ctober 2017 rings in. Boy it is amazing, seemed we just said goodbye to our northern friends and here it is, time for them to return. We are happy about that! Fall is definately here, but signs are not so visible in our sunshine state. So, what is happening in October? Thursday, Oct. 5th is the First Day of Sukkot. October 9th in the US is Columbus Day. October 9th in Canada is Thanksgiving Day. And of course, October 31st is Halloween. The holidays are definately coming.

It is with a saddened heart that I heard our friend and fellow resident, Bill Stevens passed away last month. He was certainly a great guy with a smile on his face and always happy. My thoughts and prayers to Sharron, who was such a wonderful, loving caregiver and wife to Bill. She helped him enjoy the last days of his life and I know he appreciated it. Rest in Peace Bill. You will be terribly missed.

So September was a crazy month for Riviera Estates. We had to evacuate for Hurricane Irma. What a mess she was. Lots of winds, rains and she left a lot of damage in her wake. Riviera was evacuated on Friday, and was out of power after Irma came through. We did have a few coaches damaged, Flo Weber's place had the front porch (entrance) roof ripped off. The house next to her, the newer one, also had damage to it's roof. Fencing is down, and one of the coaches at Serendipity that is at the end of the street by our property, had it's carport "rearranged" a bit. I would imagine the whole carport is toast, but I did not see any damage like that here. The office got the word out pretty quickly after the mandatory evacuation for Pinellas County mobile homes was called for. Saturday there were buses in here to take anyone who needed it, to the shelter. That was weird to see, but nice for those who needed it. Our power came back on Monday night I believe, and most residents returned to get settled back into their homes. It was my first hurricane since moving here in 2008. I was glad when it was over and I could breathe a sigh of relief. She came through in the middle of the night, so could not see much. There was major tree damage, lots of trees fallen and limbs broken off. We were very lucky. I know on social media, many of you were praying she would shift,

which she did a bit, enough to take the eye to Hardee County and away from us. So when I preach about being prepared to grab and go please don't roll your eyes and skip over it. It is for your own protection.

Some of you may have heard I was to finally have my left hip replaced on September 5th. NOPE! Did not happen. With all the things I did to get rid of an infection, 3 antibiotic prescriptions, and then 3 IV drips of antibiotic for "resistant infection", as I am signing into the surgery center my primary doctor called and advised the bacteria was still there. The surgeon cancelled it, and told me all we needed to do was get the right antibiotic for this particular bacteria and get it killed and he would do the replacement in a week. Well, called my primary and he said he had done all he could and referred me to a urologist. What? Could't get into one until the 13th, and went to see him and of course he has to do some testing and that is scheduled for the 26th of September, with results on the 3rd of October. I am not going to get this surgery for another 2 or 3 months!!!! I am so angry I could literally scream. Wait, I think I have done that once or twice. At this point, I can barely move now and my right hip is letting me know it is tired of doing all the work. So here comes Thanksgiving and Christmas, my favorite time of the year, and I will probably be recuperating from the surgery and unable to shop or anything and that makes me a VERY, VERY unhappy camper. I know this is for my own good etc. etc., but no one seems to be in any hurry whatsoever to consider my pain and frustration. So, no surgery in the near future my friends. I guess it was best, as I would have been a real mess trying to pack and evacuate for Irma if the surgery had happened.

