

Parmesan Baked Pork Chops

- 4 boneless pork chops





The Old Coot Will Tell Your Mother

"I'm going to tell your mother!" That's what a neighbor said when she caught me cutting through her backyard garden. I was five years old and on my way to a friend's house to play Cowboys and Indians. Like all kids, I took short cuts, going through yards, over fences, along the top of walls, under hedges, and yes, between the rows of tomato plants in backyard gardens. It was the law of the jungle in my world; we had to take the shortest route. Unless, someone threatened to tell our mother. Then, we went the long way. We knew we'd get it when we got home if we didn't. usually, with the switch to the back of our legs. Sometimes my mother used a yardstick, the cord to the coffee pot or anything handy if I'd made her made enough. I'll never forget the day she grabbed a hairbrush and broke it when she missed my backside and hit the doorframe. Then I really got it!

Some kids had it worse, the ones whose mothers didn't handle discipline. They made an "arrest" and held the "criminal" in captivity for the "executioner," by saying, "Wait until your father gets home!" Not only would the kid get spanked like we did, but he also had to suffer for hours on death row, knowing when his father came through the door after a long day at work, he'd really get it. My mother spared me that ordeal; she dealt with my misdeeds on the spot. I learned the immediate connection between bad behavior and consequences. I was lucky. (So was my father.)

Now kids get the "one – two – three" business. "Stop doing that! I'm going to count to three!" I'm not sure what that means. Usually, the kid keeps right on doing what he was doing, until phase two kicks in and mom or dad says, "I mean it; I'm starting to count. Right now!" After about five courses of this meal the punishment is served up, a "timeout" in a room loaded with toys, video games, computers and cell phones.

Our deal was better. It was over and done with. We shaped up. The threat to tell our mother was powerful. It has no legs anymore. If you threaten a misbehaving kid with a threat to tell his mother, you're apt to get a call from the police for harassment, or a lawyer informing you that you are being sued. And, the kid gets off scot-free. It's a huge loss to society. It's harder for teachers to teach and for the village to raise the children. We've been disarmed. If I could find out who is to blame, I'd go tell his mother!

became the world's oldest mother when she gave birth to a baby boy. Satyabhama and her husband had been married 50 years, but this is their first child. The baby was conceived through artificial insemination using eggs from the woman's 26-year-old niece, Veenarani Mahapatra, and the sperm of Veenarani's husband.

Mother's Day Trivia: Most Surviving Children

Bobbie McCaughey is the mother who holds the record for the most surviving children from a single birth. She gave birth to the first set of surviving septuplets – four boys and three girls – on November 19, 1977, at the University Hospital, Iowa, US. Conceived by in vitro fertilization, the babies were delivered after 31 weeks by cesarean in the space of 16 minutes. The babies are named Kenneth, Nathaniel, Brandon, Joel, Kelsey, Natalie and Alexis.

Mother's Day Trivia: Shortest Interval Between Two Children

Jayne Bleackley is the mother who holds the record for the shortest interval between two children born in separate confinements. She gave birth to Joseph Robert on September 3, 1999, and Annie Jessica Joyce on March 30, 2000. The babies were born 208 days apart.

Mother's Day Trivia: Longest Interval Between Two Children

Elizabeth Ann Buttle is the mother who holds the record for the longest interval between the birth of two children. She gave birth to Belinda on May 19, 1956 and Joseph on November 20, 1997. The babies were born 41 years, 185 days apart. The mother was 60 years old when her son Joseph was born.

Mother's Day Trivia: Highest Recorded Number of Children

The highest officially recorded number of children born to one mother is 69, to the first wife of Feodor Vassilyev (1707-1782) of Shuya, Russia. Between 1725 and 1765, in a total of 27 confinements, she gave birth to 16 pairs of twins, seven sets of triplets, and four sets of quadruplets. 67 of them survived infancy.

Mother's Day Trivia: Highest Number of Children in Modern Times

The modern world record for giving birth is held by Leontina Albina from San Antonio, Chile. Leontina claims to be the mother of 64 children, of which only 55 of them are documented. She is listed in the 1999 Guinness World Records but dropped in later editions.

Mother's Day Trivia: On Women and Motherhood

24.8 is the median age of women when they give birth for the first time – meaning one-half are above this age and one-half are below. The median age has risen nearly three years since 1970.

A woman becomes pregnant most easily at the age of eighteen or nineteen, with little real change until the mid-twenties. There is then a slow decline to age thirty-five, a sharper decline to age forty-five and a very rapid decline as the woman nears menopause.

The odds of a woman delivering twins is 1-in-33. Her odds of having triplets or other multiple births was approximately 1-in-539.

When the female embryo is only six weeks old, it makes preparations for her motherhood



So much signage on so small a surface. It's no wonder the dummy (not me) at the front of the line didn't notice the "press" sign.

We all made it to Sanford intact, but a few of us sported bruises, nicks or sc

rapes on our faces, elbows and knees, the result of bumping and stumbling in the aisles as we impatiently rushed from one venue to another, determined to get our money's worth and to be first in line at everything (which is what old coots do), saying to the world, "I'm old; I don't have much time left; let me through!" I don't know hwat my wife was thinking when she made the reservation.


No one knows more about old coots than me, having studied and written about my species for going on two decades, yet I went right ahead and put myself in harm's way. Next year I'm taking a jet plane!




