








ecently we added covers to the hand rails at the three pools. In the summer those rails can get extremely hot so it is anticipated that these covers will help keep hands from be-Ling burned. The covers are removable so they can be cleaned. Speaking of pools please remember to rinse off before getting into the pool with lotion and/or oil on. This can cause the filters in the pool to clog. The air conditioner at the Corral Clubhouse has been replaced. It was found that it was beyond repair and some parts of the old AC dated back to 1988! The unit is doing a great job and is much quieter than the old one. We ask that the temperature be turned up to 80 degrees after functions in the clubhouse are finished. This will keep the building at a comfortable temperature when not in use. This should be done at the Lakes and Hacienda Clubhouses also. Over the summer, new drapes were ordered for the Corral and Hacienda Clubhouses. This project was a collaborative effort between SAC, Chapel and the Co-Op. the new drapes have recently been installed and look terrific. They are a definite improvement over the vertical blinds that had been in place for many years! I want to thank Pat Bryant, SAC and Chapel for their assistance with this major project! A quick reminder- especially for our returning snowbirds. If someone calls you offering to check your air conditioner, water heater etc., and you did not initiate the call - that someone is soliciting. We have had and still have companies coming into the park soliciting our residents. Management has responded several times over the summer to instances of solicitations and told the individuals to leave. Please do not become a victim of a solicitor! Now that it is October and the weather in the north is getting cooler, we look forward to seeing many of you return to Ranchero. Please travel safely.





BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR RENTERS AND RESIDENTS

Both long term and short term occupants of a home, whether a renter, an owner, or an additional occupant are required to have a background check run. Anyone staying in Ranchero Village as more than a guest of 15 days up to twice a year is required to have a background check run. This rule applies to everyone. If you have been here before but have had an absence of over two years you will be required to have a current background check run. 

Water and Swimming Safety

From the Red Cross

A recent Red Cross survey found that eight out of ten Americans are planning water activities such as going to the beach, pool, water park or boating or fishing this summer. A third (32 percent) of all Americans plan to swim at a place without a lifeguard. The Red Cross has launched an anti-drowning campaign this summer that promotes swim lessons and safe swimming. If a trip to the beach is part of someone's plans, the Red Cross has ten tips that will help beachgoers stay out of harm's way:

- 1. If someone plans to swim in the ocean, they should always check weather conditions before going in the water.
- 2. Swim only at a lifeguard protected beach, within the designated swimming area and listen to all lifeguard instructions.
- 3. Always swim with a buddy and always swim sober.
- 4. Young children and inexperienced swimmers should wear a Coast Guard-approved life jacket.
- 5. Everyone should enter the water feet first if they can't see the bottom or don't know how deep the water is.
- 6. Be aware of the danger of rip currents. If caught in one, swim parallel to the shore until out of the current. When free, turn and swim toward shore. If unable to swim to the shore, call out for help, float or tread water until free of the rip current and then head toward shore.
- 7. Limit the amount of direct sunlight received between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., and wear a broad-spectrum sunscreen with a protection factor of at least 15. Reapply often.
- 8. Stay hydrated. Drink plenty of water regularly, even if not thirsty. Avoid drinks with alcohol or caffeine in them.
- 9. Protect the eyes by wearing sunglasses that will absorb 100 percent of UV sunlight.
- 10. Wear beach shoes. The sand is hot and can burn someone's feet and glass and other sharp objects can cut them.

POOL RULES

Il the rules for the pool apply to all people at all times. The rules posted as well as those which we highlight in this Bulletin are to be followed at all hours and conditions. Just because no one else is at the pool when you are, does not mean the rules can be altered for your convenience. For example: If no one else is at the pool you must still abide by the No Smoking Rule and only smoke in the designated area. Another example is: the children's hours remain the same whether or not others are to



example is: the children's hours remain the same whether or not others are there. These are just examples, but you get the idea. Let's all keep the rules and keep Ranchero a pleasant place to live and enjoy. HOT TUB USE is for adults only. No one under 18. Food and drink are not allowed in the pool/hot tub. The hot tub is only meant for short sessions, no longer than 15 minutes. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone, use the buddy system for safety. Also, for the health and well being of everyone, please do not go in the Hot Tub or Pools if you have wounds or open sores. GLASS BOTTLES – PLEASE REMEMBER that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken, you have the potential of people getting cut. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out No smoking at the pools – please adhere to the No Smoking Rules at the pools and smoke only away from the pool area in the designated areas.

TREE PERMITS

Permits MUST be obtained from the City of Largo for the removal of any tree with a trunk larger than 4" in diameter. Certain trees will require a fee before the permit can be obtained. The community office must submit the request to the City. If you have gone through the permit process and have removed a tree please contact the community office and let us know so we can have the permit closed out with the City.

GET PERMISSION FIRST

Tiveways, siding, roof-overs, windows, painting, planting, you name it! If you are making any type of change to the outside of your home, please come into the office first to apply for a permit. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval and a permit before proceeding with any work. If work is started without the proper permits, management will put a stop to the work and in some cases, even demand removal. Don't put yourself or your contractor through the inconvenience of interrupted work just because you failed to follow the rules. Also, very important, be sure to obtain any required City permits.