You know how I always ask everyone to "pay it forward", do a Random Act of Kindness for a neighbor or friend, that just a little bit of effort on our part can mean so so much to the person who needs it? Well, I must say, several Riviera Estate residents were the "receivers" during Irma of just what I am talking about. People helping people, offering safe places to stay with them, helping get to shelters, hotels without power and their employees go home and cook up a bunch of food, enough to feed all the hotel guests; people helping clean up the debris and blown over fences, clearing roads etc. It is amazing what a disaster does to everyone. It makes your heart swell with pride that with all the (yes I am going to say it) crap that is happening in our world, people in distress are helped with love and assistance from strangers. What a revelation it is to be a recipient of such wonderful gestures. I only have one further thing to say and that is it is a darn shame it takes a disaster like Irma or Harvey, to bring goodness out of people. But I must say I have seen the beauty of people helping people with no other thought than just to help them. It is a humbling thing to witness. Thank you to everyone who stepped up to the plate and helped in one way or another. We are forever in your debt and we are blessed



Three activities to ward off Alzheimer's

lzheimer's disease may not have a cure, but experts believe some practices can help delay memory loss. Here's what you can do:

- Cognitive training. Crossword puzzles and other games can help, but try some different techniques. Do simple arithmetic in your head instead of relying on a calculator. Develop a new method for remembering what's on your shopping list. Train your brain to remember things in new ways and you'll keep it sharper.
- Control your blood pressure. Reducing high blood pressure with medication and weight loss not only cuts your risk of heart disease, but it can also ease stress on the delicate blood vessels in your brain—stress that can exacerbate memory loss and dementia.
- Exercise. Moderate aerobic exercise has many health benefits, including heading off symptoms associated with Alzheimer's. Try exercising for 30 minutes five days a week, or 50 minutes three times a week. You'll feel better and extend your cognitive health.

Scientists search for life on the toughest planets

Te think of life as viable only on planets orbiting stars like our sun, but scientists now speculate that it could evolve on worlds circling very different types of stars.

Stars called M dwarfs are the most common stars in our galaxy. Their harsh flares and gravitational grip on their innermost planets could interfere with the formation of liquid water, which is necessary for life. However, astronomers have spotted approximately 200 planets circling M dwarfs, and dozens are in the so-called habitable zone where liquid water could exist and temperatures aren't too extreme for the development of life.



Scientists are studying these strange new worlds in hopes of detecting conditions that might lead to life—although it will probably be very different from any life found on Earth.

Lost and found: Seeking owner of ancient sword

cientists are trying to determine the identity of the owner of a 14th-century sword found in a bog in Poland. The four-foot-long sword, which according to the Fox News website is remarkably well preserved, was discovered by a worker using an excavator to drain a peat bog. The worker donated his find to a local museum.

Museum officials speculate that the sword was lost by a medieval knight, or that perhaps the knight perished in the bog. Researchers are examining an engraving on the sword's hilt that may identify the knight or his family. Meanwhile, archeologists are searching the bog for other artifacts





Dinosaurs may have been big softies

he popular image of dinosaurs is one of tough, ferocious creatures, but they may have been more sensitive than previously thought—at least their faces.

According to the Science News website, paleontologists at the University of Southampton used advanced X-ray and 3-D imaging to examine the skull of a large carnivorous land-based dinosaur found on the Isle of Wight and found that its snout may have actually been very tender—more like that of an aquatic creature. The dinosaur, a Neovenator, may have possessed pressure receptors in the skin of its snout, similar to those enabling crocodiles to forage in murky water.

Because scientists don't believe the Neovenator was a water feeder, they speculate the receptors may have been useful for picking meat from bones while eating and also stroking other dinosaur faces during mating.

What caused a massive extinction of sea life?

ost people know about the mass extinction of the dinosaurs millions of years ago, but paleontologists are hot the trail of another catastrophic event: the dying off by large marine animals 2-3 million years ago.

The extinction claimed the lives of up to one-third of marine megafauna, including water-based mammals, which lost 55 percent of their species. Forty-three percent of sea turtle species also died off, along with 33 percent of sea birds and 9 percent of sharks.

A team at the University of Zurich studying the event theorizes that a sudden loss of the productive coastal habitats combined with altered sea currents caused or contributed to the extinctions. The evidence suggests that large marine animals were more vulnerable to environmental changes than was previously believed.

Science is the acceptance of what works and the rejection of what does not. That needs more courage than we might think.
