

Be extra careful driving when exiting Belcher and Ulmerton Rd. to avoid getting a ticket or causing a crash if you do not obey the right turn traffic Laws that

Spectrum Bulk Rate is coming

anchero Village is on schedule for a Jan 1 2019 implementation of the Spectrum Bulk Rate of Cable and Internet and WiFi at \$33 (includes tax) a month.

This is a very exciting time for our Community, Your Board's (CO-OP and HOA).

This is a very exciting time for our Community. Your Board's (CO-OP and HOA) have agreed with all components of the deal and we have listened to our community and delivered a fantastic deal for virtually all or most to benefit from this agreement.

An overwhelming majority of our community has been waiting for relief of high cable bills for a long time and relief is finally coming.

This is non-negotiable and everyone is going to be billed for the service.

All the legal tasks and hoops are completed including Tallahassee's sign-off

\$33 including tax will be included in your Monthly Maintenance (similar to the way we charge sewer)

What we are getting:

All residents will receive 2 TV HD Boxes, TV Select Channels, 100/10 mbps Internet and WiFi.

As we get closer to rollout more information will be available and we will keep you posted.

These rates will hold for a year and have a 5% cap from the 2nd to the 5th year.

All additional Optional products can be put on seasonal hold at no additional fee and if you have a Spectrum phone it will be \$4.99 a month to hold your telephone number.

If you have DirecTV or Dish and in a contract – Spectrum will buyout your contract HOWEVER you need to call them and go to the triple play (cable/phone/internet) and tell them you want them to buyout your contract.

For existing users of Spectrum – you will receive a notice in the mail (note- no Spectrum mail will be forwarded to Canada residents from what I have been told). Canadians can sign up as they return in the fall.







FERTILIZATION AND PESTICIDE

Many of our residents fertilize and use pesticides to keep their lawns in top condition. This is much appreciated but we ask that homeowners abide by County regulations pertaining to the restrictions on certain types of fertilizers to be used in the summer. The run-off from our summer rains carries these chemicals right into the lakes and waterways rather than soaking into the ground and being absorbed by the plants and grass.

FRUIT SEASON BRINGS PROBLEMS

The citrus trees are beginning to bear larger fruit and it is an attractive morsel for furry vermin. Fruit rats feast on the fallen fruit as well as fruit on the tree. Pest experts give us this advice to help control the varmints. 1. Keep your yard simple and don't make it a jungle paradise. 2. Don't feed birds outside. Rats love birdseed. #3. Seal holes and cracks in doors, window frames and walls. 4. Get rid of clutter, including old furniture, newspapers and boxes. 5. Pick up fallen fruit, on a daily basis if necessary. 6. Keep your garbage closed up and don't put the curbside containers out until the morning of collection. 7. Work with your neighbors to ensure that their yards are rat free, too. If your neighbors have rats, you'll have rats. 8. (You won't like this one) Snakes are your friends when it comes to rat control. While snakes can't solve all rat problems, they do enjoy eating them. Hawks and owls are good ratters, too.

GUESTS

Guests staying more than 1 week MUST be registered in the Community Office.

Guests MUST display Ranchero Village ID tags when at the pools. Residents should be accompanying their guests while at the pool or other location and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please review your Rules and Regs and acquaint your guests with the rules also. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct. No running, jumping or diving into the pool.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts are to only be driven by persons 18 years of age or older per Ranchero Rules and Regulations.



RENTERS

It is the responsibility of the homeowners to make sure that any additional occupants in their homes are properly registered with the park. If you are planning to rent out your home or have someone stay with you, review your Ranchero Rules and Regulations first. PET RESTRICTIONS MUST BE OBSERVED BY ALL AND APPROVED BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE A PET CAN BE BROUGHT INTO THE COMMUNITY. Additional occupants and renters must be registered with the office and a background check performed prior to their arrival. It is the Homeowners responsibility to meet all the requirements. There is an application fee to cover this expense. Applications are available in the Office. They must be accompanied by two legible forms of identification for each person. For international applicants, copies of passports and driver's licenses are required. These should be submitted at least 30 days in advance of the person's arrival. Renters are to check in at the office upon arriving in the community.

IF YOU ARE A RENTER OR ADDITIONAL OCCUPANT and haven't done the above, please come to the office immediately and get properly registered. Thank You!

Plan your cookout for safety


If you're planning a cookout for Labor Day—or any other time—you should observe the following safety tips:

- Always wash the racks on your grill. Unwashed racks can be breeding grounds for bacteria and could contaminate your food at your next cookout. Use a brass-bristle brush to remove all the debris from the rack.
- Never place your grill close to your picnic table or other seating. Place it instead far away from where people will be gathered.
- Don't wear lose or flowing clothes when you are grilling. A drooping sleeve could brush against the grill or coals and catch fire.
- Use heat-resistant cooking mitts and long-handled utensils to avoid burns.
- Make sure you keep a fire extinguisher or a large spray bottle filled with water nearby in case of fire emergencies.
- Never add charcoal starter or fluid to coals that are already warm or hot. The fluid could cause flames to flare dangerously.
- Never use alcohol, kerosene, or gasoline to start a fire or grill. Using any of these fluids to start a fire can cause an explosion.

Saltwater trout evolve to freshwater species

Production normally takes place over thousands or millions of years, but sometimes it can happen more quickly. The Science website reports that a group of saltwater steelhead trout transplanted from California to the salt-free waters of Lake Michigan in the 1890s have evolved into a species that can live wholly in fresh water—in only 100 years.

Genetics helped. The steelheads hatch in freshwater rivers before swimming out to the ocean for much of their lives, returning to the rivers to spawn. That probably allowed key genetic differences to develop in their new home, demonstrating how quickly an organism can change and adapt to a new environment if it has the right genetic makeup.


