

If you have not received your Charter letter in a plain envelope explaining what to do to get the Special Bulk Rate call 833-697-7328 on or after January 1, 2019 to order.

This is a Spectrum Bulk Rate phone and they will tell you what to do for your home.

Spectrum Bulk Rate of Cable, Internet and WiFi at \$15.26 (includes tax) a month for the first year. This is a very exciting time for our Community. \$15.26 including tax will be included in your Monthly Maintenance (similar to the way we charge sewer.)

When using the Rose Tree Gate on First Street, please make sure to lock the gate after going through. This gate should be kept locked at all times.

SOLICITORS!!! DO NOT let them into your home! Call the Largo Police Department (587-6730) immediately and please notify the community office. Management is working very hard to discourage these predators from coming into the park. If a solicitor tells you they have received permission from the office to be in the park, do not believe it. Management <u>NEVER</u> gives permission for solicitation.

******ALL TRASH AND RECYCLING WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF IT IS MORE THAN 1 FOOT FROM THE ROAD. *******

- 1. Kitchen and household waste:
 - a. Garbage should be placed in plastic bags not to exceed 25lbs, tied, and placed at the street for pick up by 8:00 a.m. Monday and Friday. If a holiday should fall on any pick- up day, that pick up will be lost and not made up.
 - b. NO garbage or recycling should not be placed on the street overnight.
- 2. Trimming/yard waste and construction debris:
 - a. This waste will be collected Monday and Friday after 8:00 a.m. MUST be bundled or bagged and less than 25 lbs. and not over 3 feet in length.
 - b. Two "roll off" dumpsters are available in the maintenance yard at the west end of 3rd St. for residence use only. Contractors doing work in the community should not use the community dumpster.
- 3. Recycling:
 - a. Wednesday is recycling collection, place containers at the street by 8:00a.m.
 - b. "NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY SORT". Container can be all "mixed recycling", including: mixed paper, flattened carboard, aluminum foil trays, tin or steel food cans, glass bottles and jars, milk and juice paper cartons and all plastic #1-7 (on the bottom of the container), these include butter tubs, fruit containers, take out plates, plastic cups, yogurt containers, plastic clam shell containers, etc... any plastic with a recycling sign. Don't forget to rinse them out. PLEASE ... NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY SORT! NO TISSUES OR PAPERTOWELS. ALL CARDBOARD BOXES MUST BE BROKE DOWN.
 - BE BROKE DOWN.
 - c. Expansion to the recycling program will be implemented as approved by the City of Largo.

4. General:

- a. No burning of trash, leaves or other material is allowed in the park.
- b. Trash and recycling containers should be marked with the house number.

If you are just returning to Ranchero or have already returned but haven't reported to the office, please come in and register on the sign-in sheet so we can move you to the "IN" status. Please update your records when you come in if there have been any changes in away info, emergency contacts, cars, etc. Plus, we like to see you and get a chance to welcome you "Home"!

****<u>ALL</u> SALES AND RENTALS MUST HAVE PRIOR APPROVAL BY THE OFFICE.

RENTAL HOMES

Many homes in our community are being rented out without the pre-approval of Management. For the safety and welfare of all our residents, home owners must have their renters complete and submit an application for approval at least 30 days prior to the renters' arrival. A criminal check must be run on all renters just as it is on all residents. This is for everyone's benefit and saves the renters much embarrassment when they have to be rounded up after the fact. Also, the renters must abide by all Community Rules and meet the age requirement. Renters must also check in and register at the office upon arrival in the community.

GUESTS

Guests staying more than 1 week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

HOT TUB USE is for adults only.

No one under 18. F<u>ood and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub</u>. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, no longer than 15 minutes. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. <u>Never</u> swim alone, use the buddy system

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

<u>STOP SIGNS</u> – please stop at all STOP signs in the Park. Cars, and bicycles, continue to roll through them and someone could easily get hurt one day. Just please pay attention.

<u>DRIVEWAYS</u> – When backing out of your driveway, please stop and look before entering the street. There have been several 'close calls' with residents backing out and not looking.

RULES REVIEW OF THE MONTH:

- IX. 4. Parking regulations at Home Sites:
 - (a) The number of motor vehicles allowed per Home Site, excluding guest vehicles, shall be limited to space available to safely park in the carport. Residents of the Community prior to the incorporation of these rules shall be exempt. Homes with more than one vehicle must park the larger vehicle in the carport.
 - (b) The maximum number of motor vehicles per Home shall not exceed two (2).
 - (c) No parking on the grass at Home Sites.
 - (d) Future modification of the carport to reduce the parking capacity will not result in the Resident having the right to park the additional vehicle in the street.

Landscaping and Mowing

If you have any problems with the landscaping or mowing, please contact the Ranchero office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact their managers and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible.

<u>GLASS BOTTLES</u> – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

<u>No smoking at the pools</u> – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes vapor and e-cigarettes.

ALTERATION REQUESTS

Driveways, siding, roof-overs, windows, painting, planting, you name it! If you are making any type of change to the outside of your home, please come into the office first to apply for a permit. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval and a permit before proceeding with any work. If work is started without the proper permits, management will put a stop to the work. Don't put yourself or your contractor through the inconvenience of interrupted work just because you failed to follow the rules. Also, very important, be sure to obtain any required City permits.

KEYS

If you are leaving a position as officer of one of the organizations in the community, remember to return your keys to the office.

PUT IT IN WRITING!

All requests and complaints should be put in writing and signed. Anonymous reports will not be addressed. Forms are available in the office for your convenience

HANDICAP CHAIR LIFT

If you need assistance to go into a pool, we have a Handicap Chair Lift available at the Hacienda swimming pool.

STREET LIGHT OUT

Unknown to many, our streetlights do not belong to us. They are the property of Duke Energy and maintained by them. If a light is out please: Call Duke Energy @ 1-800-700-8744.

WATER SHUT-OFFS

The water is scheduled to be shut off for maintenance repairs IF NEEDED on Tuesdays, from approximately 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 a.m. (weather permitting). It is handy to keep a gallon of water on hand for these days and remember to turn off your hot water heater.


