



From Claudi's Kitchen:

Caramel Carrot Cake

12-16 servings

prep time: 40 mins + chilling time Bake time: 35 mins

Carrot cake batter

2 cups all purpose flour 1 1/2 tsp baking powder 1 1/2 tsp baking soda 1 tsp salt 2 tsp cinnamon 1/2 tsp nutmeg 4 eggs 1 cup brown sugar 1/2 cup sugar 1 1/4 cups veg/canola oil 12 oz finely grated carrots (about 4-5 med) 1 cup pecans

Caramel Sauce

1 cup sugar 1/4 cup water 1/2 cup whipping cream 2 Tbsp unsalted butter @ room temp 1 tsp vanilla extract 1 tsp salt

Cream Cheese Frosting

17 oz cream cheese, room temp 1 1/4 cup whipping cream, 35% fat, chilled 1/2 cup powdered sugar 1/3 cup caramel sauce

For Decorating


remaining caramel sauce pecans

Directions

- 1. Prepare the carrot cake layers. Preheat oven to 350F (180c)Grease and line w/parchment paper two 9" round cake pans.
- 2. In a medium bowl sift together flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt, cinnamon and nutmeg. Set aside.
- 3. In a large bowl add eggs with both sugars and mix for a few minutes until creamy and lighter in color. Add oil and mix until combined. Gradually mix in flour mixture. Using a spatula incorporate the grated carrots and toasted pecans.
- 4. Pour the batter evenly into the two pans.
- 5. Bake for 30-35 minutes or toothpick comes out clean.
- 6. Let pans cool on cooling rack for 10 minutes.
- 7. Remove the cakes from the pans and allow to cool completely.



- 8. Prepare the caramel Sauce. Place the sugar and water in a medium heavy bottom saucepan over medium-high heat, cook without stirring until sugar dissolves and gets a caramel color.
- 9. Remove the pan from heat and add the cream. It will bubble a little bit.
- 10. Cook for about one minute stirring constantly with a wooden spoon until smooth.
- 11. Remove from heat and add butter and salt. Stir well until smooth. Pour into a small jar and set aside to cool until cake is ready.
- 12. Prepare the frosting. In a bowl beat the cream cheese until smooth. Add powdered sugar and 1/3 cup of caramel sauce.
- 13. In another bowl whip the cream until stiff peaks form. Gradually fold into the cream cheese mixture until well blended.
- 14. Assemble the cake. Place one cake layer on serving plate. Spread evenly with a bit less then half the frosting. Add the second layer of cake. Spread the remaining frosting on top and sides of the cake. Refrigerate for at least 2 hours.
- 15. Before serving, top the cake with remaining caramel sauce letting some drip down the sides. If caramel hardened too much, heat it a bit to get a pouring consistency. Decorate with chopped and whole pecans.
- 16. Left over frosting can be covered and refrigerated for up to a week. Serve cake a room temperature.
