BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR RENTERS AND RESIDENTS

oth long term and short term occupants of a home, whether a renter, an owner, or an additional occupant are required to have a background check run. Anyone staying in Ranchero Village as more than a guest of 15 days up to twice a year is required to have a background check run. This rule applies to everyone. If you have been here before but have had an absence of over two years you will be required to have a current background check run. These rules apply to everyone no matter what your past occupation may have been.

GUESTS

GUESTS STAYING MORE THAN 48 HOURS MUST BE REGISTERED IN THE COMMUNITY OFFICE.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool. **HOT TUB USE IS FOR ADULTS ONLY.**

No one under 18. Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, no longer than 15 minutes. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

<u>STOP</u> – at all the stop signs. Whether you are in a vehicle, bicycle, golf cart, or anything else, please stop at the stop signs and make sure it is clear and







safe to proceed.

Please obey **ALL** traffic signs. Especially the WRONG WAY signs at the Hacienda Clubhouse. We have seen many near misses and we don't want anyone to get injured.

DRIVEWAYS – When backing out of your driveway, please stop and look before entering the street. There have been several 'close calls' with residents backing out and not looking.

LANDSCAPING AND MOWING

f you have any problems with the landscaping or mowing, please contact the Ranchero office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact their managers and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible.

GLASS BOTTLES

PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out. No smoking at the pools – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas.

TREE PERMITS

Permits MUST be obtained from the City of Largo for the removal of any tree with a trunk larger than 4" in diameter. Certain trees will require a fee before the permit can be obtained. The community office must submit the request to the City.

If you have gone through the permit process and have removed a tree please contact the community office and let us know so we can have the permit closed out with the City.

f you need assistance to go into a pool, we have a Handicap Chair Lift available at the Hacienda swimming pool.

STREET LIGHT OUT





The universal statement, "MAKE A KIT...HAVE A PLAN...BE PREPARED" means to start a file system, whatever is easier for you, to collect information you'll need, from year to year and become PRO-ACTIVE in your safety during any inclement weather that may pop up, in case of an evacuation for an example here's how...

ALL INFO GIVEN TO YOU or that you may PICKUP AT THE HURRICANE TABLE or receive in the MONTHLY BULLETIN OR HEAR AT SATURDAY MORNING COFFEE or in the HURRICANE GUIDE will go into a file and this will be YOUR KIT. Keep you FILE up to date and save it from year to year. 2.) THIS IS YOUR PLAN ; 3.) This is how you will BE PREPARED. If you have a hurricane guide from last year or the year before, it's ok. It is still the same information and has EVERYTHING you need to know. 4.) Tear out the page (s) from the MONTHLY BULLETIN and put it in your FILE. 5.) Jot down ant notes from Saturday Morning Coffee "Tips" and put this in your FILE. 6.) Put any HANDOUTS you get from the hurricane table INTO YOUR FILE. 7.) there will be a multitude of items to pick up to pack in your kit as you will find out once you read your HURRICANE GUIDE. 8.) 
