Please remember, we do not have Spa workers at our pool. When using the facilities for you and your GUESTS, go over all the Pool rules with them, always shower upon entering and exiting, rinse off any noodles or barbell after use and return to the utility chest. Use a towel on the lounges and chairs, always replace them to their corrected positions, straighten and remove all articles you carried in (towels, goggles, sunglasses, water bottles, etc.) Never bring in anything but plastic water containers. We do not wish to have any glass broken causing an interruption with the use of the pool. No cans of soda or alcoholic drinks enticing bees and flies and gnats to join us in our fun. Always be respectful to the property and other swimmers.

We had some issues at the pool this Spring, involving someone with a cut and bleeding and a child throwing up in the pool. Because of these instances we now have commanding rules to adhere to. If there is bleeding on the grounds or other bodily fluids rendered, YOU need to immediately close the pool and call a member of the governing board to conduct the proper cleaning. It may involve the Pool closing for a day or so, depending on the matter.

Safety First: Please if anyone has an open wound or feeling ill; do not come into the pool area. We need to have respect and protect our fellow Ranchers from infection and disease. We all need to keep the Pool clean and safe and follow the rules listed next to the shower area.

Read Across America takes place on the closest school day to Dr. Seuss birthday which is on March 2nd. "Be awesome! Be a book Nut!: ~ Dr. Seuss

Here are some facts about Dr. Seuss

- Dr. Seuss real name was Theodor Seuss Geisel.
- He was born on March 2, 1904 in Springfield Massachusetts.
- Dr. Seuss wasn't really a doctor.
- Dr. Seuss used Dr. as part of his name because his father always wanted him to be a doctor.
- Dr. Seuss was an author, poet, screenwriter, illustrator, film producer, television producer, songwriter, animator and visual artist.
- At the age of 18 Dr. Seuss went to Dartmouth College in New Hampshire.
- While he was at Dartmouth he was the editor in chief for their magazine Jack-o-Lantern. He later lost his position as editor for drinking alcohol in his dorm.
- After graduating Dartmouth Dr. Seuss moved to England and attended Oxford University. He left Oxford and moved back to the United States.
- Before writing children's books Dr. Seuss wrote advertisements for General Electric, Standard Oil, NBC and other companies.
- Dr. Seuss first book was And To Think That I Saw It on Mulberry Street was published in 1937. The book was turned down 27 times by publishing companies.
- During World War II Dr. Seuss wrote war propaganda cartoons. He also made animated films for soldiers.
- Dr. Seuss is credited for the first person using the word Nerd. he used the word in his book If I Ran the Zoo in 1950.
- Did you know that Dr. Seuss didn't interact well with children! His wife Audrey once said he was afraid of children.
- Dr. Seuss did not have any children of his own.
- Dr. Seuss once said that the character the Grinch is based on himself!
- The book Green Eggs and Ham only contains 50 different words. He wrote the book based continued on page 10



on a bet. A publisher bet him that he couldn't write a book using few words. Dr. Seuss won the bet!

- Dr. Seuss has written and illustrated 44 children's books.
- His children's books have been translated in over 15 languages.
- Dr. Seuss was given an honorary doctorate degree from Dartmouth College.
- He has won 2 Academy Awards, 2 Emmy Awards, a Peabody Award and a Pulitzer Prize.
- Dr. Seuss died on September 24, 1991.



15 Cream-Filled Facts About Oreos

veryone's favorite treat with the 71 percent to 9 percent cookie-to-cream ratio has more layers than you might think. Here are just a few of the things you probably didn't know about the Oreo.

1. HYDROX WAS THE ORIGINAL

Hydrox might seem like an Oreo knock-off, but these cookies actually came first, debuting in 1908 - four years before the Oreo.

2. DOUBLE-STUF MIGHT BE A MISNOMER

They're actually only 1.86 times bigger than regular Oreos. You can thank a high school math class in upstate New York for the detective work - though following the revelation, a spokesperson for the cookie insisted they do in fact contain "double the stuff."

3. OREO O'S CEREAL WAS A THING

The cereal was launched in 1998 and discontinued in 2007. It's not totally extinct, though: It's still being produced in South Korea.

4. THERE'S A TOOL FOR EASY DIPPING

Those who love to enjoy Oreos dunked in milk should invest in The Dipr. The hook-like (or reaper-like) utensil is perfectly designed to snugly cup an Oreo cookie, allowing for easy dunking - and ensuring that none of the cookie gets lost in the liquid. There's even a shallow, color-coordinated dish to combat the classic problem of not being able to fit your hand in a slim glass of milk.

