents**

Several unforeseen incidents have involved animals handled during Groundhog Day events. During New York City's annual Groundhog Day event at the Staten Island Zoo on February 2, 2009, a groundhog named "Chuck" drew blood when biting Mayor Michael Bloomberg's gloved finger while Bloomberg was trying to lure Chuck out of his wooden shelter. Five years later, on February 2, 2014, Bloomberg's mayoral successor, Bill de Blasio, dropped "Chuck" (subsequently revealed to be Chuck's granddaughter "Charlotte"), who seven days later died of "acute internal injuries." At the city's next Groundhog Day event on February 2, 2015, "Staten Island Chuck" walked out of a hutch that an elevator had lifted onto the stage of a portable Plexiglas-enclosed habitat, while de Blasio watched from six feet way.

During Sun Prairie, Wisconsin's annual Groundhog Day celebration on February 2, 2015, "Jimmy the Groundhog" bit Mayor Jonathan Freund's ear while being held by Jimmy's caretaker. The next day, Fruend issued a proclamation that officially pardoned and absolved Jimmy "of any perceived wrongdoing and charges" under the city's ordinance. The proclamation stated that Jimmy had "created an international media sensation, thereby helping the world to learn more about our great City."

Following the biting incident, the United States Department of Agriculture and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources informed the organization that had sponsored Sun Prairie's celebration that capturing wild animals for exhibit was against the law. The organization's manager then reported that Jimmy had escaped from his hutch before she could respond to these complaints. Sun Prairie's next Groundhog Day celebration on February 2, 2016, featured a caged groundhog purchased for \$1,200, an elected costumed "mascot" and a different mayor.

Two days later, the patient called us concerned that he had missed our calls because of poor hearing. "I can barely hear, barely see, and barely walk" he told me.


Then he added cheerfully, "Things could be worse, though. At least I can still drive."
