

Your CO-OP board continues to work together to improve our community, and we are dedicated to moving forward as a team in keeping Ranchero Village the best place to live.

BAD HABITS ARE HARD TO BREAK...

Some things are just plain unpleasant to talk about and this is one of them: Late Fees. What a nasty thing to say! Unfortunately, many of our residents are sliding into the habit of paying their rent later and later in the month. It actually has come to the point where they think they are actually paying early for the next month. REMEMBER: Rent / Maintenance are due on the first of the month and late after the 5th. Late fees are going to be strictly enforced. It takes so much time and expense to have to do all the follow- up work to notify residents of their responsibilities. Late fees are \$25 on the 6th of the month.

If anyone is interested in signing up for automatic rent payments, just come into the office and we will help you get that set up so that you are never late again. The autopay is deducted from your bank on the 3rd of the month. If the 3rd is a weekend or holiday, then it is deducted on the next business day.

Parking can be such a Pain!!!



Seems that the cul-de-sac dilemma continues. Please remember that not only are the cul-de-sacs for cul-de-sac residents alone but also that the residents in the cul-de-sacs must work together for mutually agreeable parking. Vehicles MUST first park in your driveway. We need to be courteous to our neighbors and also leave room for emergency as well as delivery vehicles to get into and out of the cul-de-sacs.

GAS GRILLS

The gas grills are at the pavilion and open to everyone. This is a first come first served basis. If you use the grills, remember to shut them off when you are finished.

CAR STICKERS

Most everyone has heard about the campaign to get all Ranchero Residents' vehicles ID stickers. As we work at increased security we encourage everyone who doesn't already have a **NUMBERED** Ranchero vehicle sticker to come to the office with the make, model, year, color, and license plate number of your vehicle and get registered.

Renters will need to provide the same information and will receive a temporary pass to use while they are staying in the community.

Guests that stay 1 week or longer must be registered in the Community Office plus receive a Visitor Pass if they are driving a vehicle.

Remember that all guests must comply with the same Rules & Regulations as our residents. Guest are NOT ALLOWED TO BRING PETS WITH THEM.

RENTAL HOMES

Many homes in our community are being rented out without the pre-approval of Management. For the safety and welfare of all our residents, homeowners must provide a rental application along with two ID's for each person renting the home and submit these for approval at least 30 days before the renters arrive. A criminal check must be run on all renters just as it is on all residents. This is for everyone's benefit and saves the renter much embarrassment when they have to be rounded up after the fact. Also, the renters must abide by all Community Rules and meet the age requirement.

LICENSE CONTRACTORS

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Please update your Resident Information sheet annually. If you can't remember if you've done it, you probably haven't. Pick up a sheet in the office. Having current information is crucial in an emergency.

FIRST AID KITS

Management has first aid kits at each pool site. These are equipped for emergencies involving our residents at these sites. If someone takes these products home for their personal use, then the kits are stripped and useless for emergencies. Please do not abuse the use of these items.

FEEDING SQUIRRELS, BIRDS, WILDLIFE

Anytime feed is put out for birds, ducks, etc. it draws rodents. No one wants citrus rats in their yards and homes. Please do not feed any wildlife. It's the law. Thank you.

GOLF CART DRIVERS and BICYCLISTS

Remember to STOP at all stop signs. We've had some close calls lately plus observed a lot of carts breezing through the stop signs. A good habit may just prevent a tragedy. For everyone's sake observe the law.

STREET SAFETY

Please observe the rules of the road – stop at stop signs, obey the speed limit (15 miles per hour) and be alert. If you are forced to park "On Street", please be sure to always park so emergency vehicles can pass and do not block residents' driveways. If you are out after dark wear light or reflective clothing and carry flashlights. Golf cart owners are to use headlights if driving your cart at dusk or after dark.

WATER SHUT-OFF SCHEDULE FOR REPAIRS

Please mark your calendars...don't get caught with shampoo in your hair! Water valves and meters are repaired or replaced on Tuesdays. Please keep in mind that you may not have water on Tuesdays from approximately 9:00 a.m.-1:30 a.m. (weather permitting). Thank you for your cooperation in this regard.

TRASH NOTICE REMINDER

Resident's Bill of Rights & Responsibilities states "For sanitary reasons, garbage must <u>not</u> be set out overnight and receptacles must be kept in utility sheds. Garbage must be put in plastic bags, tied and placed at the street for pick up by 8:00 AM, Monday and Friday." Put trash out every week to avoid drawing rodents and bugs. Maintenance will NOT pick up trash with maggots in it. Cardboard cartons will not be picked up unless they are broken down. If you take your items to the maintenance yard, please put kitchen and household garbage in small green dumpsters. Electronics & hazardous materials are to be placed where noted near the maintenance building. (We are fined if these items are in the roll off.) All other items can be placed in the roll offs. Thank you for your cooperation. Maintenance Yard map is available at the office.
