pril starts with a day that many look forward to and some dread. Yup "April Fool's Day" on the 1st. Here is a little history on it and some notable hoaxes/Jokes that have been done in the past.

**April Fools' Day** (sometimes called All Fools' Day) is celebrated every year on April 1 by playing practical jokes and spreading hoaxes. The jokes and their victims are called April fools. People playing April Fools jokes expose their prank by shouting April Fool. Some newspapers, magazines, and other published media report fake stories, which are usually explained the next day or below the news section in small letters. Although popular since the 19th century, the day is not a public holiday in any country.

In the UK, an April Fools joke is revealed by shouting "April fool!" at the recipient, who becomes the "April fool". A study in the 1950s, by folklorists Iona and Peter Opie, found that in the UK, and in countries whose traditions derived from the UK, the joking ceased at midday. A person playing a joke after midday is the "April fool" themselves.

In Scotland, April Fools' Day was traditionally called 'Huntigowk Day', although this name has fallen into disuse.[citation needed] The name is a corruption of 'Hunt the Gowk', "gowk" being Scots for a cuckoo or a foolish person; alternative terms in Gaelic would be Là na Gocaireachd 'gowking day' or Là Ruith na Cuthaige 'the day of running the cuckoo'. The traditional prank is to ask someone to deliver a sealed message that supposedly requests help of some sort. In fact, the message reads "Dinna laugh, dinna smile. Hunt the gowk another mile." The recipient, upon reading it, will explain he can only help if he first contacts another person, and sends the victim to this next person with an identical message, with the same result.

**In England** a "fool" is known by different names around the country, including a "noodle", "gob", "gobby" or "noddy".

**Ireland** - In Ireland it was traditional to entrust the victim with an "important letter" to be given to a named person. That person would then ask the victim to take it to someone else, and so on. The letter when finally opened contained the words "send the fool further".

**Poland** - In Poland, prima aprilis ("1 April" in Latin) is a day in which many jokes are told; various hoaxes are prepared by people, media (which sometimes cooperate to make the "information" more credible) and even public institutions. Serious activities are usually avoided. This conviction is so strong that the anti-Turkish alliance with Leopold I signed on April 1, 1683, was backdated to March 31.

#### **Pranks**

As well as people playing pranks on one another on April Fools' Day, elaborate practical jokes have appeared on radio and TV stations, newspapers, web sites, and have been performed by large corporations. In one famous prank from 1957, the BBC broadcast a film in their Panorama current affairs series purporting to show Swiss farmers picking freshly-grown spaghetti, in what they called the Swiss Spaghetti Harvest. The BBC were later flooded with requests to purchase a spaghetti plant, forcing them to declare the film a hoax on the news the next day. (Spaghetti Squash actually looks like Spaghetti when you cut it open. There are some great recipes on the Internet and no, this part is not a joke. Larry D').

On April Fools' Day 2016, online football news channel Goal.com falsely reported that FC Barcelona winger Lionel Messi agreed to a €500 million deal to sign with Real Madrid for five

years. The reporter's name used in the article was "Lirpa Loof", which "April Fool" is spelled backwards.

With the advent of the Internet and readily available global news services, April Fools' pranks can catch and embarrass a wider audience than ever before.

#### **TV Station Hoaxes**

Spaghetti trees: The BBC television program Panorama ran a hoax in 1957, purporting to show the Swiss harvesting spaghetti from trees. They claimed that the despised pest, the spaghetti weevil, had been eradicated. A large number of people contacted the BBC wanting to know how to cultivate their own spaghetti trees. It was, in fact, filmed in St Albans. The editor of Panorama at the time, Michael Peacock, approved the idea, which was pitched by freelance camera operator Charles de Jaeger. Peacock told the BBC in 2014 that he gave de Jaeger a budget of £100. Peacock said the respected Panorama anchorman Richard Dimbleby knew they were using his authoritativeness to make the joke work. He said Dimbleby loved the idea and went at it with relish. Decades later CNN called this broadcast "the biggest hoax that any reputable news establishment ever pulled".

- In 1962, Swedish national television broadcast a 5-minute special on how one could get color TV by placing a nylon stocking in front of the TV. A rather in-depth description on the physics behind the phenomenon was included. Thousands of people tried it.
- Smell-o-vision: In 1965, the BBC purported to conduct a trial of a new technology allowing the transmission of odor over the airwaves to all viewers. Many viewers reportedly contacted the BBC to report the trial's success. In 2007, the BBC website repeated an online version of the hoax, as did Google in 2013, in tribute.
- Great Blue Hill eruption prank: On April 1, 1980, Boston television station WNAC-TV aired a fake news bulletin at the end of the 6 o'clock news which reported that Great Blue Hill in Milton, Massachusetts was erupting. The prank resulted in panic in Milton, where some residents began to flee their homes. The executive producer of the 6 o'clock news, Homer Cilley, was fired by the station for "his failure to exercise good news judgment" and for violating the Federal Communications Commission's rules about showing stock footage without identifying it as such.
- In 2008, the BBC reported on a newly discovered colony of flying penguins. An elaborate video segment was even produced, featuring Terry Jones walking with the penguins in Antarctica, and following their flight to the Amazon rainforest.
- Netflix April Fools' Day jokes include over-detailing categories of films, and adding original programming made up entirely of food cooking.
- In 1969 the public broadcaster NTS in the Netherlands announced that inspectors with remote scanners would drive the streets to detect people who had not paid their radio/TV tax ("kijk en luistergeld" or "omroepbijdrage"). The only

way to prevent detection was to wrap the TV/radio in Aluminum foil. The next day all supermarkets were sold out of their Aluminum foil, and a surge of TV/radio taxes were being payed.



