September 2017 is here!!! What is going on for the month? Well, watch the clubhouse bulletin board for information and sign up sheets for various functions we will have going on. Labor Day is the 4th of September, and there is usually some kind of a get together to celebrate. Having no information in advance, keep close watch on the bulletin boards for announcements, or attend the coffee get together on Saturday mornings to get up to speed on what is happening and when. What else is going on for September? Well, not a whole heck of a lot. The calendar reflects that the 20th, Wednesday is Rosh Hashanah. Friday, the 22nd is Fall Equinox and Friday the 29th is Yom Kippur.

Labor Day is typically the last holiday of the summer, and is a celebration of achievements of the American Worker.

Labor Day: What it Means

Labor Day, the first Monday in September, is a creation of the labor movement and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of American workers. It constitutes a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country.

Labor Day Legislation

Through the years the nation gave increasing emphasis to Labor Day. The first governmental recognition came through municipal ordinances passed during 1885 and 1886. From these, a movement developed to secure state legislation. The first state bill was introduced into the New York legislature, but the first to become law was passed by Oregon on February 21, 1887. During the year four more states — Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York — created the Labor Day holiday by legislative enactment. By the end of the decade Connecticut, Nebraska, and Pennsylvania had followed suit. By 1894, 23 other states had adopted the holiday in honor of workers, and on June 28 of that year, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in the District of Columbia

and the territories.

There you have a bit of history about the Labor Day Holiday and what it represents, and how it came about. Enjoy everyone, whether working or retired, this is your day to pat yourself on the back for jobs well done.

School has resumed here in the county, and those school buses are out and about on the roadways. Please watch for the students getting on and off the buses and pay attention while driving. When you see those flashing lights and that stop sign come out the side of the bus, that means to STOP and allow the students to get on or off and clear the roadways before resuming. It is against the law to "go around" or pass a stopped bus with stop sign and lights flashing. So keep an ever watchful eye out for our children, they are our future and leaders in the coming years.

Also, here in Florida, we are currently in the midst of that wonderful weather phenomenon known as "Hurricane Season". The experts have predicted their "guesses" on the number of storms they think will develop and how many will be considered major storms. Hurricane season runs until the end of November, I believe, and it is very important to be prepared to take action, should we be in line to have a storm visit our area. It really amazes me that some Floridians don't pay much attention to the warnings etc, until the very last minute. Being from the Great Lakes region of the Midwest, I grew up dealing with Tornadoes. Now with a tornado, you have very little time to prepare if one pops up in your area, maybe a few hours at most. Hurricanes are watched as they develop for days with all kinds of projections and warnings. So being prepared is vital for survival if you end up in the midst of one. For the new residents of our park, who are new to this experience, please note that the first areas asked to evacuate are Mobile Homes. They just cannot stand up to the very strong winds and torrential rains. So you need to have a plan in place for yourself and your pets. You need to find out the best shelter you can go to that will accomodate your needs and your pet's needs if that is your situation. If you have to go to a shelter to stay, and it is a pet friendly one, your pet must be up to date on it's shots, etc. and you must have a crate for them. So it does take some "effort" to line up your agenda for survival. You need to stock up on 3 days of water for each person in household, and food to last a few days. This is usually peanut butter, canned tuna and meats etc. Protein is important, so many buy meat sticks and jerky etc to keep in a Hurricane Box. Your medicines are also important to make sure you have them and enough to get you through a few days. Your important papers, (titles, insurance policies, wills etc.) should be in a protected safe that you can grab quickly and throw in the car before you go. You need to have a plan on where to go, a shelter, a motel, go up north to escape the storm, so you can grab your survival containers and head out quickly. Also check on your neighbors, that they have a plan etc. or take them with you if they don't. No one enjoys the thoughts of evacuating and leaving their homes to the will of God, not knowing if it will be there when you get back to it. But material things can be replaced, not your life! When you first get an idea a storm may be coming in your direction, you need to bring all outdoor items into the shed or home so the wind doesn't blow

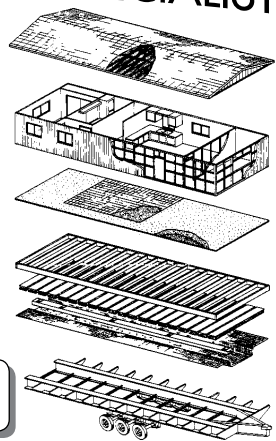

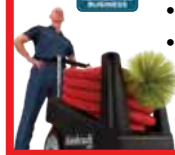

it all around. Get your survival boxes in order and ready to grab. And keep yourself informed until the threat either passes or you head out. Stay safe and vigilant.

