There is no parking allowed on the grass. All vehicles are to be in the carports at night. If you park on the street do not block your neighbors' access to their carport. Do not park directly across the street from a driveway.

If you give permission to someone to park in your carport, put it in writing and submit it to the office.

NOISE

As a courtesy, notify your neighbors prior to starting a job that you anticipate will create noise. Communication with your neighbors can prevent complaints from arising and resolve concerns before there is a problem.

Mitigate noise from power equipment or other noise producing activities with sound barriers, muffling devices, lower settings on power equipment, and shortened work periods.

If you have questions about the Noise Ordinance, or would like a health inspector to take noise readings, call 727-464-4761 and tell them you would like someone to come out and test the decibels of the noise.



WATER BILLING QUESTIONS FROM AFAR

If you get a water bill that you question while you are away from Ranchero Village, please contact the caregiver for your home right away and have them go in and make sure there are no leaks, the hot water heater is turned off and the water valves are all closed. Have they been watering the lawn or doing anything around the home that requires water? It is so important to have someone watching your home and inspecting it regularly to make sure there are no problems.

If the caregiver says the house is okay and does not find a cause for the bill, then contact the community office and we will have a reread done on the water meter to try to determine the cause of the problem. Sometimes it is just a reading or data entry error, but many times toilets and water heaters are the culprits that send water usage through the roof. They are the sneaky leaks that leave no trail but can be extremely expensive.

One way to check for leaks is by placing food coloring in the upper tank of your toilet. If it seeps down into the toilet bowl, you have a leak. Another way to check for household leaks is record your water meter level before and after a two-hour period of no water use. If the meter increases over the time period, you have a leak.

DOGS

Dog are to be walked only in the dog section and on the street. Do not walk your dog around your neighbors' home. Remember to clean up after.

HOT TUB USE is for adults only. NO ONE UNDER 18 IN HOT TUB

Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, no longer than 15 minutes. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

<u>GLASS BOTTLES</u> – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

<u>No smoking at the pools</u> – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes vape and e-cigarettes.

UMBRELLAS

Close pool umbrellas when you are finished using them.

All requests and complaints should be put in writing and signed. Anonymous reports will not be addressed. Forms are available in the office for your convenience. Do not ask your neighbor to file complaints for you.
