



STAY SAFE

Florida is currently in phase one of reopening after rising coronavirus cases caused a statewide stay-at-home order. Phase one allows for a partial reopening of restaurants and retail stores, elective surgeries, barbershops and salons with limited capacity.

At this time, we do not have an exact date for Phase two.

Please continue to social distance and wear a mask or stay home if you are not feeling well. We ask that you are mindful of the new pool restrictions. No guests or children should be at any of the pools at any time.

PAYMENTS

The Ranchero Village Office and Resource Property Management do not process any checks mailed or dropped off. These checks get mailed out the next business day to the PO Box and this can cause you to get a late fee. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. <u>Never swim</u> alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores.

<u>STOP SIGNS</u> – Just your monthly reminder to please stop at all STOP signs in the Park. Cars, golf carts, and bicycles, continue to roll through them and someone could easily get hurt one day. Just please pay attention.

<u>DRIVEWAYS</u> – When backing out of your driveway, please stop and look before entering the street. There have been several 'close calls' with residents backing out and not looking.

<u>I strongly urge residents</u> to obey the one-way arrows in the roads, especially around the clubhouses. Those following the correct direction of the arrow are not looking for those going the wrong way. We have seen many instances where someone has almost gotten run over because of someone going against the arrows.

Good Morning/Good Night signs are available in the office for those who live alone and would benefit by having their friends/neighbors see a sign that all is well with them. The sign is placed in your window. In the morning you turn the sign so that the "Good Morning" side faces out. In the evening before you retire for the night you turn it to the "Good Night" side. If a neighbor should notice that the sign hasn't been turned they will try to contact you or they will call the office and have a welfare check made. The manager and maintenance also watch for the signs in the windows as they travel around the community. This system has been a great comfort to many of our residents already and many "buddy systems" have been set up. If you have questions, please call the community office and we'll be glad to explain it to you or supply a sign if you are unable to come to the office to pick one up.

<u>WEEDS</u> – As our northerners go home, please remember to make arrangements to have your home cared for in your absence. The weeds grow during the summer and will need to be pulled while you are away.

<u>Sewers and sinks</u> can be kept flowing and in good condition by the addition of enzymes available at nearby home improvement stores or hardware stores. Enzymes poured down the sink periodically will help to break down the grease and gunk that build up in the plumbing. Only a couple ounces a month will do the job. For the sewer a twice per year treatment of <u>Copper Sulfate Pentahydrate flushed</u> down the toilet is also available. This kills off the roots and growth that get into the sewer line. These small investments now can prevent costly plumbing bills later.

Another seasonal tip is to remind our gardeners to pull out the little oak seedlings that are popping up all around the homes from fallen acorns. Some of these "seedlings" have grown into rather large plants already and are up against homes. They might not seem like much now but trees in Florida grow fast...VERY FAST! We really recommend that homeowners remove these plants while they are still able. As many know, oak trees can cause great damage to homes, drives and sidewalks

We are updating our records and requesting that all sales associates selling homes within Ranchero Village to provide to this office, within ten (10) days from receipt of this letter, copies of the broker's license for the share homes and the dealer's license for the land lease homes.

As I am sure you are aware, a broker can only show/sell a share home and a dealer can only show/sell a lease home (Florida Statue 320.77).

Effective February 1, 2020

- Realtors or Homeowners may not sell their home or transfer their home title without first notifying Management in writing.
- There will be an Administrative Fee of \$200 due from the realtor/agent (homeowner if sold by owner) for each sale, payable to RANCHERO VILLAGE CO-OP., INC. This fee is payable when the prospective buyer is approved for residency and a signed contract/bill of sale is presented.
- 3. Once the Ranchero Village office has been notified of a sale, the home will be inspected to be sure the home is in compliance with park standards; which include cleaning or painting if needed, flower beds weeded, bushes trimmed, all loose debris removed and any unapproved alteration such as fences and golf cart pads. All unapproved alterations must be removed, and property returned to original condition.
- 4. Two (2) attractive "For Sale" signs, not more than 12" X 16" may be placed inside the home or in the flower bed in front of the home (not in the grass). "For Sale" signs are limited to the home only. "Open House" signs for the purpose of home sales will be permitted during the hours of the open house, by either Residents or anyone representing Residents.

BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR RENTERS AND RESIDENTS

Both long term and <u>short term</u> occupants of a home, whether a renter, an owner, or an additional occupant are required to have a credit and background check run. Anyone staying in Ranchero Village as a guest for more than 15 days up to twice a year is required to <u>submit an application</u>. This rule applies to <u>everyone</u>. If you have been here before but have had an absence of over two years you will be required to have a current background check run. These rules apply to everyone no matter what your past occupation may have been.

It is the responsibility of the homeowners to make sure that any additional occupants

RENTERS

in their homes are properly registered with the park. If you are planning to rent out your home or have someone stay with you, review your Ranchero Rules and Regulations first. PET RESTRICTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED BY ALL AND APPROVED BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE A PET CAN BE BROUGHT INTO THE COMMUNITY. Additional occupants and renters must be registered with the office and a background check performed prior to their arrival. It is the Homeowners responsibility to meet all the requirements. There is an application fee to cover this expense. Applications are available in the Office. They must be accompanied by two legible forms of identification for each person. For international applicants, copies of passports and driver's licenses are required. These should be submitted at least 30 days in advance of the person's arrival. Renters are to check in at the office upon arriving in the community.

IF YOU ARE A RENTER OR ADDITIONAL OCCUPANT and haven't done the above, please come to the office immediately and get properly registered. Thank You! Landscaping and Mowing

If you have any problems with the landscaping or mowing, please contact the Ranchero office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact their managers and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible.

TRASH & RECYLING:

We would like to remind everyone that trash and recycling needs to be out by 8:00 am But NOT overnight. Please bring trash and recycling to the end of your driveway or cul-de-sac. Trash must be in bags and securely **tied**. No loose trash will be picked up. You may also use the maintenance yard during the day. All the bins are marked. Do not put kitchen trash in the 2 large roll offs by the gate. The sign posted states "No Kitchen Trash". Use the 4 dumpsters marked "Kitchen Trash Only". The City of Largo has brought bags of trash back to us that was placed in the roll offs.

If you are putting out kitchen trash and yard waste, please separate yard waste from kitchen trash to make it easier for the maintenance crew to identify.

Please flatten cardboard boxes. Yard waste must be bagged, and branches tied in bundles.



Fun facts about your Father's Day gift