And if you are a year rounder that lives here in this park, the heat has been record breaking all spring and summer. The heat and humidity have been in triple digits. We have also had a lot of rain and storms, almost every day. I have tried more times that I can count to get to the pool and swim, and when I go to put on my suit, the thunder starts up and storms come through. I have yet to get to the pool. I have much respect for the thunder and lightening here in Florida. Florida is known for being the "Lightening capital of the states" and is very dangerous. The sun can be shining outside, but if a storm is building or approaching, lightening can be close to you, so watch and avoid going or being outside. Sounds like I am lecturing or ranting, but just want everyone to remain alert and safe. Newcomers to the park may not be aware of these things. If just one person learns something new, then my mission is accomplished.

There are many new faces in the park as homes sell and new residents move in. Won't be long and we will be seeing familiar faces return for the winter season. Can't believe that the holidays are fast approaching. But am anxious to see the snow birds return. Also, we still have residents struggling with health issues, and such, so remember them in your thoughts and prayers.

I mentioned the heat and humidity earlier, and with it being so hot, turning on the oven to cook or even the burners of the stove makes that old air conditioner work all the harder. So if you have a crockpot or slow cooker, you can do amazing things with it and keep the "heat" out of the kitchen. You can bake breads, rolls, in them. Make pizzas and even candy. Here are some "hints" on things you can do with a crockpot. If you want to cook fried chicken or some kind of a crispy meat, bread and quickly fry in pan on stove. Wad several balls of aluminum foil and place on the bottom of the crockpot and press them down a bit to flatten. Quickly brown your chicken and place on top of the foil, so it doesn't sit in juices. Place paper towels or clean dishtowel over top and put lid on. The towels will soak up the condensation and keep it away from the crispy meat. Cook until chicken or meat is completely done. If you want baked potatoes, clean them, rub them in olive oil, sprinkle salt or seasonings on them, wrap in foil and place in crockpot until fork tender. Same with corn on the cobb.....season, butter shucked ears, wrap in foil and place in crockpot. You can stack on top of the potatoes if you want!! Foil pack dinners seem to be the rage right now, so you make up your foil pack with meat, potatoes, vegetables, seasonings and seal it up, place in crock pot and cook until done. Love spaghetti, acorn or butternut squash? Take a spaghetti squash, clean the outside of it, pierce it with a knife several times all around and place it in your crockpot. Let it cook until fork tender, turn off, let it cool a bit, lift it out of crockpot, cut in half and there is your "spaghetti" cooked and ready for your favorite red sauce, cheeses etc. Put a whole head of cleaned cauliflower in the slow cooker, and let cook till falls apart. Use mixer or potato masher, mash it up, add butter, salt and pepper and sour cream, just enough to bind it all together and you have skinny mashed potatoes. Line the crock with parchment paper, place nut bread batter in and let it bake until

done. Lift out with parchment paper and let cool, slice and enjoy. You can take thawed yeast dough and put on parchment paper that has been sprayed with oil, let it rise on low, when risen, turn on high and bake until done and you have very little effort in "homemade" bread. You can make cinnamon rolls, etc also. If you are interested in the exact recipes, let me know, will be glad to share. I love to roast a whole chicken, but in the crockpot it fills up with the juices and that is fine if I am going to use the chicken for noodles and want a lot of broth. But I love it with crispy skin and so I take a large crockpot, fill halfway with foil balls and place the bird on top. It roasts well, the juices are in the bottom with the foil and my bird is not soaked. Just some ideas to try.

Well, I have rambled on long enough. I hope all who are struggling with health issues are on their road to recovery and I include you in my thoughts and prayers. Please "pay it forward" or perform a Random Act of Kindness for someone to let them know you are thinking of them. Check on neighbors and friends who may be struggling with the heat or other issues. And always wave and smile. Take a moment out of your busy day to listen to the birds sing, or smell a flower or sing in the rain. Life is good, enjoy it. Till next month, take care.

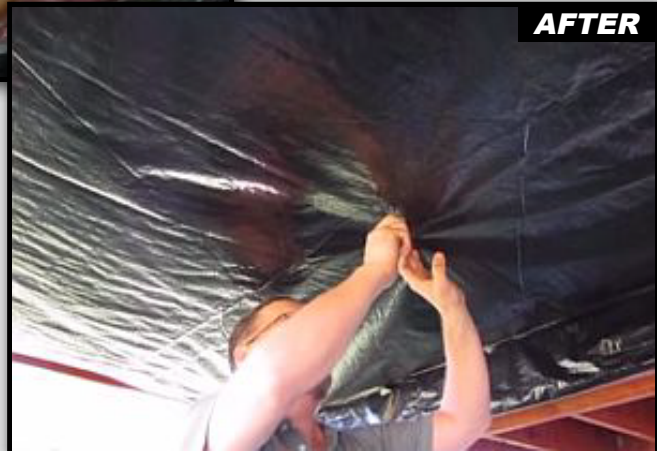

Chocolate may be good for your heart

In case you're looking for an excuse to eat some chocolate, consider this: It may reduce your risk of irregular heartbeat.

