GUESTS

Guests staying more than 1 week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

GOOD MORNING/GOOD EVENING signs are still available in the office for those who live alone and would benefit by having their friends/neighbors see a sign that all is well with them.

FALL MEANS FALLING FRUIT!!

Please pick up all the fruit off the ground so we don't have rotting fruit and unwanted guests. And be sure to have someone care for your yard if you will be away.

HOT TUB USE is for adults only.

No one under 18. <u>Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub</u>. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, <u>no longer than 15 minutes</u>. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. <u>Never</u> swim alone, use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you are not feeling well, have wounds or open sores.

<u>STOP SIGNS</u> – please stop at all STOP signs in the Park. Cars, and bicycles, continue to roll through them and someone could easily get hurt one day. Just please pay attention.

<u>**DRIVEWAYS**</u> – When backing out of your driveway, please stop and look before entering the street. There have been several 'close calls' with residents backing out and not looking.

<u>I strongly urge residents</u> to obey the one way arrows in the roads, especially around the clubhouses. Those following the correct direction of the arrow are not looking for those going the wrong way. We have seen many instances where someone has almost gotten run over because of someone going against the arrows.

Please DO NOT make left turns at the Belcher entrance.

Landscaping and Mowing

If you have any problems with the landscaping or mowing, please contact the Ranchero



office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact their managers and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts are to only be driven by persons 18 years of age or older per Ranchero Rules and Regulations.

If you have registered your golf cart with the office and have been waiting for your number, please stop by the office to pick it up. All golf carts must be registered with the office.

SOLICITORS

<u>DO NOT let them into your home!</u> <u>Call the Largo Police Department (587-6730)</u> <u>immediately</u> if you see solicitors and please let the management office know after you have called the police. We have been trying to catch and trespass them. If we can even get a license plate number it would help immensely. Management has been working with the police in an attempt to stop these offenders. Ranchero is a plainly posted No Soliciting Community; no one should be coming to your door. These people are very bold and brazen; please help us stop them and any other solicitors before they take advantage of anyone else in our community. The office NEVER gives permission to any solicitor.

<u>GLASS BOTTLES</u> – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool.

If you are having a party or gathering at one of the clubhouses, please remind your guests not to take any glass out onto the pool deck. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut and it can be quite expensive to clean it up.

No smoking at the pools – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas. This includes Vapor and E-Cigarettes.

SMOKING IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY:

Smoking Areas are posted and located near pools and clubhouses. The picnic area at the Corral Clubhouse is NOT a designated smoking area. Please do not smoke there.

TREE PERMITS

Permits MUST be obtained from the City of Largo for the removal of any tree with a trunk larger than 4" in diameter. Certain trees will require a fee before the permit can be obtained. The community office must submit the request to the City.

If you have gone through the permit process and have removed a tree please contact the community office and let us know so we can have the permit closed out with the City. The City arborist tells us there are a number of unfinished permits on the books and they'd like to get it cleaned up.
