





#### Tips from a Neighborhood Nurse- Fall Prevention

have 20 years of experience in the medical field in a local intensive care unit and did you know that every 11 seconds, an older adult is seen in an emergency department for a fall-related injury?

#### Many falls are preventable. Please stay safe with these easy 6 tips:

- 1. Keep your home safe by removing tripping hazards such as throw rugs. If throw rugs are used make sure they have non-skid backing. Increasing the lighting in your home and installing grab bars in shower and stairwells are also helpful tips. Watch out for our small furry pets as they are often trip hazards.
- 2. Ask your Primary Physician to assess for your risk of falling. Do not be afraid or embarrassed to be honest about any recent history of falls.



- 3. When refilling your prescriptions, speak to your pharmacists. Ask them to review your medications with you and make sure different side effects do not increase your chance of falling. Keep a log to show them what time you take each medication to ensure that timeframes are not making you predisposed to a fall. Be sure to take medications exactly as prescribed.
- 4. Vision and hearing can also contribute to falls. Keep your vision and hearing checked annually and eyeglasses prescriptions updated.



5. Maintain your strength, balance and flexibility by finding a good balance exercise program if able. Take a friend and make it fun.



6. Keep your family members and/or friends involved to get their support in taking the above steps. Be honest about your concerns. They love you and want you to remain safe.