An analysis of some 55,000 adults from Denmark found that eating 2-6 ounces of chocolate a week was associated with a 20 percent decreased risk of atrial fibrillation, or A-fib, otherwise known as an irregular heartbeat. A-fib can compromise blood flow in the upper chambers of the heart—the atria. People with A-fib are five times more likely to suffer a stroke, according to the American Heart Association, and have twice the risk of a heart-related death.



Moderate consumption of chocolate, especially dark chocolate, appears to reduce that risk, although binging on larger amounts can obviously lead to weight gain and associated problems.

Carbon monoxide safety tips for your home

Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless and nearly odorless gas that's created by the incomplete burning of solid, liquid, and gaseous fuels. Appliances that burn LP gas (liquefied petroleum), oil, coal, kerosene, coal or wood may produce carbon monoxide. Carbon monoxide is also poisonous to animals and people. Symptoms of its effects include:

- Headache
- Fatigue
- Shortness of breath
- Nausea
- Dizziness

To prevent CO poisoning, take these precautions:

- Buy and install a CO alarm. Make sure it is listed with Underwriters Laboratories or that there is information on the package that indicates that it meets the requirements of IAS 6-96 standards. Follow the directions for placement and installation.
- Install appliances properly. Most of them should be installed by a professional.
- Practice good maintenance. Have your heating system (furnaces, flues, and chimneys) inspected and serviced by a professional every year.
- Burn charcoal outdoors only. Never burn it in a tent, home, garage, vehicle, etc. Don't use portable fuel-burning camping equipment indoors or inside tents, etc.
- Make sure you turn off fuel-burning engine equipment when you are inside a garage or basement. Just having the doors open does not ensure your safety.

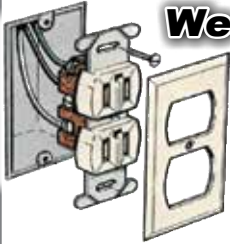

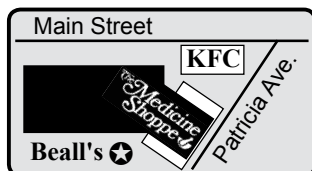

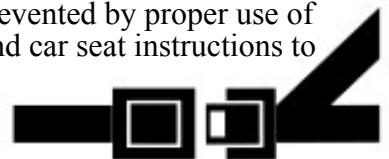

Complete dinosaur skeleton is spectacular find

Most dinosaur fossils consist of a few bones or teeth, but in 2011 a heavy-equipment operator in Alberta, Canada unearthed something unique—the complete fossilized remains of a newfound type of nodosaur, part of the ankylosaur family, which lived between 100 million and 112 million years old.

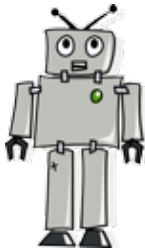
As reported on the National Geographic website, the dinosaur is still getting paleontologists excited today. The dinosaur is so well preserved that it “might have been walking around a couple of weeks ago,” says paleobiologist Jakob Vinther, who’s studying the ancient beast at Alberta’s Royal Tyrrell Museum.



Because of its preservation, the fossil is providing new insights into the structure of nodosaurs’ armor, letting paleontologists see how sheaths of keratin—material also found in human fingernails—exaggerated the armor’s size and shape.

Robot can grasp complex objects with new hand

Most robotic hands are clumsy and have a hard time picking up odd-shaped objects like shoes or spray bottles. But according to the Science News website, roboticists at UC Berkeley have created a robot that can pick up and move awkward objects with a success rate of 99 percent.



The robot, DexNet 2.0, uses a process called deep learning to handle objects. The roboticists created a database of three-dimensional shapes using 6.7 million data points. A neural network learned ways to grasp, lift, and move irregularly shaped objects, and then was hooked up to a robotic arm with a 3D sensor. DexNet 2.0 studies an object placed in front of it and then chooses the right grasp to pick it up and move it.

DexNet 2.0’s success rate could be applied to industry, possibly revolutionizing manufacturing and supply chains.

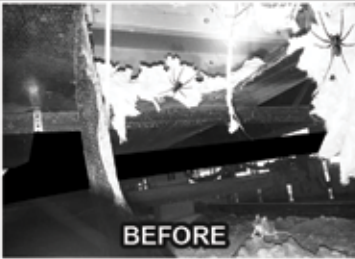

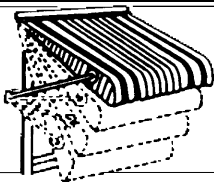

What to eat? The choices can be confusing

Americans trying to eat healthy have lots of choices, but all those options can be confusing. The CNN website reports that 78 percent of respondents to a survey by the International Food Information Council Foundation said they're not sure what foods they should eat and which they should avoid.