#### POOL AND PET OWNER REMINDERS

**FYI:** Riviera Estates MHP would like to remind our residents that **NO one is allowed to touch the temperature settings on the pool heater and/or the clubhouse air conditioner.** Our manager and the Homeowner's Association Executive Board have insisted on this. Pool hours are 9:00 a.m. until dusk daily. Pool is heated in winter, the months of November through March. Please remember when leaving the pool, to **CLOSE DOWN THE UMBRELLAS**, pick up your trash and close the gates. If you are going by the pool, and see the umbrellas are open, please go in and close them. A wind gust can pick them right up and they become a missile and could damage or injury, along with the umbrella itself getting damaged. Treat our community pool as if it were your own. Thank you.


**ATTENTION PET OWNERS:** Please be a responsible pet owner and a RESPECTIBLE pet owner as well. When walking your pets, please do not allow them to "potty" in other people's yards. Some are not pet lovers as we are.

Your dogs must be leashed at all times, and there are plenty of areas where your dog can go. There is a pet clean-up station in the storage field for your use. Please be sure to clean up after your pet. Also, please try to keep your pet from barking or making loud disturbing noise that can bother a neighbor.

Complaints are being received by the office on a constant basis of pet problems in the park. So, at this time, our pet rule policy should be noted. Pets are allowed in park, UP TO 20 **POUNDS** weight restriction. Copies of pet inoculation certificate must be given to the office as proof the pet has been vaccinated. There is a *LIMIT OF TWO PETS PER COACH*. Fences for the pets are not allowed to be installed. All pets must be leased at all times when outside the coach. Make certain when you leave your pet, they are not barking the entire time you are gone and bothering your neighbors. If this is the case, please make some type of arrangements that will alter this situation, such as a pet sitter, taking pet with you, or if the problem continues, and complaints continue in the office from residents being bothered by the barking, the park is forced to take steps in resolving the issue, such as requiring you to get rid of the dog, or face eviction procedures. Please be a responsible pet owner and obey the rules concerning them. It is IMPERATIVE THAT YOU CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET EVERYWHERE, INCLUDING THE DOG WALKING AREA. Please do not ignore these pet owner rules, so that we all can continue to love and enjoy our pets. But at all times we must be respectful of all the residents that live here, that they are not bothered by our pets in any way. Not by hearing them all the time, or stepping in their waste when out walking etc. Thank you for adherence to the policies and rules.

#### **Exploring the mysteries of an ancient codex**

British and Dutch scientists have used high-tech imaging to uncover the secrets of an ancient Mexican manuscript, the eScience News website reports. The manuscript, known as the Codex Seiden, is strip of deer hide five meters long that's been covered with gesso (a white plaster composed of gypsum and chalk) and folded according style to make a document 20 pages long.

It dates back to approximately 1560, and was found in what's now known as the Oaxaca region of Mexico. Like other codices from that area and others, the Codex Seiden uses brightly-colored symbols to record history: wars, genealogy, and cultural information.

One intriguing discovery: The high-tech imaging found the image of an individual represented by a glyph of a twisted cord and a flint knife. The man or woman resembles a character found in other codices, and may be an important ancestor of two families connected to other archeological sites in Mexico.

#### **Collision course**

huge space cloud is on a collision course with our galaxy, but don't panic—it's not expected to reach us for another 30 million years. According to NASA's Science Mission Directorate website, Smith's cloud, as it's known, is composed of enough gas to create two million stars the size of our size, and is orbiting the Milky Way at 700,000 mph.

The collision won't have much impact for anyone still around, as the cloud is much smaller than our galaxy, but scientists are watching it closely anyway, seeking explanations for its origin as well as other secrets of the universe.

#### Big dinosaurs, big eggs, and hatching times

Tow long did dinosaur eggs take to hatch? Paleontologists know very little about dinosaur embryology, but with CT scanners and high-resolution microscopy, they're finding out more.

The SciNews website reports on a recent find: Non-avian dinosaurs likely took longer to hatch than their feathered counterparts, much as modern reptiles hatch at a later age than to-

day's birds. Scientists looked at the fossilized remains of two dinosaur embryos, looking at the formation of their teeth. Analyzing growth lines, they were able to determine that one dinosaur had died at three months, and the other at six months.

The difference in hatching times may have had an impact on the large dinosaurs' eventual demise. Because they require more food and other resources to live to adult size, larger reptiles were likely more vulnerable than smaller animals (amphibians, birds, and other mammals) to an extinction event.
