

If any of the maintenance men are directing traffic there, please obey and follow their instructions. It is for your own protection and the safety of others.

Do not go into any of the dumpsters for any reason. Do not use the compactor. That is for maintenance personnel only.

******ALL TRASH AND RECYCLING WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF IT IS MORE THAN 1 FOOT FROM THE ROAD. ********

- 1. Kitchen and household waste:
 - a. Garbage should be placed in plastic bags not to exceed 25lbs, tied, and placed at the street for pick up by 8:00 a.m. Monday and Friday. If a holiday should fall on any pick-up day, that pick up will be lost and not made up.
 - b.NO garbage or recycling should not be placed on the street overnight.
- 2. Trimming/yard waste and construction debris:
 - a. This waste will be collected Monday and Friday after 8:00 a.m. MUST be bundled or bagged and less than 25 lbs. and not over 3 feet in length.
- b. Two "roll off" dumpsters are available in the maintenance yard at the west end of 3rd St. for residence use only. Contractors doing work in the community should not use the community dumpster.
- 3. Recycling:
 - a. Wednesday is recycling collection, place containers at the street by 8:00a.m.
 - b. "NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY SORT". Container can be all "mixed recycling", including: mixed paper, flattened carboard, aluminum foil trays, tin or steel food cans, glass bottles and jars, milk and juice paper cartons and all plastic #1-7 (on the bottom of the container), these include butter tubs, fruit containers, take out plates, plastic cups, yogurt containers, plastic clam shell containers, etc... any plastic with a recycling sign. PLEASE ... NO PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY SORT!

ALL CARDBOARD BOXES MUST BE BROKE DOWN.

- c. Expansion to the recycling program will be implemented as approved by the City of Largo.
- 4. General:
 - a. No burning of trash, leaves or other material is allowed in the park.
 - b.Trash and recycling containers should be marked with the house number.
 - c. No dumping of any refuse in any area of the community except for the containers in the maintenance yard at the west end of 3rd St.
 - d.Residents who bring their garbage, trash or recycling, to the maintenance yard should place the waste in each of the proper receptacles as clearly marked.

DOGS – DOGS-DOGS

There is so much to be said about dogs. We encourage everyone to review your Rules and Regulations manual to update yourself on all the rules. Among many of the rules in section VII. PETS, you will find it states: "Guests and visitors are to be advised not to bring their



pets into the Community, with the exception of trained working dogs."

This means you must alert your guests that their pets are NOT allowed to visit in the community.

Also, "No pets are allowed in the Community recreation or common areas at any time." Please come to the community office for a Dog Section Map if you are not sure of the dog section. Dogs can only be walked in the areas indicated and on the side of the street designated "Dog Section". Keeping these rules makes for happier neighbors...and management, too!

And, of course, all pet owners are to have a litter bag with you at all times to pick up and properly dispose of pet litter.

ALTERATIONS AND SUCH STUFF!

No alterations to the exterior of the Home may be made without the written consent of Management. All contemplated changes must be submitted in writing to Management for approval or disapproval. Management will advise the Resident within fifteen days thereafter of the decision. Management's consent does not relieve the Resident from the responsibility of applying for proper permits from local governmental authorities and meeting existing building code requirements. Management reserves the right to require that any improvements made without the written consent of Management shall be removed at Resident's expense.

These alterations include the planting of trees and bushes, adding patio stones or removing existing plants or construction. Exterior antennas, satellite dishes and other external signal receivers must be approved by Management as well.

Americans prefer to stay at home

Planning a vacation overseas this year? You're not exactly alone, but you're not in the majority. As reported on the NerdWallet website, a survey by Priority Pass found that only 14 percent of Americans plan to leave the United States for a vacation this year. Forty-five percent said they'd prefer to stay in the U.S.

The survey included 10,000 people in nine countries. Overall, 32 percent of respondents said they expect to go abroad for their holidays. Among other travel-related findings from the survey:

- Americans are least likely to spend a cash gift on travel. If given \$300, U.S. residents are least likely to use it to help pay for a trip. People in the United Kingdom and Mexico are most likely.
- Americans spend more on travel. Although they travel less, Americans have the highest per-person budget for overseas travel.
- Americans don't share. Finally, the survey found that Americans are least likely to share their travel memories on social media, or recommend hotels, airlines, and transportation services than residents of other countries.

We're still looking at our phones on the road

Te all know the dangers of texting while driving—or do we? A survey of drivers in Philadelphia, as reported on the Fox 8 website, found that 75 percent admit to using mobile devices behind the wheel.

They're not all kids, either. Although 91 percent of millennials reported using a smartphone or other device while driving, so did 79 percent of Gen Xers and 64 percent of Baby Boomers. What are they doing? Reading text messages or emails (48 percent), updating or checking social media (23 percent), and recording videos (18 percent). Only 9 percent of drivers in the survey said they use a "Do not disturb" app on their phones while driving.

These drawing games can spur your brain

rawing can spur your creativity. You don't have to be a Picasso. Just try some of these games with your friends (from the My Modern Met website):

- The Exquisite Corpse. In this game, developed by the 20th-century Surrealist artists, one person begins a drawing at the top of a sheet of paper, then folds it over or covers it up so only a bit of the bottom is showing. The next person continues the drawing, folds it down, and so on. Unfolding it to reveal the completed drawing should produce surprises, laughs, and even some ideas.
- Paper Telephone. One person writes a short, descriptive phrase on a piece of paper, then passes it to the next. He or she then draws a picture based on the phrase. The next person looks only at the picture and then writes a phrase or sentence describing it. The following person then draws a picture of that phrase, and so on. By the end, the final picture and the original phrase may have nothing to do with each other.

• Blind Contour. In this exercise you (and a partner) draw something around you, but without looking at the paper—just the subject of your drawing. Keep your pen or pencil on the paper at all times. You might be surprised at what you see.

• Scribbles. One person scribbles on a piece of paper, eyes closed. The next person has to turn that doodle into a drawing. This forces your mind to make sense of nonsense.

A simple exercise for imagination

our subconscious mind can help you exercise your imagination. Try this technique (used by Thomas Edison):

Ten minutes before you go to sleep, organize your thoughts. Think about a problem you're trying to solve, or ask your brain a question. Keep thinking about this as you drift off to dreamland. Then, during the first 10 minutes after waking up, write down whatever pops into your head. You'll often find that your brain has answered your question during your sleep. In the morning your mind is looser, and you're more likely to remember dreams and connect them to your daytime reality.