The survey of slightly more than 1,000 American adults found that almost 60 percent named food that's "high in healthy components or nutrients" as one of their top three factors for choosing a "healthy" food, followed by food that's free from artificial ingredients, preservatives or additives (just more than 50 percent). Choices that are "part of an important food group that I need to build a healthy eating style" rounded out the list of foods health-conscious folks are looking for (nearly 50 percent).

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration considers food that can be marketed as "healthy" as having low levels of total and saturated fat, sodium, and cholesterol, and at least 10 percent of the daily requirements for vitamins, fiber, and other nutrients.

Millennial women take less vacation than men

Americans workers have a reputation for not taking all the vacation they have coming. Among them, millennial women seem to take the least: Only 44 percent used all their vacation time in 2016, according to a survey reported on the Mic website, compared with 51 percent of their male co-workers.

What's behind the gap? Thirty-seven percent of millennial women said they want to demonstrate full commitment to their jobs, but only 32 percent of men surveyed expressed the same feeling. Moreover, 35 percent of the women said they feel guilty about taking time off, compared with 25 percent of the men.

Overall, 53 percent of the 7,331 millennials surveyed left unused vacation days, with 55 percent of Gen Xers and 52 percent of Baby Boomers forfeiting vacation days.

Teens: Not glued to social media

Most of us imagine that today's teens do nothing but sit around with their smartphones texting each other, checking social media, posting images to Instagram, and the like. That stereotype, like most, isn't true. An Associated Press-NORC Center for Public Affairs Research survey of teens recently found that 58 percent voluntarily take breaks from social media for various reasons:

- Getting in the way of work or school: 8 percent
- Tired of conflict and drama: 24 percent
- Tired of keeping up: 20 percent



Start financial literacy early

Teaching children to save money when they're young can help them deal with financial emergencies when they're older. Here's how to get them started:

- Encourage kids to save something. Whether you've got a 10-year-old stashing away a dollar or a teenager opening a savings or checking account, get your children in the habit of saving no matter how small the amount.
- Help kids balance treats and sacrifices. Work with your kids to set and meet some goals. Once those goals are met, allow them a little withdrawal to buy something for themselves.
- Put loose change into an emergency fund. Loose change can add up, so don't let kids discard pennies or leave them lying in the parking lot.
- Set an example. Children don't miss much. If they don't see you saving, they might wonder why they have to save.
- Keep kids away from credit as long as possible. Credit card companies expend lots of effort on marketing to teenagers. Make sure your kids understand what credit pitfalls could lie ahead.
- Schedule money meetings. Meet with your child at regular intervals to discuss their emergency account, answer questions, and discuss money issues he or she might encounter.
- Help kids set up a real budget. The earlier kids learn to manage a budget, the easier things will be down the line. Younger kids can start learning by jotting their pluses and minuses down on a piece of paper, while older kids can be introduced to budgeting on software and apps.



Doctor to parents: Watch the juice

Lots of parents give their young children fruit juice, but pediatricians now say that's a bad idea. The American Association of Pediatrics recently updated its position on juice, recommending now that newborns shouldn't drink any juice before their first birthday and that juice should be limited after that.

The reasons? Doctors don't see any evidence of health benefits, and they believe that juice may prevent children from getting the protein and nutrients they need through breast milk or formula. In older kids, the sugar in juice contributes to tooth decay.

The guidelines advise that toddlers 1 to 3 years old get no more than four ounces of juice a day, six ounces up to age 6, and eight ounces to age 18. They recommend that parents encourage their kids to eat fruit instead.

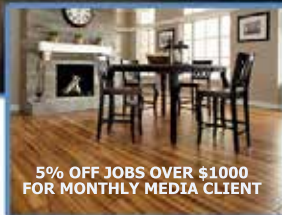

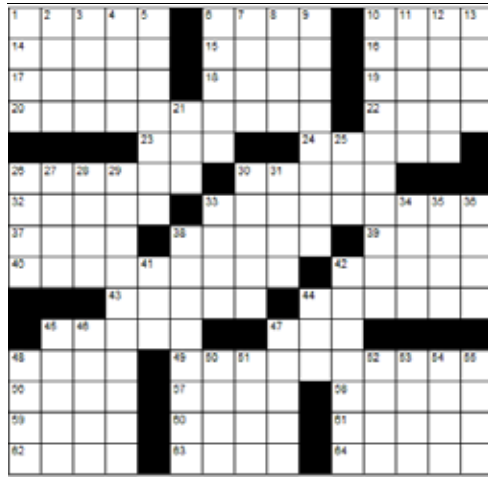
