



Tell, it's all over for another year & it was a success despite all the road blocks we faced.

In the end, each of the 5 participating clubs received \$832.47.

Earning that amount was no small chore. It began in summer, before most Ranchers arrived for the season, with new purchasers donating items & it just took off like a golf ball-sized snowball at the top of a very steep hill & by the end of January that gigantic snowball gave up it's exhausting journey to come to rest in the shuffleboard room, the middle shuffleboard courts, the garage where the truck is parked, the Maintenance garage, under the outside overhang behind the kitchen & anywhere else that seemed a likely spot to place old treasures. One observation made this year is that in the future, the donated furniture will have to be carefully looked at before being accepted for sale. Buyers are being more observant & wanting only items in top condition with no staining, no rips & tears & no obvious signs of wear. Some items may have to be refused in the future to maintain our sales market.

Every single volunteer who helped in any way deserves our thanks & appreciation. This includes all the wonderful "young" fellas who both picked up & later delivered furniture & other goods, all those who took in the bountiful donations on Mondays & Wednesdays, those who helped to set up the club House on the Thursday evening after Bingo the very busy workers who not only hauled all the goodies into the Club House on Friday but also distributed then to their venues, unpacked, sorted, discarded, folded, priced items. Let us not forget the furniture crew who set up the Pavilion working diligently to sell the bounty, the kitchen crew who made the lunches for the Saturday volunteers, the Saturday volunteers who worked so hard to sell anything & everything & then stayed behind to pack up & put the club House back to rights. This was no mean feat when we sadly learned that the company that promised to pick up all our left-overs decided to only pick up certain items, leaving us with a mountain to move in a very short period of time. Lucky for us we had more people volunteer to take the left-overs & distribute then with their trash on Monday, take recyclable goods to the re-cycle bins, take goods to High Point, the Pregnancy Centre thrift store & the Salvation Army. Our heartfelt thanks to the fellas who cut, chopped & sawed up the remaining furniture into pieces small enough to then place into a dumpster bin. They filled it in under 1/2 hour.

Volunteers are the life blood of our Ranch Mobile Community & without them the clubs would not function, there would be no dinners, no activities, no fun, no life, no sense of community. You may not realize it but almost all Ranches are able to volunteer in some way. Roll up a tablecloth after a dinner & put it in the trash, clean up & reset the Club House after a dance, dinner or event, wash or dry dishes in the kitchen after a dinner, prepare a dinner, put up the wind barrier or clean the chairs around the pool, set the tables for a dinner, decorate the

Pavilion at Christmas, etc.

Just 1 hour per person once a year would be so much appreciated by the veteran volunteers who are still at it after many years but showing a little wear & tear. Some of these volunteers cook the meals, set the tables, serve the meal & then clean up after everyone else has gone. These volunteers have paid the same price as everyone else for their meal, but have given so much more. Please, show them a little love, give of your time to make this mobile park, YOUR mobile park, an even better place to proudly call home.



Classic Cabbage Rolls

Ingredients

- 1 medium head cabbage
- 1-1/2 cups chopped onion, divided
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 cans (14-1/2 ounces each) Italian stewed tomatoes
- 4 garlic cloves, minced
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1-1/2 teaspoons salt, divided
- 1 cup cooked rice
- 1/2 cup ketchup
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1 pound lean ground beef (90% lean)
- 1/4 pound bulk Italian sausage
- 1/2 cup V8 juice, optional
- 1. In a Dutch oven, cook cabbage in boiling water for 10 minutes or until outer leaves are tender, drain. Rinse in cold water; drain.
- 2. Remove eight large outer leaves (refrigerate remaining cabbage for another use); set aside.
- 3. In a large saucepan, saute 1 cup onion in butter until tender. Add the tomatoes, garlic, brown sugar and 1/2 teaspoon salt. Simmer for 15 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- 4. Meanwhile, in a large bowl, combine the rice, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce, pepper and remaining onion and salt. Crumble beef and sausage over mixture and mix well.
- 5. Remove thick vein from cabbage leaves for easier rolling. Place about 1/2 cup meat mixture on each leaf; fold in sides. Starting at an unfolded edge, roll up leaf to completely enclose filling. Please seam side down in a skillet. Top with the sauce.
- 6. Cover and cook over medium-low heat for 1 hour. Add V8 juice if desired. Reduce heat to low; cook 20 minutes longer or until rolls are heated through and a thermometer inserted in the filling reads 160°. Yield" 4 servings.

In the centuries following Patrick's death (believed to have been on March 17, 461), the mythology surrounding his life became ever more ingrained in the Irish culture: Perhaps the most well known legend is that he explained the Holy Trinity (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) using the three leaves of a native Irish clover, the shamrock.

Since around the ninth or tenth century, people in Ireland have been observing the Roman Catholic feast day of St. Patrick on March 17. Interestingly, however, the first parade held to honor St. Patrick's Day took place not in Ireland but in the United States. On March 17, 1762, Irish soldiers serving in the English military marched through New York City. Along with their music, the parade helped the soldiers reconnect with their Irish roots, as well as with fellow Irishmen serving in the English army.

Growth of St. Patrick's Day Celebrations

Over the next 35 years, Irish patriotism among American Immigrants flourished, prompting the rise of so-called "Irish Aid" societies like the Friendly Sons of Saint Patrick and the Hibernian Society. Each group would hold annual parades featuring bagpipes (which actually first became popular in the Scottish and British armies) and drums.

In 1848, several New York Irish Aid societies decided to unite their parades to form one official New York City St. Patrick's Day Parade. Today, that parade is the world's oldest civilian parade and the largest in the United States, with over 150,000 participants. Each year, nearly 3 million people line the 1.5 mile parade route to watch the procession, which takes more than five hours. Boston, Chicago, Philadelphia and Savannah also celebrate the day with parades involving between 10,000 and 20,000 participants each.