5. PIGS HATE OREOS

We have the folks over at Ben & Jerry's to thank for this discovery. When the company started giving its milky water waste to a local pig farmer in 1985, the farmer reported that his hogs loved every flavor except for Mint and Oreo Cookies. Guess every man (and hog) has his limits.

6. THEY'RE DIFFERENT IN CHINA

While beloved in the United States, Oreos didn't do so well when they were introduced in China in 1996. They were almost pulled from the market, but then Kraft decided to ask Chinese consumers for their input. As a result of that research, eventually created an Oreo that looks nothing like the one we know: It's essentially a tube-shaped treat with four layers of crispy wafer and vanilla or chocolate filling

7. OREO CREAM MAKES FOR GREAT ART

Artist Tisha Cherry makes incredible tiny pieces of artwork on the canvas of Golden Oreos, using novelty Oreo cookies from over the years for color and a toothpick as yer tool. Her Instagram has everything from Oreo-d Frida Kahlo to American Gothic and lots of other food art in between.

Oh sure, there are dunkers out there. Of the ketchup and French-fry ilk or the Oreos and milk variety. Here and there a grilled cheese gets dunked in tomato soup. But, the legion of donut dunkers that lined the silver diners vanished a decade or two ago. The Seinfeld TV show made the last mention of dunking in public on Season 3, episode 7, when the camera panned to a well-dressed gentleman dunking a donut in Dinky Donuts. Kramer claimed it was Joe DiMaggio. (We'll never know for sure.)

People buy donuts by the dozen and consume them in private at home these days. No one hops on a bar stool, executes a 360 degree swivel and orders a cup of Joe and 2 plain donuts. And dunks! Even the company that took the dunking process as their namesake (Dunkin Donut) backed away from their heritage and discontinued the "dunkin" donut with its little dunking handle. It no longer has a home on the racks that line the back wall. Coffee comes in a Styrofoam container with a lid. Who can dunk in that atmosphere?

Now that I've got that out of my system, I forgot my point. that's what you get from an old coot. A long rant about the good old days and then nothing. I don't even know what got me started. Probably that trip to the dentist last week so Pam could fix yet another tooth that started to come apart (an "old age" thing). It must have got me looking into the future, to a time when I'll only be able to eat a donut if I can dunk it. Sitting on a stool in the diner and saying, "Hi," to someone who greets me with, "How you doing Gummy?" That's even worse than being called, :Old Coot!"



Caramel Apple Crisp Bars

Makes about 16

INGREDIENTS

3 large Granny Smith apples, peeled, halved, and sliced 1/4 inch thick

3 large Honeycrisp apples, peeled, halved, and sliced 1/4 inch thick

1 cup granulated sugar, divided

3-2/3 cups all purpose flour, divided

1-1/2 cups plus 2/3 cup firmly packed light brown sugar, divided

2 tablespoons cornstarch

1 tablespoon ground cinnamon

2-1/2 teaspoons kosher salt, divided

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg

3 cups old-fashioned oats

1-3/4 cups unsalted butter, softened

1-1/4 teaspoons baking soda

1 cup chopped pecans

1 (11 ounce) bag individually wrapped caramel candies, unwrapped

2 tablespoon heavy whipping cream

DIRECTIONS

- 1. In a large bowl, stir together apples and 1/2 cup of granulated sugar. Let stand for 30 minutes.
- 2. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Line a 13x9" pan with foil and then parchment paper, letting excess extend over the sides.
- 3. Drain apples, discarding liquid. Stir 2/3 cup each of flour and brown sugar, cornstarch, cinnamon, 1 teaspoon salt, vanilla, and nutmeg into apples until well combined..
- 4. In a large bowl, beat oats, butter, baking soda, remaining 3 cups flour, remaining 1-1/2 cups brown sugar and remaining 1-1/2 teaspoons salt with a mixer at medium speed until well combined and crumbly. Press 4 cups of mixture into the bottom of the prepared pan. Stir pecans into the remaining mixture, and reserve.
- 5. Bake rust for 20 minutes. Let cool 5 minutes.
- 6. Spread apple mixture onto hot crust, and sprinkle with reserve oat mixture. Bake 40 minutes more. Remove from oven, and let cook completely in pan on a wire rack. Refrigerate until firm, 2 to 3 hours.
- 7. Using excess foil and parchment as handles, remove from pan, and cut into bars. In a medium microwave-safe bowl, heat the caramels and cream on high in 14 second intervals, stirring between each, until melted and smooth, about 1 minute. Drizzle bars with caramel, and let stand until set, about 3 minutes. Cover and refrigerate for up to 3 days.




